KEY MIZZOU NUMBERS

- Senior Mark Mitchell is the only player in the nation tallying 17 points, six boards and three assists, while also shooting 60 percent.
- The Tigers have won their last three conference challenge matchups and are 8-4 all-time.
- At 8-0, Mizzou is one of 25 teams left in the nation that is unbeaten and can match its best start over the last 12 seasons with a win Tuesday.
- A total of 10 different Tigers have scored at least 10 points in a game this season.
- Of the Tigers' eight victories, six have been by at least 20 points this season the most in the country.
- The Tigers rank first in the nation with a field goal mark of 55.5 percent.

ABOUT THE TIGERS

- Missouri is a perfect 8-0 through its first eight games of the season.
- MU has won its last three games by 25-plus points coming off an 86-59 win over Cleveland State.
- Mark Mitchell leads MU with 17.1 points and 3.5 assists, while ranking second with 6.3 rebounds.
- Overall, five Tigers are scoring in double figures with Jayden Stone (13.3), Jacob Crews (13.1), Anthony Robinson II (10.6) and Sebastian Mack (10.6) follow Mitchell's lead.
- Shawn Phillips Jr. leads MU with 7.2 rebounds.
- The Tigers are averaging 92.9 points per game in 2025-26 – shooting 55.5 percent from the field and 39.1 percent from 3-point range.

ABOUT THE FIGHTING IRISH

- Notre Dame is 5-3 on the season, coming off a 1-2 trip to the Players Era Festival with a win over Rutgers and losses to Kansas and Houston.
- Markus Burton leads the Irish with 20.1 points and 2.8 assists per game, while Jalen Haralson also scores in double figures with 13.1 points.
- Carson Towt has a team-best 10.4 rebounds.
- Notre Dame is scoring 75.4 points per game with a scoring defense of 67.3 points.

SERIES HISTORY

- The schools have met nine times previously dating back to the 1980 NCAA Tournament with Mizzou holding a 7-2 advantage against the Irish.
- The Tigers won that first meeting with an 87-84 overtime victory to advance to the Sweet 16.
- The teams last met during the 2011-12 campaign with Mizzou earning an 87-58 win in Kansas City.
- While the Tigers do own a 7-2 advantage in the all-time series, they are just 1-2 at Notre Dame.

MIZZOU VERSUS ACC

- Missouri owns a 15-20 all-time record against schools from the ACC with 19 of the 35 meetings coming on a neutral court.
- The Tigers are 2-0 against ACC schools under Coach Gates – defeating Pittsburgh in 2023 and California last season.

ACC/SEC CHALLENGE

- Mizzou and Notre Dame are meeting on the first day of the third-annual ACC/SEC Challenge.
- Mizzou owns a record of 8-4 in league challenge series – 3-1 versus Pac 10, 3-3 versus Big 12 and 2-0 versus ACC with its victories at Pitt two years ago and over California last season, 98-93.
- Coupled with its win versus No. 12 Iowa State in 2022-23, the Tigers have won their last three conference challenge games.
- Additionally, MU is 2-4 in road challenge games, defeating Oregon in 2010 and Pitt in 2023.

PERFECT THROUGH EIGHT

- The Tigers ended the month of November the same way they started undefeated.
- Mizzou is currently one of 25 undefeated schools remaining in the nation.
- With a win on Tuesday, the Tigers would match the 2022-23 team with the school's best start in the last 12 seasons – posting identical 9-0 starts.

DOMINATING WINS

- Not only has Mizzou won all eight of its games in 2025-26 but it has done so in a big way.
- The Tigers have won their last three games by at least 25 points and have won six games this season by 20 or more points.
- Mizzou leads all teams in the nation with six wins by at least 20 points in 2025-26.
- Highlighting the dominating wins was a 23-point victory over Minnesota, marking Mizzou's largest in 146 games against Big Ten opponents.
- Overall, the Tigers rank 11th nationally with a scoring margin of +24.8 points.

