## THE OPENING KICKOFF

- Stanford football closes out its 2025 season with a home game against No. 9 Notre Dame. Kickoff is scheduled for 7:30 p.m. PT on ESPN.
- The Cardinal is 4-1 at home and will finish with a winning record at home for the first time since 2018.
- · Stanford won the 128th Big Game on Nov. 22, defeating California 31-10 to reclaim the Axe. It was Stanford's first Big Game win since 2020 and first at home since 2017.
- No team in the country has forced more turnovers in home games during the month of November than Stanford (7). Stanford also ran back two fumbles for touchdowns against California, the first time the Cardinal has done so in a game since 2005.
- Stanford's offense has been a significantly better team at Stanford Stadium this year, averaging more than twice as many points per game (26.2) as it has on the road (12.5), including a season-high 31 points against California. From a yards-per-game perspective, Stanford is averaging 92 more yards per game at home (356.2) than on the road (264.2).
- The best tight end in the ACC is senior tight end Sam Roush. He leads all tight ends in the conference

in receiving yards (472) and is just one reception shy of having the most among ACC tight ends (45). Nationally, he ranks in the top 15 in both categories.

- CJ Williams has been one of the most consistent wide receivers in the ACC this season. He ranks fifth in the conference in receptions, eighth in receiving yards, and is tied for the ACC lead in touchdown receptions. He has four 100-yard games this season, the first Cardinal to do so since 2018.
- Micah Ford ran for 150 yards with a touchdown against the Golden Bears in Week 13. He became the first Cardinal since Austin Jones in 2020 to have three 100-yard rushing games in a season.
- · Stanford's defense has allowed the second-most trips to the red zone of any team in the country (54), but is 13th in opponents' red zone touchdown percentage (46.3%). That mark is fourth in the ACC.
- Stanford and Notre Dame are playing for The Legends Trophy this weekend. The Cardinal most recently won this coveted trophy in 2022, beating the Fighting Irish 16-14 in South Bend. The rivalry has been nearly split over the last decade-plus, with Stanford winning eight of the last 15 matchups.

## **CONTENT & WORKPLACE POLICIES**

- 1. Video clips of in-game competition, live or otherwise, online or via social media networks are not permitted. Still photos may be shared online and across social platforms during the game.
- 2. Any non-editorial or commercial use of any picture, audio, film, tape, or digital image or drawing of the event is prohibited without prior, specific, written authorization from the host institution.
- 3. Internet usage in all media areas, including media work areas, stadium pressbox, digital work room and the field, is for work-related purposes only. Media members who do not follow the proper internet procedures may have their credentials and internet access revoked for the remainder of the event.
- 4. Media should respect the work environment of their colleagues by maintaining a quiet and professional atmosphere in all working media areas. The press box will close three hours after the conclusion of the game.

## **FIELD ACCESS & SIDELINE POLICY**

Field access is limited to photographers, videographers and sideline reporters whose job function requires them to work from field level. Print media, and anyone working out of the press box, will only be permitted on the field for the final five minutes of games. No interviews should be conducted on the field.

- 1. Photo credentials will be issued only to accredited media outlets prior to the game and photo identification must be provided.
- 2. Photographers and videographers must check in at media will call located at Gate 8 of the stadium. Those photographers and videographers who will work on the sidelines will be issued a photo vest. This photo vest must be worn at all times to gain access to the sidelines. Vests must be returned after the game at the on-field dropoff location situated next to the south endzone tunnel.
- 3. Only working photographers and videographers with professional-grade cameras will be allowed on the field. Those without proper equipment or not shooting the game will be escorted from the sidelines regardless of credential.
- 4. Working photographers and videographers are permitted to shoot in the designated area (between the two marked dotted lines outside the 20-yard lines and behind the end zone).
- 5. Photographers are encouraged to use the photo work areas, located on Level 3 of Stanford Stadium. Wireless internet is available. While security in this area is provided, Stanford University is not responsible for the loss of any items.
- 6. According to NCAA policies, the presence of any type of photographer and videographer in the bench area for all sports is strictly prohibited with the exception of one (1) institutional videographer in the football bench area. According to the NCAA Football Rules and Interpretations Manual (Rule 1, Section 2, Article 4b): "the team area shall be limited to squad members in uniform and a maximum of 40 other individuals directly involved in the game. The 40 individuals not in uniform shall wear special identification." (Rule 1, Section 2, Article 4e): "No media personnel, including journalists, radio and television personnel, or their equipment, shall be in the team area or coaching box, and no media personnel shall communicate in any way with persons in the team area or coaching box." Stanford Athletics prohibits photographers and videographers from stopping and shooting from behind the bench area or into the bench area.

