TEAM NOTES

- Notre Dame captains OL Aamil Wagner, DL Donovan Hinish, S Adon Shuler and WR Will Pauling represented the Irish for the coin toss.
- Navy won the toss and elected to receive. Notre Dame kicked off and defended the south endzone.
- Attendance - 77,622, which marks the 19th-consecutive sellout and 24 of the last 26 home games coached by Marcus Freeman at Notre Dame.
- Notre Dame improves to 84-13-1 all-time against Navy and 33-5-0 in Notre Dame Stadium.
- Marcus Freeman improves to 4-0 against Navy and 1-0 against the Midshipmen in Notre Dame Stadium.
- Notre Dame improves to 141-23-5 against American Athletic Conference opponents.
- Notre Dame improves to 533-133-13 all-time at home.
- Tonight marked the first time Navy competed in a night game at Notre Dame Stadium.
- Tonight's game was played in a steady rain which turned to snow in the second half.
- Notre Dame was not whistled for a penalty in tonight's game, matching the school record and marking the first time the Irish played a game without a penalty since a 1997 victory at No. 11 LSU.

NOTABLE

- WR Malachi Fields' 52-yard reception on the first drive of the game gives him at least one reception in 36 consecutive games. He entered the weekend tied with the eighth-best streak of FBS players with consecutive games with at least one catch.
- RB Jeremiyah Love started his 26th consecutive game this afternoon, passing Mark Green (1985-88) for second on Notre Dame's list for consecutive running back starts. Allen Pinkett (1982-85) holds the school record in that category with 35 straight starts.
- Love's one-yard rushing touchdown in the third quarter, coupled with his 48-yard run in the third quarter, are the 36th and 37th touchdowns of his career, moving him into fifth place on the Notre Dame all-time list.
- Love's 31 rushing touchdowns moved him to sixth all-time at Notre Dame.
- DL Jordan Botelho made his 59th career appearance in a Notre Dame uniform this afternoon, which matches DJ Brown (2019-23) for seventh on the program's all-time list for game appearances.

- Jadarian Price's touchdown run in the second quarter marked the 12th time that both RB Jeremiyah Love and RB Price have rushed for a touchdown in the same game and the sixth time this season, the most by a running back duo in Notre Dame history.
- CJ Carr completed his eighth 40-yard pass of the season in the first quarter today, which is the most in a season for an Irish freshman quarterback. Steve Beuerlein had four 40-yard completions in 1983.
- Sophomore RB Aneyas Williams rushed for a career-best 72 yards today, all coming on one drive that included a 54-yard touchdown run.
- Sophomore LB Jaiden Ausberry led the team with a career-high eight tackles which included one sack, two tackles for loss and a forced fumble.
