Dennis Green (Stanford)

"We felt we would be playing a very physical football game today. And that didn't bother us. We've said all along that we were better than most people thought we were. We tried to play physical today.

"We had great, great leadership on the field today. Ed McCaffrey showed a lot of leadership out there today and I thought Jason Palumbis was very solid.

"Teams like Notre Dame are going to keep your halfback out of things, so we knew we would have to do some other things. We call Number 44 our Touchdown Tommy. We know he's going to get the ball, you know he's going to get the ball and we want to see you try to stop him.

"Defensively, we knew we had to try and contain their quarterback. We didn't do a good job of that. We did have some excellent run defense and I liked some of the things I saw in the secnd half.

"It's hats off to our team, the players and the coaching staff. There's no doubt this is a major win for our program. We think we are doing things right here. I believe we have one of the best, if not the best, program in the country. And we're very proud of that.

Lou Holtz (Notre Dame)

"It was a difficult game. I congratulate Standard Stanford. They played very, very well. They made the critical plays and didn't make ctitical mistakes. We had threee very costly turnovers which were very disastrous.

"I'm very disappointed. We can't become a good football teams if we continue to play defense like that. I know one thing, we'll work on catching punts this week.

"Rocket Ismail did not practice on Wednesday or Thursday. He was banged up and it would not have been in his best interest if he played today.

"I liked what I saw on our last drive, the way we battled back. It was would have been another miraculous comeback. But it can't take away from the great effort of the Stanford team and their coaching staff.

"I don't two know if I've ever been in a loss that was this difficult.

"On defense, there are going to be some changes somewhere. Anytime you give up 38 points you have to be concerned.

Ricky Watters — (Punts) "The first one I lost in the sun and the wind got it, and it carried over my head. The second one I'm not sure what happened.

GAME NOTES

Notre Dame's loss was their first at Notre Dame Stadium since the 1986 Penn State game ending the Irish 19-game home winning streak.

Stanford fullback Tommy Vardell's 4 TD's were the most since Darrin Nelson set the Stanf-ord rushing TD mark in 1981 with 5 against Oregon St.

Stanford running back Jon Volpe moved into fifth place on the Stanford All-Time Rushing list.

Notre Dame has only lost three games at Notre Dame Stadium while ranked number one in the country. Both of the other losses were to Purdue.

Notre Dame is now 61-10-3 while the top ranked team in the country.

Tony Smith's two touchdown receptions were the most since Rick - Watters caught two in the 1988 Air Force game

Stanford didn't get their first first down until 8:23 in the 2nd quarter Stanford broke a Notre Dame nine-game winning streak against the Pac-10.