## THE MATCHUP

- Stanford and Notre Dame meet for the 39th time on Saturday night, closing out the regular season.
- Last season, the Cardinal scored first, but allowed 49 unanswered points en route to a 49-7 defeat, keeping The Legends Trophy with the Fighting Irish.
- Notre Dame's last visit to The Farm was a 56-23 win, but it did come with several Stanford highlights. Stanford's defense forced four turnovers, including a pair of fumbles.
- Stanford's last home win over Notre Dame came in 2017, a 38-20 victory over the Fighting Irish. That was the final win in a stretch of seven wins against Notre Dame over a nine-year span. Notre Dame has since won five of the last six matchups.
- The Legends Trophy was created by the Notre Dame Club of the San Francisco Bay Area and is made, appropriately, from Northern California redwood with an Irish crystal bowl. The Legends Trophy is named in honor of the 1925 Rose Bowl meeting, which was said by sportswriters to contain more legends on one field than had ever played the game.

## ON THIS DAY IN STANFORD HISTORY...

...the Cardinal made history by beating No. 12 Arizona 29-24 in 1986. The game was played as the Coca-Cola Bowl in Tokyo, Japan, the first time Stanford played a game in Asia. Held at Memorial Stadium, home of the 1964 Olympic Games, Brad Muster rushed for 108 yards and a touchdown. He became just the second Cardinal to eclipse 1,000 yards on the ground, joining Darrin Nelson. Greg Ennis, taking over for John Paye at quarterback, had two touchdowns and Kevin Scott returned a kickoff for a touchdown in the fourth quarter.

## **HEAD COACH FRANK REICH**

Frank Reich was named Stanford's interim head football coach on March 31, 2025, by Stanford Football General Manager Andrew Luck. The 36th head coach in program history, Reich will serve as interim head coach for the 2025 campaign.

Reich is one of the sport's most well-respected offensive minds thanks to over 30 years in professional football, combining a 14-year playing career as an NFL quarterback with 18 seasons in various coaching roles. Reich was a member of six Super Bowl teams overall, four as a player with the Buffalo Bills (1991-94), and twice as a coach.

Highly regarded in NFL circles with a knack for building lasting relationships, Reich's six-year head coaching tenure included five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts (2018-22) before his final stop at the helm of the Carolina Panthers (2023). Reich's NFL resume also includes four years as an offensive coordinator, including two seasons with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-17), the second of which resulted in the franchise's first Super Bowl title in Super Bowl LII (2018).

Reich's first season as Indianapolis head coach in 2018 coincided with the final season of Luck's playing career. Despite a 1-5 start, Reich guided the Colts to a

10-6 overall record and an appearance in the Divisional Round of the NFL Playoffs during a season that was highlighted by Luck earning Pro Bowl honors while being named the NFL Comeback Player of the Year.

Reich's coaching career also includes two seasons as the offensive coordinator of the San Diego Chargers (2014-15), following stints as quarterbacks coach, wide receivers coach, and offensive coaching staff assistant with Indianapolis and Arizona. A coaching staff member of two Super Bowl-winning franchises, Reich also served as an offensive staff assistant when Indianapolis won Super Bowl XLI (2007).

Selected in the third round (57th overall) of the 1985 NFL Draft by the Buffalo Bills, Reich's NFL career spanned 14 seasons and four organizations, with his last four years split between the Carolina Panthers (1995), New York Jets (1996), and Detroit Lions (1997-98). Reich threw for 40 touchdowns and passed for 6,075 yards, making 20 starts over a 118-game career.

A native of Lebanon, Pennsylvania, Reich spent his first nine seasons in Buffalo, mostly serving in a backup role to Pro Football Hall of Famer Jim Kelly. Reich's trademark dependability and willingness to stay ready were among his most notable strengths as a player, resulting in one of the most memorable moments in NFL playoff history. In a wild card round game on Jan. 3, 1993, host Buffalo overcame a 35-3 third-quarter deficit to defeat the Houston Oilers 41-38 in overtime to set a record for the largest comeback in NFL history at the time. Starting in place of Kelly, who sustained an injury one week earlier, Reich engineered the historic comeback and completed 21 of 34 passes for 289 yards and four touchdowns.

