GAME NOTES

Notre Dame has won nine consecutive games against USC. Notre Dame leads the all-time series by a 36-23-4 count.

Jerome Bettis' 178 yards are the 17th highest total in a single-game in Notre Dame history. His 794 yards in 1991 also rank 17th on the all-time single-season rushing list.

Bettis' 53-yard run was the longest of his career and the longest USC has allowed in 1991.

Bettis also recorded his fifth straight two rushing touchdown game and fourth 100-yard game of the season.

Tony Brooks moved into eighth place on the Notre Dame career rushing list, with 2015 yards. With his 03 yards today he moved past Don Miller (1933), Marchy Schwarz (1945) and Mark Green (1977). He also caught his third career touchdown reception and first since the Air Force game in 1938.

USC HEAD COACH LARRY SAITH

"At halftime I told them all to execute. To tackle on defense and on offense to quit playing blind. Execute, throw, catch, nothing fancy."

(on Bettis): "He's a great fullback. The best I've ever seen. He's the core of Notre Dame's offense."

(on performance of his team):"I"Grade it average. I thought we could win if we hald Notre Dame to under 17 points, because we thought we would get 20 to 24 points. We just got to learn. We're just a bunchof young guys who played our buts off. We just don't have it togather on defense."

NOTRE DAME HEAD COASH LOU HOLTZ

This was a hard-fought game; the footing was had for both teams, made it difficult to operate. T- first half we played very, very well defensively. It was a crazy game, a game with great emotion. We made a great goal line stand and they come right back and score in two plays. We were up 21-7 at one point but we could never take control of the game. That's a credit to Southern Cal. Bettis and Brooks ran well against a solid defensive football team.

We had problems with their counter in the second half. We're happy to win; i gives us a winning season. We just could not disrupt their rythum or put pressure on their passer. They kept us off balance the second half.

ON LAKE DAWSON'S GREAT CATCH: Just the other day in practice he made three like that, including one with one hand. I said that someday he might do it in a game. This was the first time he did it in a game. You just watch and admire something like that.

MIRER'S INTERCEPTION: He threw it into double coverage; but I called it. Dont blame Rick Mirer, blame me. That's the thing about him. You tell him to do something and he does it.

A game like this is so emotinal, it's special. The momentum goes back and forth. We've been the luckiest team in America against Southern Cal. Since I've been here we've beaten them six times and five of those games could have gone against us. I don't sit here and gleet. I have the greatest respect for Laryy Smith and his team. We've beaten some great USC teams and this team is a good one.
