• The Bears' 12-1 record at home marks their best start at home since the 2012-13 season (started 12-1). Cal's best season at home came during the 1982-83 season, when it finished a perfect 13-0 in Berkeley.

• The Bears are coming off their best season under head coach Charmin Smith in which they:

- Won their most overall (19) and conference (seven) games since 2018-19
- Had home and road sweeps of Pac-12 schools (Washington and Washington State) for the first time since 2018-19
- Played in the postseason for the first time since 2018-19
- Advanced to the quarterfinals of the Pac-12 Tournament for the first time since 2019-20.
- Swept three different Pac-12 schools (Oregon, Washington and Washington State) for the first time since 2017-18.

• At 19-4, Cal is off to its best overall start under Smith and since the 2012-13 season (19-2). Cal's six road wins are the most under Smith.

• The Bears are one of 21 teams in the country with at least three Quad 1 (NET) wins.

• Cal is currently 8-4 against teams from the 2024 NCAA Tournament with wins over #19 Alabama, #21 NC State, Florida State, Gonzaga, Auburn, Arizona and Stanford (twice).

• The Bears came in at No. 21 in this week's AP Top 25 Poll and No. 21 in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

• A win against Notre Dame would tie for Cal's highest-ranked win ever (No. 3 Rutgers on Nov. 21, 2008) and be its highest ranked win since beating then-No. 5 Stanford on Jan. 13, 2013. It would also give the Bears three ranked wins in a season for the first time since 2019-20.

• Ioanna Krimili was named to this week's Ann Meyers Drysdale National Player of the Week Watch List.

HEAD COACH CHARMIN SMITH



Fresh off her best season at the helm of the California women's basketball team, Charmin Smith signed a contract extension in the summer of 2024 that will retain her through the 2028-29 season.

In her fifth year as head coach in 2023-24, the Golden Bears won their most overall (19) and conference (seven) games since the 2018-19 season. Smith also guided Cal into the postseason for the first time since 2018-19 as the Bears earned an at-large bid and a No. 2 seed in last year's inaugural NCAA Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament. Under Smith's guidance that season, the team also had its first weekend home and road sweeps of Pac-12 schools (both against Washington and Washington State) since 2018-19, swept Oregon for the first time since 2012-13 and set a program record for 3-pointers (282) in a season. The season sweeps of Oregon, Washington and Washington State marked the first time Cal has swept three different Pac-12 schools since 2017-18. The Bears also advanced to the quarterfinals of last year's Pac-12 Tournament for the first time since 2019-20. Smith was named ESPN's Coach of the Week on Jan. 8 of that season.

Entering last season Smith signed a Top 25 (ESPN) recruiting class that featured two ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 players in Kamryn Mafua (54) and Zahra King (76) along with last year's Gatorade and MaxPreps Hawaii State Player of the Year Lola Donez.

Smith is an award-winning coach, former professional player, and active board member who has dedicated her career to progressing equity and opportunity. The true definition of a trailblazer, Smith is the first Black Head Coach at the University of California Berkeley's women's basketball program history and is on a mission to leverage her platform to lead societal change through sports.

Smith's unwavering dedication to empowering players to surpass their potential, her commitment to enhancing the representation of Black individuals in the sport, and her resolute drive to inspire action toward racial justice solidify her position as an influential leader in basketball and beyond.

Regarded as one a 2024 and 2020 Top 100 Most Influential Figures in Women's College Basketball (Silver Waves Media), Smith's legacy at Cal Berkeley—beginning with her transition from Associate Head Coach to Head Coach—highlights her strategic acumen and commitment to player development. Her storied tenure includes a 2013 Final Four appearance and an impressive ten postseason appearances.

Currently serving on the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA), Smith is renowned for her role as a Board Member and co-chair of the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Committee. Her dedication extends far beyond the basketball court, as evidenced by her impactful contributions to the Cal Athletics Equity Inclusion and Diversity Task Force and her pivotal role in the Chancellor's Counsel for Students of Color and Multicultural Engagement.