Before authoring what still stands as the largest comeback in NFL postseason history, Reich was also responsible for the then-largest comeback in NCAA history. Reich, who played collegiately at Maryland from 1980-84 and spent his first three seasons backing up Boomer Esiason, rallied the Terrapins from a 31-0 halftime deficit to a 42-40 victory over the defending national champion Miami Hurricanes at the Miami Orange Bowl on Nov. 10, 1984. Reich finished 108-for-169 and threw for 1,446 yards and nine touchdowns as a senior in 1984, with his six touchdowns against the Hurricanes remaining the school's single-game record.

Reich was a three-sport athlete in football, basketball, and baseball at Cedar Crest High School in Lebanon, Pennsylvania. The team's starting quarterback over his final two seasons, Reich participated in the 1980 edition of the Big 33 Football Classic, an annual all-star game comprising the top high-school players in Pennsylvania.

## **TRENDING UP**

In the first year with Andrew Luck as General Manager, Stanford has won four games. The Cardinal had not recorded a four-win season since 2020, after going 3-9 from 2021-2024. 2025 is the first season since 2015 that

Stanford has won more games than it did the previous season

A win against No. 9 Notre Dame in the season finale would give Stanford wins against California and Notre Dame in the same season for the first time since 2017.

## IF I HAD TWO DOZEN ROSES...

Matt Rose has blossomed into one of the best linebackers in the ACC, and he just turned in arguably one of the best games of the season by a linebacker.

Rose ranks second in the ACC in total tackles with 97, and has been stuffing the stat sheet all season long. He's added eight tackles-for-loss, three sacks, three passes defended, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery.

In the 128th Big Game against California, Rose set a new career-high in tackles with 14, and added a sack and a fumble recovery. He is the only Power 4 linebacker to post that stat line in a game this season, and the first ACC player to do so since Payton Wilson of NC State in 2023.

## **GIMME THAT!**

Highlighted by its best defensive performance of the season in the 128th Big Game, Stanford's defense has returned to its ball-hawking ways.

The Cardinal ran back two fumbles for touchdowns against the Golden Bears during Big Game, giving the team four defensive touchdowns this season, the team's most since 2016. Big Game was the first time since 2013 Stanford scored twice defensively in the same game, and the first time since 2005 its defense had two fumble recovery touchdowns in a game.

In two home games this month, Stanford has forced seven turnovers, the most by any FBS team in home games during the month of November.

## **DEFENSIVE TRENDS**

While Stanford's defense might not have signs of being one of the best in the nation, it continues to improve under year three of the current staff, and in year one of Andy Thompson calling plays.

The Cardinal is surrendering 397.6 yards per game to opponents, which is on pace for the fewest yards per game allowed since 2016. Stanford's defense is allowing 27.2 points per game; the last time Stanford allowed fewer than 30 points per game was in 2018. Additionally, Stanford is allowing 113.1 rushing yards per game, on track for the program's lowest since 2014. It would also be the fourth year in a row that Stanford improves its rush defense.

## **FARM FRESH**

Stanford closes the season with its final two regularseason games at home. The Cardinal has been notably better across the board inside Stanford Stadium this season.

All four of Stanford's wins have come at home, holding a 4-1 home record compared to 0-6 away from home the team's first winless season on the road since 2002. Stanford's offense has been significantly better at home. The Cardinal has scored 100 points in four home games (25 points per game) and just 75 points in six road games (12.5 points per game). Stanford is averaging 374.8 yards per game at home compared to just 264.2 on the road, a difference of over 110 yards per game.

Defensively, Stanford has shown an ability to create more turnovers in home games. The Cardinal ranks 20th in the country in turnovers forced at home (11). Eight of those are fumbles, which trails only North Texas for the most in FBS.

Since the start of the 2023 season, Stanford has forced 29 turnovers at home and just 11 in road games.

## **BUILT FORD TOUGH**

Micah Ford has blossomed into a true bell cow back. The sophomore from Toms River, N.J. has been a key cog in Stanford's offensive success all season.