DOUBLE-DIGIT THREATS

- The key to the MU's success on the offensive side this season is its number of weapons.
- Of the 12 players to feature for MU this year, 10 have scored in double figures at least once.
- Junior **Luke Northweather** is the most recent to do so scoring 10 in Friday's win over CSU.
- Twice this season, Mizzou has had at least six players score 10 points in a game this season.

MARK MITCHELL SHINES EARLY

- Mark Mitchell has led the charge for Mizzou and has started the season on an elite level.
- Mitchell has averaged a team-best 17.1 points shooting 64.4 percent from the field – while also leading MU with 3.5 assists and ranking second with 6.3 rebounds per game.
- In fact, he is one of just 10 players in the nation averaging 17.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists, plus the only player to do so while shooting 60-plus percent.

EARLY NATIONAL LEADER

- The Tigers have not wasted any of time finding their shooting touch in 2025-26.
- MU is making 55.5 percent of its field goals this season with a 3-point clip of 39.1 percent.
- In fact, Mizzou currently ranks first nationally with its 55.5 percent overall clip and 30th with its 3-point percentage of 39.1. It also ranks third in the country with an effective field goal mark of 62.6 percent.

HOT SHOOTING LEADS THE WAY

- The key to the Tigers ranking among the nation's best shooters is their consistency
- Mizzou has eclipsed 50 percent shooting in seven of eight games this season.
- The Tigers lead all teams in the nation with their seven games of making half of their field goals.

40 PERCENT OR LOWER

- The Tiger have been nearly as strong by holding teams to shoot under 40 percent.
- Mizzou is currently one of 17 schools (of 365) to hold a team under 40 percent shooting six times in 2025-26.
- Coupled with its strong shooting, MU has made 50 percent of its field goals, while holding its opponent under 40 in the same game a total of five times this season the most nationally.

50 PERCENT OR BETTER

- As Mizzou continues to make 50 percent of its field goals, it continues to pile up the wins.
- The 50 percent mark is almost a guaranteed win for the Tigers as MU is now 37-1 under Coach Gates when hitting the mark, including 19-0 since the start of the 2024-25 season.

DOMINATING THE PAINT

- The best way to have a high shooting percentage is to take close shots and that's exactly where the Tigers have thrived in 2025-26.
- MU is outscoring teams, 378-162, in the paint this season an average of 47.3 to 20.3 (+27.0).
- On Nov. 9, Mizzou outscored VMI, 60-2, in the paint. The 60 points scored are the third most by MU under Coach Gates, while the two points are easily the lowest allowed (previous low was 16).

SECOND-CHANCE POINTS

- When the Tigers do miss a shot, they have been very strong still converting that into points.
- Missouri is currently averaging 18.9 secondchance points per game.
- Twice this season, Mizzou has totaled at least 30 second-change points in a game – 30 versus VMI on Nov. 9 and 36 in last Tuesday's win versus South Carolina State.
- Prior to the season, MU had not scored 30 points after offensive boards in a single game since a double overtime win against Texas A&M in 2014.

SCORING DEPTH

- Overall, Mizzou features one of the nation's deepest teams in 2025-26.
- The Tigers are one of three teams in the SEC to feature five players averaging at least 10 points per game.

3-POINT WEAPONS

- Behind the team's top-40 3-point shooting team are a number of weapons beyond the arc.
- Four Tigers are currently shooting 40-plus percent from 3-point range – Luke Northweather (57.9),
 Jacob Crews (48.8), Anthony Robinson II (44.0) and Jayden Stone (41.7).
- The Tigers are one of just 10 teams nationally with four players making more than one triple per game and shooting 40-plus percent.

THE CREWS MISSILE

- Jacob Crews' strong shooting early this season shouldn't be much of a surprise as he finished his first season in the Black & Gold strong as well.
- In his last 14 games of 2024-25, Crews shot 38.9 percent from 3-point range after sinking 29.2 percent in his first 19 games at Mizzou.
- Crews has gone even further this season as he is now averaging 13.1 points in just 21.1 minutes with a 3-point mark of 48.8 percent.
- Crews currently ranks 27th in the nation with his 3-point clip of 48.8 percent in 2025-26.