Smith experienced a number of successes in her first year as head coach, leading the Golden Bears to three upsets over higher-ranked opponents. The first came in the form of a 4-point victory over No. 20 Arkansas on November 24 and then a win over No. 13 Arizona on the road in the regular season finale. The Bears completed their second upset in the same week as just four days later, they defeated 5-seeded and No. 22-ranked Arizona State in the opening round of the 2020 Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament in Las Vegas. The win over the Sun Devils made the Golden Bears just the second 12-seed to win a game in the Pac-12 Tournament.

Smith has helped coach the Bears to the top three individual seasons in program history. In her first two years in Berkeley, Cal set then-school records for wins in a season, finishing both years with 27-7 marks before Cal pushed itself into elite status with the record-breaking 32-4 Final Four campaign in 2012-13. The Bears also recorded their best Pac-12 record (17-1) and won their first conference regular-season crown that season. Smith has helped lead the Bears to the postseason in 11 of her 13 seasons and was also part of the staff that led the Bears to the 2010 WNIT championship.

Smith's previous roles at Stanford and Boston College allowed her to build upon impact, leading her teams to multiple NCAA appearances and historic victories. Her experience as a point guard for the WNBA's Minnesota Lynx and Seattle Storm later influenced her time as an Assistant Coach for the New York Liberty.

As a standout player Stanford Women's Basketball Team, Smith was a crucial component of the team's three NCAA Final Four Appearances and three Pac-10 Conference Championships between 1995 to 1997. Following her collegiate playing career, Smith joined the professional ranks in the ABL from 1997-98 as a member of the Portland Power and played three years in the WNBA, along with one year in the Swedish Basketball League.

She holds both master's and bachelor's degrees in Civil and Environmental Engineering from the University. Coupled with her impressive career in basketball, Smith also pursued the challenging discipline of Muay Thai martial arts. As a testament to her relentless spirit, Smith applies the lessons from her passion off the court to her coaching approach on the court.

Her leadership extends to a realm where the core values are honor and discipline, where she embodies the ethos that actions must follow words. And her steadfast commitment and achievements have set her apart to lead the future of sports.

This marks just the fourth meeting between the two programs with Notre Dame winning all of the previous three matchups. The two teams last met up in the inaugural Shamrock Classic which at the time was the first ever women's college basketball game broadcast on NBC.

About the Fighting Irish

Notre Dame is led by fifth-year head coach Niele Ivey who has led her team to three consecutive Sweet 16 appearances since taking over. The Fighting Irish are led by the backcourt duo of Hannah Hidalgo who is second in the country in scoring (26.0 points per game) and third in the country in steals (80) and Olivia Miles who is fourth in the country in assists (141).

Last time out versus Notre Dame

The Cal women's basketball team overcame a 14-point deficit in the third quarter to cut the lead to just three points a few minutes into the fourth, before ultimately falling to No. 9 Notre Dame, 90-79, at the Enterprise Center on Saturday in the inaugural Citi Shamrock Classic.

Jayda Curry led all scorers with 24 points including four three-pointers. Mia Mastrov joined Curry in double-figures with 10 points off the bench, giving the Bears a 28-20 edge in bench points.

The Bears got down by double-figures early but Jadyn Bush provided a spark off the bench leading the team with five second quarter points to keep the halftime margin to single digits. With less than a minute left before halftime, Bush scored on an assist from Curry with an opportunity to get to the line. She hit the free throw to put the score at 46-37 going into the half.

In the third quarter Peanut Tuitele gave the Bears a surge with six points on 3-for-4 shooting and had a huge block at the end of the quarter to keep the deficit at seven points going into the final frame. The Bears kept attacking and got to the line often, including Mastrov going 4-4 from the charity stripe.