Ford has 643 rushing yards in nine games this season with four rushing touchdowns. The last Cardinal running back with four rushing touchdowns in a season was Casey Filkins in 2022. His 643 rushing yards are the most in a season by a Stanford running back since Cameron Scarlett in 2019 (840).

Against California, Ford ran for 150 yards with a touchdown, his third 100-yard game of the season and his second 150-yard game. Austin Jones is the last Cardinal with at least three 100-yard rushing games in a season. Ford is the first Cardinal since Bryce Love in 2017 with multiple games of 150 rushing yards or more.

The future of the running back position at Stanford is in good hands. Both Ford (sophomore) and Tabb (redshirt freshman) have over 400 rushing yards and three rushing touchdowns this year. The last time Stanford had two underclassmen accomplish that in the same season was 2010, when Stepfán Taylor, Anthony Wilkerson, and Andrew Luck all did it.

## THE CASE FOR ALL-AMERICA

Stanford has a pair of offensive standouts who have strong cases for All-America honors in 2025. CJ Williams and Sam Roush have been important contributors to the Cardinal offense and rank among some of the best at their position in the conference and NCAA.

A senior transfer from Wisconsin who began his career at USC, Williams has blossomed into the most reliable target for Stanford quarterbacks this season. He has 58 receptions for 735 yards and six touchdowns, with all six of his scores coming in the last six games.

Among ACC receivers, Williams is fifth in receptions, ranks eighth in receiving yards, and is tied for the ACC lead in touchdown receptions. Since Week 4, Williams

is inside the top-20 nationally in receptions (50) and receiving yards (673).

Williams hauled in seven passes for 122 yards and two touchdowns against Pittsburgh in Week 10, his first career multi-touchdown game. He eclipsed the 100-yard mark for the fourth time this season, becoming the first Cardinal since J.J. Arcega-Whiteside in 2018 to do so. Only five other Stanford wide receivers have done so four or more times in a season since 1995.

Earlier this season, Williams had 100 receiving yards in three consecutive games, becoming the first Stanford player to achieve that feat since Alex Smith in 2004, and the first Stanford wide receiver to do so since Troy Walters in 1999.

A senior from Nashville, Tenn., Roush has put together the best season of his career and is among the best tight ends in the country, restoring Stanford's moniker of Tight End U.

Roush has compiled 45 receptions for 472 yards with a pair of touchdowns, setting career highs across the board. He leads ACC tight ends in receiving yards and is second in receptions, one shy of the conference lead. Nationally, Roush ranks sixth among Power-4 tight ends in receptions and 13th in receiving yards.

Against Pittsburgh, Roush went over the 100-yard mark for the first time in his collegiate career, piling up 104 receiving yards. He became just the eighth different Cardinal tight end since 1995 to eclipse 100 receiving yards in a game, and the first since Benjamin Yurosek in 2023.

Roush has also shown his ability to turn intermediate routes into big plays. He has two catches of at least 50 yards this season, one of just five tight ends in the nation and the only tight end in the ACC to do so.

## **KEEPING IT 100**

Through 10 games, Stanford has eight individual 100-yard receiving performances. The last time Stanford had at least eight 100-yard receiving games from individuals came in 2018 (11).

Some of these big receiving games have come in the same game. Farrell and Williams both went for over 100 yards at Virginia, and one week later, Williams and Caden High topped the 100-yard mark against San Jose State. Stanford's offense had not seen multiple 100-yard games from receivers in consecutive games since the 1998 season during games six and seven.

Against Pittsburgh, Stanford added another pair of 100-yard receivers (Williams and Roush), the third time in 2025 the Cardinal has had multiple 100-yard receivers in the same game. That 2018 season was once again the last season with such an occurrence for Stanford.

## **BEND, BUT DON'T BREAK**

Stanford's defense has been great at preventing touchdowns when in the red zone. Stanford has allowed the second-most red zone trips of any team in the country (54), but has allowed just 25 red zone touchdowns. The opponents' success rate of 46.3% is 13th in FBS and fourth in the ACC.

## **ANOTHER TOUGH ACC SLATE**

Stanford finished its first season in the ACC with the second-most difficult schedule in the conference. That trend is continuing in 2025, where Stanford's schedule through 11 games has been the toughest in the ACC, according to ESPN's Strength of Schedule index.