RETURNERS & TRANSFER BALANCE

- The new-look Tigers feature a strong balance of returning players and newcomers.
- The seven returners to see action hold a slight edge in points, assists and steals, while the five newcomers have the edge in boards and blocks.

ROBINSON LEADS MU DEFENSE

- Junior Anthony Robinson II entered the 2025-26 season as the frontrunner for the league's Defensive Player of the Year accolade.
- Robinson was named to the SEC's five-man All-Defensive Team as a sophomore. In fact, he is the only player returning from last year's team.
- Robinson finished last year second in the SEC and 38th nationally with 2.03 steals per game.
- He picked up where he left off last year, leading Mizzou with 17 swipes in eight games in 2025-26, placing 64th with 2.13 per game.

PHILLIPS DOUBLES UP

- Senior center **Shawn Phillips Jr.** has made a splash early in his tenure in the Black & Gold.
- Phillips has collected two double-doubles in four games – one in the opener at Howard (16 points and 11 boards) and another versus Prairie View A&M (12 points and 13 rebounds).
- The double-double in the opener is the first for a Tiger in his MU debut since Ronnie DeGray in 2021.
- Through six games this season, Phillips has tallied 9.7 points and a team-best 7.2 rebounds.

GETTING TO THE LINE

- A large key to MU's success the past two seasons is the team's march to the free-throw line.
- Last season, the Tigers ranked second nationally with 19.7 makes per game from the free-throw line and third with 27.0 attempts.
- MU returned its top two players in free-throw attempts in Mark Mitchell (212) and Anthony Robinson II (140), while also adding Sebastian Mack, who led UCLA with 136 attempts last year.
- Through eight games this year, MU is averaging 17.9 made free throws per game.
- Additionally, Mitchell ranks 18th nationally with 62 free-throw attempts this season and 37th in the country with 43 makes.

WELCOME BACK

- Two Tigers have made successful returns to the lineup after missing multiple weeks to start the season with injuries.
- Sophomore Annor Boateng missed the season's first five games and is now averaging 8.3 points and 2.3 rebounds in 14.8 minutes.
- Boateng has scored in double figures in each of the last two games – just the second and third time he has tallied 10-plus points in his career.
- After missing his true freshman season and the first six games of his redshirt season, Trent Burns made his debut last Tuesday with seven points, three boards and one block versus South Carolina State.

EFFICIENT DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- Senior Jevon Porter had his most productive game in the Black & Gold on Nov. 17.
- Against South Dakota, Porter recorded his first double-double as a Tiger with 19 points and 12 boards, making all nine of his field goals in the win.
- Porter had the best shooting day by a Tiger since Amari Davis shot 10-of-10 at Ole Miss in 2022.
- Porter is the first Tiger to shoot 100 percent from the field and record a double-double since Ricardo Ratliffe did so in 2012 against Oklahoma.
- Overall, Porter is tallying 8.0 points, 5.3 rebounds and 1.9 assists per game this season.

MITCHELL EARNS PRESEASON NODS

- Senior **Mark Mitchell** is one of the top returners in the SEC and in the nation this season.
- Mitchell is one of 50 players named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Preseason Watch List – which is presented to the men's national player of the year by the USBWA.
- The senior was also named to the Preseason All-SEC Second Team.
- Mitchell leads Mizzou with 17.1 points and 3.5 assists in eight games this campaign, while ranking second with 6.3 rebounds

TOP RETURNING SCORER

- Senior Mark Mitchell led the Tigers in scoring as a junior and is back for more in 2025-26.
- Mitchell tallied 13.9 points per game shooting 50.5 percent from the field and leading the team in free-throws made (142) and attempts (212).
- In fact, Mitchell's 13.9 points are the most by a returning Tiger since Marcus Denmon in 2011-12 (he averaged 16.9 in 2010-11).