In the fourth quarter, the Bears got started with back-to-back buckets by Karisma Ortiz and Claudia Langarita to cut the lead to just three. Notre Dame answered with three straight free throws before Curry added her fourth three-pointer of the game to once again bring the deficit to three with just over seven minutes left. The Fighting Irish then went on a 15-5 run to give them their biggest lead of the night at 13 with a little over two minutes to go to seal the victory. Overall, the Bears outshot Notre Dame from deep 9-6.

Notre Dame had a considerable disparity on free throws with 36 attempts compared to Cal's 24. Cal did a good job on defense against the Fighting Irish with a 23-16 edge in turnovers, however the Bears were only able to convert them into 21 points while Notre Dame generated 24 points off of Cal's turnovers.

Leilani McIntosh swiped four steals against the Fighting Irish giving her 10 games in her career with four or more steals.

In the loss at Louisville Thursday:

- Michelle Onyiah posted her sixth double-double of the season with 15 (7-of-10) points and 11 rebounds.
- Gisella Maul tied her career high with five rebounds in just 13 minutes off the bench
- Five Bears scored in double figures for the second time this season.
- Cal allowed just three made 3-pointers tying for its fewest allowed during ACC play.
- The Bears got to the free throw line 22 times marking its most in conference play.

- Over the course of ACC conference play during the 2024-25 season Cal will fly a total of approximately 18, 015 miles.
 - On Feb. 4, Krimili and Kayla Williams were named to the Women's College All-Star Game Watch List, comprised of 70 of the top seniors in the country.
 - On Dec. 17, Suárez was named to the USBWA Ann Myers National Player of the Week team following her 21-point (including four 3-pointers) and seven-rebound effort in the win over Stanford.
 - Krimili is currently the **nation's leader** in both career triples (408) and most career games with at least five made 3-pointers (26). She ranks **fifth** in the NCAA in career points (2,473) among all active players.
 - Krimili's 408 career 3-pointers rank 14th on the NCAA's all-time career list. She needs to hit 17 more to move into a tie for 10th place all time.
 - Krimili and Twidale are the best 3-point shooting duo in the nation. Krimili is ranked fifth (71) while Twidale is ranked ninth (68) (**through Feb. 7**). No other school has a duo who have combined for more made 3-pointers or rank in the top 25.
 - Twidale leads all sophomores in the nation in made 3-pointers. (**through Feb. 7**).
 - Krimili and Twidale are two of only eight players in the NCAA with at least 14 games this season with three or more made 3-pointers (**through Feb. 7**). Krimili is second in the country with 16 such games.
 - While Krimili holds Cal's single-season 3-point record at 71, Twidale's 68 triples this season rank second on the list.
 - For the month of November, Twidale:
 - Ranked 5th in the country in 3-point makes
 - Posted three 20-point games
 - Led the country with eight games with 3+ 3-pointers
 - For the month of December, Krimili:
 - Ranked 5th in the NCAA in total 3-pointers with 24
 - Ranked 9th in the country in 3PT % (min. 45 attempts) at 40.7%
 - Averaged 17.7 points per game
 - Krimili is one of only two active players in the country with career averages of 42% from the field, 39% from downtown (min. 400 3PA) and 85% from the free throw line while averaging at least 16.0 points per game. The other is UConn's Paige Bueckers.
 - Marta Suarez has scored in double figures in all but two games during conference play averaging 14.0 points per game over that stretch - the second highest on the team. She also leads the team in rebounding (7.3 rebounds per game) during ACC play.
 - Entering this week, Suarez is 1 of 3 players in the conference to rank in the top 20 in scoring (14.3 ppg) and rebounding (7.4 rpg) and top 10 in field goal percentage (50.0) during ACC play.
 - Suarez's 30 3-pointers this season rank third among all forwards in the ACC.
 - Suarez is one of only 11 forwards in the country and only one in the ACC shooting at least 48% from the field and 35% from deep (min. 70 3PTA).
 - Williams has done a great job facilitating and contributing to the team's offensive output this season. She is just 1 of 2 players in the nation shooting at least 50.0% from the field, 40.0% from deep and totaling at least 100 assists on the season. The other is Notre Dame's Olivia Miles.
 - For the season Williams is 1 of 4 players in the ACC listed at 5-7 or shorter to have grabbed 6+ rebounds in a game at least six times.
 - Onyiah is setting career single-season highs across several categories this year: FG% (61.1), rebounding (7.2) and scoring (10.7). During ACC play she is shooting 64.0% from the field.