Despite playing just one ranked team so far in 2025 (No. 9 Miami), Stanford has played four additional games against teams that are now ranked in the top 15 (No. 11 BYU, No. 17 Virginia, No. 24 Pittsburgh, No. 25 SMU). Stanford's seven losses have been to teams that are a combined 55-22.

Stanford's schedule ranks as the 32nd-toughest in FBS. 15 of the 31 teams with more difficult schedules are in the SEC. Syracuse and NC State are the only teams in the ACC with a more difficult schedule to this point. Eight of Stanford's 12 opponents are currently bowleligible.

## TRANSFER TALK

One year after having the second fewest transfers in FBS behind Clemson, Stanford has made a splash in the transfer portal. The Cardinal welcomed 17 transfers for the 2025 season, more than all previous transfers in program history combined (14). Six of those transfers came in during the winter quarter, giving Stanford nine winter enrollees (including three freshmen), also the most the program has ever seen in one winter.

Stanford made significant upgrades on the offensive side of the ball, bringing in nine transfers. Four of the nine transfers are at wide receiver, helping make up for the loss of Elic Ayomanor in the NFL Draft. Offensive line has also been an area of need for the Cardinal, and the team addressed that by bringing in four offensive linemen

From 2024 to 2025, Stanford added 13 more transfers from the prior season. That is the seventh-largest increase in transfers taken in by an FBS program.

## **CARDINAL CRISSCROSS**

With existing non-conference clashes on the schedule before the transition to the ACC, the 2025 Stanford football schedule is one of the more unique schedules in the NCAA. Stanford is the only FBS program to play in five time zones in 2025. The Cardinal played at Hawai'i (Hawaii-Aleutian Time Zone) and will play at BYU (Mountain Time Zone), at SMU (Central Time Zone), three games in the Eastern Time Zone, and all six home games will be played in the Pacific Time Zone.

Nine other FBS programs are playing in four different time zones in 2025: BYU, Houston, Iowa State, Middle Tennessee State, Nevada, Sam Houston State, TCU, Utah, and West Virginia.

When taking the distance from each road opponent's stadium to Stanford Stadium, the Cardinal traveled 23,503 miles to its opponents in 2025.

In the ACC, the next closest school in terms of 2025 travel miles is Syracuse at 10,578 miles.

## **ACC HISTORY**

The Cardinal went on the road in its ACC debut and took down Syracuse 26-24 on Sept. 20, 2024. It was the first time since 1919 that Stanford played a conference game as a new member.

Stanford joined seven other full-time schools - Duke, North Carolina, Maryland, Florida State, Miami, Louisville, and Virginia Tech, as well as Notre Dame (2020) - in winning its first conference game as a member of the ACC. SMU became the ninth team to do so when it won its first ACC game on Sept. 28. Only

Duke's and Maryland's wins also came on the road, both in 1953.

The Cardinal beat Boston College in Week 3 this season to start ACC play 1-0 for the second consecutive season. The last time Stanford began conference play 1-0 in back-to-back seasons came in 2015-16 when Stanford was in the Pac-12.

Stanford continues to square off as ACC rivals against a number of new foes in 2025. The Cardinal faced Virginia, Florida State and Miami for the first time in program history. Stanford has played every ACC team except Georgia Tech and Duke. Both are on the schedule for 2026.

## **RECENT DRAFT SUCCESS**

The Cardinal has had 57 draft picks since 2010, fourth among ACC schools, behind only Miami, Florida State, and Clemson. Stanford has nine consensus All-Americans since 2010, and its 22 Academic All-Americans in that span are the most among FBS schools.

In the 2025 NFL Draft, the Cardinal saw Elic Ayomanor get drafted by the Tennessee Titans in the fourth round. He became the 282nd all-time player to be drafted out of Stanford, and the fifth wide receiver since 2019.

## STANFORD IN THE NFL

There is a rich tradition of Stanford success in the NFL, and that tradition is still alive in the 2025 NFL season. There are currently 29 former Cardinal on NFL rosters, with 28 active.

No player in the NFL has scrimmage yards than Christian McCaffrey through 11 weeks. Over the last two games, McCaffrey has scored five touchdowns, and now has 17 career games with a rushing and receiving touchdown, an NFL record. He also has over 700 rushing and receiving yards this season, the third player in NFL history to do so through 11 games.

