We made costly mistakes that whenwe should not have and you cannot do that and expect to beat a team like Notre Dame. Offensively, I waw a lot of good things out there. I thought most of the time we executed pretty well. The key mistakes hut us, but it's not a one game season and we'll get it back together. I thought we created some confusion and caught them off guard at times. Dunbar had an excellent game and out line played very well. I saw great effort out there.

(ONSIDES KICK) - The onsides kick was costly, we had a young player in there, the ball came his way and they recovered. We alerted them before it happened. It was a smart move by Notre Dame and not everybody was headsup for us. You've got to be on your toes in that situation.

Our tackling was not what I thought it would be today. Bettis and Culver ran over us at times. (ON IRV SMITH TD RUN)O- He made a good run, I'll say that. (ONTRENT GREEN) - I thought he came back after the first interception and showed a lot of poise. He didn't go into the tank. Unfortuenately we were up 3-0 and gave up a cheap one. But he handled himself very well.

Offensively, we're going to mix it up this year. I'd like to see Dunbar get the ball 25 times a game. I think we have some serious threats with four receivers including our tight end. Lewis and Beatty, in their first starts, played very well.

I thought we'd use our quickness to offset their sixe, but I have to see some film. Don't shortchange our kids. -The We came in with a positive fe feeling that we could win. They've got good quality, depth and talent.

Offensivley, we knew Hires could throw and that they could run. I thought the offense was the strong point of their team. Our goal going in was to try to keep them contained and not give up the so-called big plays.
