	COUNTDOWN TO PUCK DROP
568	Head coach Jeff Jackson has 567 career wins, which ranks third among active NCAA Division I head coaches, spanning six seasons at Lake Superior State and now 18 seasons at Notre Dame. Jackson's win total ranks 10th all-time for most wins at the NCAA Division I level.
24	Twenty-four former Irish icers participated in NHL training camps ahead of the 2022-23 season, representing nearly half of the NHL franchises. The Toronto Maple Leafs saw a team-high four former ND players lace up their skates at their camp including Max Ellis, Matt Hellickson, Graham Slaggert and Alex Steeves.
19	The Irish return 19 letterwinners from the 2021–22 roster this season, including three graduate students in Nick Leivermann, Chase Blackmun and Jack Adams.
18	Head coach Jeff Jackson has guided his teams at Lake Superior State and Notre Dame to 18 NCAA Tournament appearances, including winning NCAA Championships with the Lakers in 1992 and 1994, while guiding the Irish to their only four Frozen Four appearances in program history: 2008, 2011, 2017 and 2018.
16	Sixteen sets of brothers have now suited up for the Irish, including current players, Landon Slaggert (brother Graham graduated in 2022), Trevor and Justin Janicke and Brady Bjork (brother Anders played 2014–17).
14	Fourteen alums have laced up their skates for an NHL team this regular season: Andrew Peeke (Columbus Blue Jackets), Anders Bjork (Buffalo Sabres), Vinnie Hinostroza (Buffalo Sabres), Riley Sheahan (Buffalo Sabres), Jake Evans (Montreal Canadians), Anders Lee (New York Islanders), Kyle Palmieri (New York Islanders), Bryan Rust (Pittsburgh Penguins), Ian Cole (Tampa Bay Lightning), Jordan Gross (Nashville Predators), Steven Fogarty (Minnesota Wild), Dennis Gilbert (Calgary Flames), Cal Burke (Colorado Avalanche) and Cal Petersen (Los Angeles Kings).
10	Veteran leadership: Notre Dame's roster features 10 seniors and graduate students in 2022-23.
8	With the most recent being the 2019 Big Ten tournament title, Notre Dame has won eight conference championships in program history – each under Jeff Jackson (three regular-season).
7	Notre Dame advanced to a NCAA Regional Final for the seventh time in program history last season. The Irish are 4–2–0 in NCAA Regional Final games
6	Notre Dame has an active six-straight NCAA tournament appearances streak, including Frozen Four appearances in 2017 and 2018, which is the longest streak in program history and is the second-longest active streak in the NCAA.

NOTES

QUICK HITS

- Notre Dame most recently split on the road at Wisconsin, dropping game one before bouncing back to a 6-4 victory Saturday night.
- Their six-goal performance was a team best in 2022-23, with Drew Bavaro, Trevor Janicke, Jesse Lansdell, and Jack Adams lighting the lamp in Saturday night's road win.
- Three individuals boasted three points in the Wisconsin series, including Bavaro and T.
 Janicke with two goals each. Lansdell also tallied a goal Saturday night along with two
 assists for a career-high night.
- Ryan Bischel picked up his nation-leading fourth shutout of the season in the team's
 first game of the calendar year, defeating Alaska, 2-0, stopping all 25 shots faced in the
 contest.
- The Irish closed out the first half of their season with an 8-8-2 record following a split with No. 5 Penn State at home to enter the holiday break.
- In game two of that series, Bischel stopped a career-high 47 saves as the Irish picked up a 5-3 win, and amassed 81 saves over the two game weekend.
- With 672 total saves this season, Bischel currently ranks second nationally in the category.

NOTRE DAME VS. MINNESOTA

- All-time, Notre Dame trails Minnesota in the series, 25-40-5.
- Earlier this season the Irish fell at the hands of the Gophers in Minnesota. Ryan Bischel set a then-career high 45 saves on night one in Minneapolis as the Irish dropped a 4-1 decision. Jack Williams also saw time between the pipes in the contest, registering five saves in the third period in 7:10 played.
- Justin Janicke net the lone Irish goal on the weekend, finding twine at 19:14 of the third to ward off the Gophers' shutout bid.
- The last time the two teams met in Indiana, the Irish split the series with a 3-2 overtime victory on night two. Landon Slaggert scored the game-winner in the contest, taking just 32 seconds of the overtime period to net the sudden death goal.