Doing what he does best, New York Giants linebacker Bobby Okereke is still one of the best tacklers in the league. Okereke is fifth in tackles through 11 weeks with 103, including 16 in Week 1 against Washington. Okereke has finished inside the top-10 in the NFL in tackles twice in his career (2022-23).

Tight ends continue to be a staple, with six active in the NFL. Colby Parkinson has scored touchdowns in three consecutive games for the 9-2 Los Angeles Rams, tied for the best record in the NFL. His touchdown streak is the longest of his career.

Michael Wilson had one of the best receiving games of the 2025 NFL season in Week 11 against San Francisco. The third-year Arizona receiver caught 15 passes for 185 yards, the most receiving yards in a game recorded this year in the NFL. His 15 receptions are the most by a former Stanford wide receiver at the NFL level. Over his last two games, he has 25 catches for 303 yards.

## **EPITOME OF A STANFORD MAN**

Stanford student-athletes go on to achieve great things at the professional level, both on the field and off. During the 2024 NFL season, both Curtis Robinson (San Francisco 49ers) and Solomon Thomas (New York Jets) were nominees for the Walter Payton Man of the Year award. Stanford was one of four FBS programs to have multiple nominees for the award, joining Baylor, California, and Notre Dame.

Widely regarded as the league's most prestigious honor, it was renamed in 1999 after the late Hall of Fame running back, Walter Payton. Each team nominates one player who has had a significant positive impact on their community.

Curtis Robinson focuses on education in his community efforts, inspired by his mother's dedicated career as a college professor. He participates regularly with the 49ers' EDU stadium classroom and Social Justice Player Committees, as well as coaching over 400 youth in flag football events. Solomon Thomas continued to champion mental health awareness with impactful public appearances and community efforts, using each opportunity to empower others with tools to recognize signs of struggle and foster supportive environments.

#### WHERE THEY'RE FROM

Stanford student-athletes on this year's roster hail from 30 states, plus Canada.

There is a total of 13 student-athletes from Texas, the largest representation of student-athletes from outside of California (29) on the team. Behind Texas is Georgia (6), while Florida, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and Tennessee all have five. Two student-athletes are from Canada (Brendan Delaney and Benedict Umeh).

## **ANDREW LUCK RETURNS**

One day after the 2024 season came to a close, Stanford announced Andrew Luck's return to the program as the Football General Manager, a newly created position that oversees all aspects of the Cardinal Football program.

One of the most transformative student-athletes in school history, Luck produced a record-setting collegiate career while leading the Cardinal to national prominence. A 2012 graduate with a bachelor's degree in architectural design who returned to Stanford to finish his master's degree in education in 2023, Luck led the Cardinal to a 31-7 overall record from 2009-11 after redshirting the 2008 campaign. Luck was a two-time Heisman Trophy runner-up (2010-11) and concluded the 2011 season as the recipient of the Maxwell Award, Walter Camp Foundation Player of the Year Award, and Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award.

In his new role, Luck will be tasked with overseeing the Cardinal Football program, including working with Coach Reich on recruiting and roster management, and with athletics and university leadership on fundraising, alumni relations, sponsorships, student-athlete support, and stadium experience.

Luck was selected as the No. 1 overall pick of the Indianapolis Colts in the 2012 NFL Draft, competing for seven seasons from 2012-18. Earning Pro Bowl honors in each of his first three seasons and four overall, Luck led the NFL in passing touchdowns (40) in 2014 and was named the league's Comeback Player of the Year in 2018.

Luck's commitment in the classroom was equally impressive as a 2011 First-Team Academic All-American and Academic All-America of the Year. He was also a three-time first-team conference academic honoree and member of the NFF Hampshire Honor Society. In June 2024, Luck was named to the College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-America Hall of Fame, becoming Stanford's first honoree and joining his father, Oliver, a 2000 inductee, as the organization's first father-son duo.

Since he retired from the NFL, Luck and his wife, Nicole, a former Cardinal gymnast who also graduated in 2012, have been consistently involved in both university and athletic department initiatives. The couple has two daughters, Lucy and Penelope.

## TWO ADDITIONS TO STANFORD HOF

The Stanford Athletics Hall of Fame welcomed 10 former student-athletes on Sept. 27, including former football greats David DeCastro and Tank Williams.

(women's soccer), Jeanette Pohlen (women's basketball), Chasson Randle (men's basketball) and Tank Williams (football).