TIGERS SIGN NO. 1 CLASS

- Not only are the Tigers unbeaten on the season but Mizzou also signed the nation's top-ranked recruiting class in November.
- MU signed Jason Crowe Jr. (No. 5 in ESPN100), Toni Bryant (No. 14) and Aidan Chronister (No. 83).
- Overall, Mizzou has the No. 1 class by ESPN, ahead of No. 2 Michigan State.

BREAKOUT CANDIDATE

- Anthony Robinson II has been identified as one to watch this season.
- Robinson was named one of 10 breakout players for the 2025-26 campaign by Andy Katz and one of 20 by Jon Rothstein.
- Robinson tallied 9.0 points per game during his sophomore season, leading Mizzou with 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game.

RETURNING EXPERIENCE

- The Tigers are ready to take on the 2025-26 campaign with a number of familiar faces.
- Mizzou is the only team in the SEC with three returning starters from last season with Mark Mitchell, Trent Pierce and Anthony Robinson II all back for MU.
- Overall, it marks the first time that MU returns three starters since the 2020-21 campaign.

FLYING HIGH

- There is one thing you can't teach on the court and that is height, which Mizzou owns a lot of.
- The Tigers average height in 2025-26 is 79.79 inches (nearly 6-foot-8).
- Mizzou's height is nearly an inch taller than the second-previous tallest team in school history (79.00 in 2017-18) and more than a half inch taller than any other team in the SEC.

- The highlight for Mizzou during the 2024-25 season was a trio of wins over top-five schools.
- The Tigers defeated No. 1 Kansas, No. 4 Alabama and No. 5 Florida during the season.
- The victory over the Jayhawks marked Mizzou's fifth against the nation's top-ranked team and first since 1997.
- Meanwhile, the win over Florida marked the first for MU over the eventual national champion since North Carolina State in 1982-83.
- Overall, MU was one of three schools with three top-five wins in 2024-25 doing so for the second time in its history and first since 1988-89.

TOP-10 OFFENSE NATIONALLY

- The key to the Tigers' success in 2024-25 was their offensive attack.
- Mizzou ranked ninth in the nation by averaging 83.6 points per game.
- The Tigers posted their highest scoring offense since 1989-90 (86.8) and fourth-highest overall in school history.

- Mark Mitchell is not just a scorer and does a little bit of everything for the Tigers.
- Mitchell led the team in scoring (13.9) last season, second in rebounds (4.7), third in assists (64), fifth in steals (32) and first in blocks (25).
- In fact, Mitchell was one of just 14 players in

the nation to total 450 points, 150 rebounds, 60 assists. 30 steals and 25 blocks last season.

LEARNING FROM THE POINT GOD

- Anthony Robinson II spent some of his summer learning from Chris Paul as he was one of 12 players nationally to earn an invite to his camp.
- Robinson participated in the Chris Paul Elite Guard Camp from July 29 to August 1 this summer.

PORTER'S POWERS

- One transfer to keep an eye out for is senior levon Porter.
- Porter tallied 12.5 points and 7.2 rebounds for Loyola Marymount during the 2024-25 season.
- A 6-foot-11 forward, Porter can do it all on the court. He was one of 11 players in the nation last season to tally 350 points, 200 rebounds, 40 made 3-pointers and 35 blocks.
- Through eight games, Porter has tallied 8.0 points, 5.3 rebounds and 1.9 assists per game.

TAKING THE SHOW ON THE ROAD

- The Tigers went on the road to open the 2025-26 season, putting on a show at Howard.
- Mizzou's win marks the first time it won a road season opener since 2003, while the 21-point win is its largest since in a road opener since a 52-29 win at Saint Louis in 1941.
- The Tigers were the only power conference school to open with a win in a true road game.

OH CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

- Two Tigers are set to serve as team captains during the 2025-26 campaign.
- Mark Mitchell and Anthony Robinson II are both set to serve in leadership roles this season.

In just three seasons as Whitten Family Men's Basketball Head Coach, Dennis Gates has made an immediate impact and reestablished University of Missouri on the national stage. Now in his fourth year on the Mizzou sideline, he aims to build off his early progress as the Tigers chase championships with him leading the program.






