

MIAMI'S DENMIS ERICKSON: "I would like to congratulate Notre Dame on a fine effort. You just can't make the mistakes we made in the second half and expect to win. Notre Dame controlled the ball in the third quarter and it really paid off for them.

They played better defensively than they have this season but that really didn't surprise us. We knew they were good.

(ON 2ND LOSS) "Even though we're probably out of the national title picture, we can still get nine wins and have a good season. We have a lot of character and we'll be working towards a major bowl.

We just hurt ourselves with all the mistakes, but I do not want to take away from their defensive effort. I thought they moved the ball well and I was impressed with their front line.