TEAM LEADERS

- Ryder Rolston and Trevor Janicke boast six goals a piece, nine assists and 15 points total, all team highs.
- Jack Adams, who scored the eventual game-winner on night two with the Badgers leads the team with three game-winning goals. His other two came against Penn State and Ohio State.
- Three individuals boast multiple powerplay tallies, with Primeau, T. Janicke and Rolston

- Ryan Bischel recorded 47 saves on the weekend against Alaska, bringing his 2022-23 season total to 672 which ranks second nationally.
- With his fourth blanking of the season Sunday night against the Nanooks, the senior leads the nation in shutouts in 2022-23.
- Always willing to jump in front of a shot, Jake Boltmann's 40 blocks leads the team and
 is 14th nationally.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- Drew Bavaro was named Big Ten Second Star of the Week, Oct. 18, by the conference
 for his performance on both sides of the puck last weekend. The offensive defenseman
 had an assist on the game-winning-goal Friday night before scoring his first goal as
 a member of the Irish on Sunday. His late powerplay goal Sunday broke the tie and
 sparked an offensive push to secure the Notre Dame victory, 5-4. The junior extended
 his point-streak to four games to start the season, a career-best.
- For his play on the defensive side of the puck, Jake Boltmann was recognised by
 Everything College Hockey as "Sponge" of the Week. The sophomore blueliner blocked
 a nation's best 14 pucks over the weekend series with NMU, including eight Sunday
 night.
- Ryan Bischel picked up his fourth career shutout when the Irish hosted the Spartans
 to close out October. In just under 125 minutes played on the weekend, the senior
 stopped 71 of 72 shots faced, posted a career-high save perfomance in game two with
 41 stops, and backstopped the Irish to a 1-0-1 record with the Spartans en route to Big
 Ten Third Star of the Week honors (Nov. 1).

ON THE RETURNERS

- With 19 returners in 2022–23, the Irish return 83 goals from last season anc 65 percent of their total scoring.
- Three of last season's top-five scorers will suit up for the blue and gold again this season, including top-scoring defenseman Nick Leivemann. The graduate student returns for his fifth season at Notre Dame and has appeared in 118 games in his collegiate career.
- The current roster includes 10 seniors and graduate students for a strong veteran core.

HEAD COACH JEFF JACKSON



- The 2022-23 season marks University of Notre Dame hockey coach
 Jeff Jackson's 18th season behind the Irish bench. During his first 17
 seasons, the program has enjoyed a great deal of success, including
 four trips to the Frozen Four and eight conference championships.
- Jackson has over 30 years of coaching experience and led Notre
 Dame to back-to-back Big Ten tournament championship seasons in
 2018 and 2019 while also guiding the Irish to the 2018 national title
 game en route to being named the Spencer Penrose Award winner
 as the National Coach of the Year.
- Jackson was also named the Spencer Penrose award winner in 2007 and he is one of just 15 coaches to have earned the honor multiple times (dating back to 1951).
- Additionally, Jackson is one of only two coaches to have earned the honor multiple times in the last 17 seasons.
- Jackson's Notre Dame teams have made 12 trips to the NCAA
 Championship (2007–09, 2011, 2013–14, 2016–19 and 2021),
 advancing to the Frozen Four four times and playing in the 2008 and 2018 national title games.
- During his 17-year run, Notre Dame has become one of the nation's top teams while playing in the Central Collegiate Hockey Association, Hockey East and now Big Ten.
- Under Jackson, the Irish won the CCHA regular-season title twice (2006–07 and 2008–09) while earning three Mason Cup championships (2007, 2009 and the final one in 2013).
- Then, in the team's first season in the Big Ten (2017–18), Notre Dame captured both the regular season and conference championships and followed up by once again winning the conference tournament in year two (2018–19).
- Jackson's success on the ice also has had a major impact off the ice
 for the Irish. With the wins came a commitment from the University
 that led to the new home of Irish hockey The Compton Family
 Ice Arena one of the finest college hockey facilities in the nation.
 The venue opened for business on Oct. 21, 2011.
- Since Jackson's arrival, the Irish have had 43 players selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft, including three first round selections.
- In that same span, 33 players from USA Hockey's National Team

 Anders Bjork in 2017, Robbie Russo in 2015, Anders Lee in 2013, Ian
 Cole and Erik Condra in 2009 and David Brown in 2007.
- In addition, 25 of Jackson's Notre Dame players have gone on to play in the NHL.
- Jackson entered the 2021-22 season with a 21-year collegiate record of 530-271-91 for a .645 winning percentage, the third-highest winning percentage among all active coaches with five years or more in Division I (entering 2021-22).
- Entering the 2022–23 season, Jackson's 558 career wins rank 11th all–time in Division I and leads all active NCAA Division I coaches).