DeCastro is recognized as the best guard in program history, starting all 39 games he played in, helping lead Stanford to three bowl games, including a win in the 2011 Orange Bowl. A 2011 unanimous First Team All-America selection, DeCastro was selected No. 24 overall by the Pittsburgh Steelers in the 2012 NFL Draft and spent nine seasons with the Steelers, making six Pro Bowls while being named All-Pro three times.

Williams was the first Stanford defensive back to earn First Team All-America honors (2001), capping off a terrific career that saw him record nine interceptions, including five as a senior. He was a member of two bowl teams, including the 2000 Rose Bowl Game. He was drafted in the second round (No. 45 overall) by the Tennessee Titans in the 2002 NFL Draft and spent seven seasons in the league, finishing fourth in the 2002 AP Defensive Rookie of the Year voting.

#### **SOFTBALL AND...ROCK AND ROLL?**

No stranger to hosting premier events, Stanford Stadium added two first-time events in 2025. Stanford softball called Stanford Stadium its home during the 2025 season as construction of a new, state-of-the-art softball stadium is underway. Following the conclusion of the season, Stanford Stadium transitioned to hosting British rock band Coldplay in the first North American shows of the 2025 portion of its Music Of The Spheres World Tour.

The football stadium turned into one of the most unique softball stadiums in the country for the 2025 season. Home plate was nestled into the southwest corner of the stadium, creating picturesque views of the stadium from behind the backstop, with the stadium's arches looking down upon the playing surface from left field. It was a banner year for Stanford softball, as the Cardinal went 22-4 at home and set the NCAA softball single-game attendance record with a crowd of 13,207 against Cal during Big Swing on April 19.

Following softball season, Stanford Stadium turned into one of the biggest rock-n-roll venues in the Bay Area when it hosted Coldplay's Music Of The Spheres World Tour for shows on May 31 and June 1. These shows kicked off the North American leg of the 2025 portion of Coldplay's tour, which also featured performances in Las Vegas, Denver, Boston, Nashville, and Miami, among other shows in the United States. It was the band's first appearance in the United States during the Music Of The Spheres Tour since Oct. 1, 2023, when it played at the Rose Bowl.

Stanford Stadium's rich history includes the 1928 moment when Herbert Hoover, a former Stanford football student manager, delivered his acceptance speech as the Republican presidential candidate. In 1962, amidst the Cold War tensions, track coach Payton Jordan brought the USA-USSR dual meet to the stadium. The stadium also witnessed Super Bowl XIX between the San Francisco 49ers and Miami Dolphins and hosted six soccer matches during the 1994 World Cup.

## THE HOME OF CHAMPIONS

Stanford has won at least one NCAA team title in each of the past 49 years (dating back to the 1976-77 campaign), the longest streak in NCAA history. Stanford leads the NCAA with 137 team titles, including two national team championships during the 2024-25 campaign - women's water polo and women's rowing, increasing its overall total to 173. Stanford is one of six programs with at least one national championship in football, baseball, and men's basketball, and the only school with at least one in football, baseball, men's and women's basketball.

From 1995-2019, Stanford won 25 straight Division I Learfield Sports Directors' Cups. The Cardinal enters the 2025-26 year with 26 of the 31 total Directors' Cups, most recently capturing the elusive award during the 2022-23 season.

## **STANFORD SCORIGAMI**

Scorigami is a concept developed by Jon Bois at SB Nation that has taken over social media in recent years. Scorigami tracks final scores that have never happened before, initially in the NFL, and now for Stanford football. Through Week 13 of the 2025 season, there have been 724 unique results in Stanford football history. The following are the Stanford Scorigami results for the 2025 season:

- Hawai'i 23, Stanford 20. No Scorigami. Stanford lost to UCLA by that score in 2008.
- BYU 27, Stanford 3. No Scorigami. Stanford lost to California by that score in 2005.

INTERIM HEAD COACH
1ST SEASON AT STANFORD
6 SEASONS AS NFL HEAD COACH
(2018-2022 INDIANAPOLIS, 2023 CAROLINA)

Frank Reich was named Stanford's interim head football coach March 31, 2025 by Stanford Football General Manager Andrew Luck.

The 36th head coach in program history, Reich will serve as interim head coach for the 2025 campaign.

