No. 21/21 Notre Dame 28 (3-2), Boise State 7 (3-2)

TEAM NOTES

- Boise State won the toss and deferred to the second half. Boise State kicked off and defended the south endzone.
- Attendance - 77,622 which marks the 16 consecutive sell out and 21 of the last 23 home games coached by Marcus Freeman at Notre Dame.
- Today's game marked the first meeting between Notre Dame and Boise State.
- Boise State is the sixth Mountain West opponent Notre Dame has faced in program history, and just the second in the Marcus Freeman era (2022 vs. UNLV, W, 44-21).
- Notre Dame improves to 33-6-0 against Mountain West teams and has a 17-4-0 record at Notre Dame Stadium against Mountain West foes all-time.
- It is the seventh first time-opponent for the Irish in the Marcus Freeman era.
- Coupled with last week's contest at Arkansas, it is the first time during the Marcus Freeman era that the Irish have faced off against first-time opponents in back-to-back weeks.
- Notre Dame improves to 532-131-13 in Notre Dame Stadium.
- Notre Dame is now 7-1 in Irish Wear Green contests since 2018 and improves to 3-1 when wearing green jerseys in Irish Wear Green Games.
- The Irish are now 8-1 when wearing green jerseys since 2010.
- Today marked the warmest Notre Dame home game played in October (for games in which the temperature was recorded) at 84 degrees, surpassing October 9, 2010 against Pittsburgh. The Irish won that game 23-17.
- Today's game was the sixth warmest ND home game ever (for games in which the temperature was recorded) -

NOTABLE

- WR Malachi Fields has a reception in 32 consecutive games. He entered the weekend tied with the eighth-best streak of FBS players with consecutive games with at least one catch.
- DL Jordan Botelho made his 55th-career appearance in a Notre Dame uniform this afternoon, tied for ninth in program history for most career games played.
- Today is the 22nd-consecutive start at running back for RB Jeremiyah Love, tied for fourth all-time in program history for a running back.
- With his four-yard rushing touchdown in the second quarter, Love eclipsed 30 total touchdowns in his career (24 rushing, six receiving).
- RB Jeremiyah Love totaled 103 rushing yards, his second 100+ yard rushing game of the season and seventh of his career.
- It's the 10th time that both RB Jeremiyah Love and RB Jadarian Price have scored rushing touchdowns in the same game and the fourth time this season.
- CB Leonard Moore had a career-best two interceptions on the afternoon, becoming the first Notre Dame player to have multiple interceptions in the same game since Xavier Watts on October 28, 2023 against Pittsburgh.
- It's the seventh time Notre Dame has had at least four interceptions as a team in a single game since 1996, and the first time since October 28, 2023 against Pittsburgh.