CAL WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

- Onyiah has had two games with five blocks this year joining only three other players in the ACC to have reached that mark.
- Noble has proven to be the team's defensive stopper and a key player off the bench as she has played double-digit minutes in eight of the past nine games and leads the team in reserve minutes. She is the team's leading rebounder off the bench with 75 rebounds grabbed so far this season.
- Gabrielle Abigor has earned her way into the primary backup center spot this season. Among freshmen in the ACC she ranks in the top 10 in blocks and rebounds despite totaling just 223 minutes - by far the fewest among the group - and not having started a game. Within freshmen in the ACC who have not started a game she ranks 2nd in blocks (10) and third in rebounds (59).
- Natalia Ackerman has been incredibly efficient off the bench over her last four games. She is averaging 5.2 points per game in just 10.2 minutes per game during that stretch while missing just one field goal (9-of-10).
- Cal is 1 of only 5 ACC schools with five different players having scored 20+ points at least once in a game this season (others are Duke, Notre Dame, Stanford and Virginia Tech).
- Entering this week, Cal is 1 of only 10 schools in the country to have five players averaging over 10 points per game.
- Cal's depth on the offensive side of the ball has been on display this season as five different Bears have led the team in scoring in a game.
- The Bears put up a combined 346 points through the first four games of the season, which is the third most in program history through the first four games of a campaign. They put up 347 over that span in both the 2012-13 and 1994-95 seasons.
- Cal held each of its first three opponents to under 60 points for the first time since the 2008-09 season.
- The Bears welcome four transfers in graduate forward Natalia Ackerman (Cal Poly), sophomore guard Gisella Maul (Texas), graduate guard Jayda Noble (Washington) and graduate guard Kayla Williams (USC).
- Cal's 22nd-ranked freshman class is comprised of two rookies who were part of ESPN's 2024 HoopGurlz Top 100 - Kamryn Mafua (No. 54) and Zahra King (No. 76) along with last year's Graduate and MaxPreps Hawaii State Player of the Year Lola Donez and Gabby Abigor.
- The returning trio of Krimili, Marta Suarez and Twidale combined for 144 3-pointers last season which accounted for 51% of the team's total triples made.
- Despite missing nine games last season Krimili's 61 triples last season ranked ninth in the Pac-12 conference. During conference play she tied for the league lead with 47 3-pointers.
- Suarez proved to be one of the most versatile players on the team last season as she made impacts on both ends of the floor leading the team in rebounds (171) while ranking third in 3-point makes (42).
- In 2023-24, Suarez led the team with seven double-doubles, good for 10th in the Pac-12. She also led the team with 22 double-digit scoring games.
- Twidale was one of the best freshman in the Pac-12 last season as she was only 1 of 2 freshmen in the Pac-12 to either score 24 points or hit six triples in a game - the other was USC's Juju Watkins. Twidale also posted three 20-point games in 2023-24 - tied for 2nd in the Pac-12 among all freshmen.
- Graduate center Michelle Onyiah enters her fifth season with the Bears and has shown steady improvement in several categories each year with the team:
 - FG%: 46.9 (FR) -> 56.1 (SR)
 - Rebounds: 115 (FR) -> 212 (SR)
 - Steals: 12 (FR) -> 37 (SR)
 - Points: 151 (FR) -> 261 (SR)
- For the month of February last season Onyiah was incredibly efficient from the field as she averaged an incredible 72% field goal percentage which ranked second in the country.