"I could not be more excited for our coaches, staff and players to have Frank as our head football coach for the 2025 season," said Luck, who was named to his newly-created post on Nov. 30, 2024. "I have experienced first-hand the incredible impact Frank has demonstrated as a leader and have full confidence he is the perfect steward for this season of Stanford Football. Frank is a teacher, a winner and a coach of the highest caliber. Frank's values align seamlessly with our vision for this program and I firmly believe in his ability to maximize the on-field potential of our student-athletes while serving as a role model in all aspects of their personal growth."

Reich is one of the sport's most well-respected offensive minds thanks to over 30 years in professional football, combining a 14-year playing career as an NFL quarterback with 18 seasons in various coaching roles. Reich was a member of six Super Bowl teams overall, four as a player with the Buffalo Bills (1991-94), and twice as a coach.

Highly regarded in NFL circles with a knack for building lasting relationships, Reich's six-year head coaching tenure included five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts (2018-22) before his final stop at the helm of the Carolina Panthers (2023). Reich's NFL resume also includes four years as an offensive coordinator, including two seasons with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-17), the second of which resulted in the franchise's first Super Bowl title in Super Bowl LII (2018).

Reich's first season as Indianapolis head coach in 2018 coincided with the final season of Luck's playing career. Despite a 1-5 start, Reich guided the Colts to a 10-6 overall record and an appearance in the Divisional Round of the NFL Playoffs during a season that was highlighted by Luck earning Pro Bowl honors while being named the NFL Comeback Player of the Year.

"I am thrilled to be working with Andrew again to help take an important step in establishing his vision for the Stanford Football program," said Reich. "Andrew is an elite leader and competitor, and those traits, along with his genuine passion for this university, resonated in every way and inspired me to accept this role. The unique responsibility to mentor the best student-athletes in the world, to be the absolute best in what they aspire to do, is an opportunity I will fully embrace."

Reich's coaching career also includes two seasons as the offensive coordinator of the San Diego Chargers (2014-15), following stints as quarterbacks coach, wide receivers coach and offensive coaching staff assistant with Indianapolis and Arizona. A coaching staff member of two Super Bowl winning franchises, Reich also served as an offensive staff assistant when Indianapolis won Super Bowl XLI (2007).

Selected in the third round (57th overall) of the 1985 NFL Draft by the Buffalo Bills, Reich's NFL career spanned 14 seasons and four organizations, with his last four years split between the Carolina Panthers (1995), New York Jets (1996) and Detroit Lions (1997-98). Reich threw for 40 touchdowns and passed for 6,075 yards, making 20 starts over a 118-game career.

A native of Lebanon, Pennsylvania, Reich spent his first nine seasons in Buffalo, mostly serving in a backup role to Pro Football Hall of Famer Jim Kelly. Reich's trademark dependability and willingness to stay ready were among his most notable strengths as a player, resulting in one of the most memorable moments in NFL playoff history. In a wild card round game on Jan. 3, 1993, host Buffalo overcame a 35-3 third-quarter deficit to defeat the Houston Oilers 41-38 in overtime to set a record for the largest comeback in NFL history at the time. Starting in place of Kelly, who sustained an injury one week earlier, Reich engineered the historic comeback and completed 21 of 34 passes for 289 yards and four touchdowns.

Prior to authoring what still stands as the largest comeback in NFL postseason history, Reich was also responsible for the then-largest comeback in NCAA history. Reich, who played collegiately at Maryland from 1980-84 and spent his first three seasons backing up Boomer Esiason, rallied the Terrapins from a 31-0 halftime deficit to a 42-40 victory over the defending national champion Miami Hurricanes at the Miami Orange Bowl on Nov. 10, 1984. Reich finished 108-for-169 and threw for 1,446 yards and nine touchdowns as a senior in 1984, with his six touchdowns against the Hurricanes remaining the school's single-game record.

Reich was a three-sport athlete in football, basketball and baseball at Cedar Crest High School in Lebanon, Pennsylvania. The team's starting quarterback over his final two seasons, Reich participated in the 1980 edition of the Big 33 Football Classic, an annual all-star game comprising the top high-school players in Pennsylvania.

Reich's father, Frank Sr., played collegiately at Penn State and was drafted by the Philadelphia Eagles in the 14th round of the 1956 NFL Draft.

Reich, 63, and his wife, Linda, have three daughters, Lia, Aviry and Hannah, and four grandchildren.
