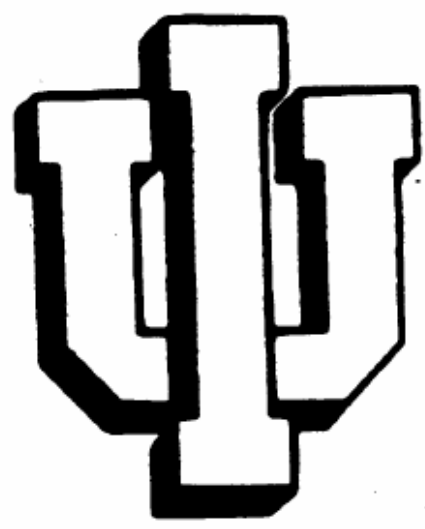

I knew going in Notre Dame would be strong; They came up with the key plays at the key times. We made costly mistakes that- when we should not have and you cannot do that and expect to beat a team like Notre Dame.

Offensively, I saw a lot of good things out there. I thought most of the time we executed pretty well. The key mistakes hurt us, but it's not a one game season and we'll get it back together. I thought we created some confusion and caught them off guard at times. Dunbar had an excellent game and out line played very well. I saw great effort out there.

(ONSIDES KICK)- The onside kick was costly, we had a young player in there, the ball came his way and they recovered. We alerted them before it happened. It was a smart move by Notre Dame and not everybody was heads-up for us. You've got to be on your toes in that situation.

Our tackling was not what I thought it would be today. Bettis and Culver ran over us at times.

(ON IRV SMITH TD RUN)0- He made a good run, I'll say that.

(ONTRENT GREEN)- I thought he came back after the first interception and showed a lot of poise. He didn't go into the tank. Unfortunately, we were up 3-0 and gave up a cheap one. But he handled himself very well.

Offensively, we're going to mix it up this year. I'd like to see Dunbar get the ball 25 times a game. I think we have some serious threats with four receivers including our tight end. Lewis and Beatty, in their first starts, played very well.

I thought we'd use our quickness to offset their size, but I have to see some film. Don't shortchange our kids. -The We came in with a positive feeling that we could win. They've got good quality, depth and talent.

Offensively, we knew Miles could throw and that they could run. I thought the offense was the strong point of their team. Our goal going in was to try to keep them contained and not give up the so-called big plays.

NOTRE DAME COACH LOU HOLTZ-

We're ver glad to win our openig ballgame. I give Indiana a lot of credit. They were well prepared. I think ~~there was~~ this will make Indiana a better football team in the long run., judging from the tremendous preparation they made for us in the summer session. They're a good football team and they'll win a lot of football games, I don't think there's any doubt about it. As for Notre Dame, we had the one turnover that wyou don't like to have but defensively we generated spe turnovers. We have some things to build on, and we have some concerns, naturally. One game doesn't make a season. I can't judge a football team after one game.

Offensively, I thought we got off to a slow start. Once we got into the groove, Jerome Bettis played well, Rick Mirar played well, Tony Brooks ran well. Our tight ends, Derek Brown made some big plays, Irv Smith's a good football poyer- player. I thought our receivers blocked well. But we committed some critical penalties and we just couldn't put the game away. But Jerome Bettis made a very good run and that certainly helped.

Defensively, our secondary played well, bur we got a little soft as the game went on. We got worn down a little baton defense They did some things that we had some trouble adjusting to, but you can expect that from a young football team.
