GAME 10 - TCU

Finals might not be for another two weeks but this big test week for the Irish continues on the road Friday night. Notre Dame will look to ride its wave of momentum after its ACC/SEC Challenge win, when they travel to TCU for an 8 p.m. ET tip on ESPN+. It'll mark the last road non-con of the season, as ND will have three more non-cons at home before the Christmas break and the ACC season.

The TCU matchup marks the start of a home-and-home, with the Horned Frogs returning the trip to Purcell in 2026, same as Ohio State.

It'll be the program's first trip to Fort Worth, despite a 5-0 mark in the all-time series. The two have not clashed on the hardwood since March 18, 1997.

TCU is off to a 5-2 start. They suffered a tough 78-74 loss to New Orleans and a 67-63 heartbreaker to No. 6 Michigan. They have since bounced back and have won three straight including an 84-80 victory over No. 10 Florida.

With a win on Friday night, the Irish would earn a coveted Quad 1 win, with TCU's current NET rating coming in at 46.

The Horned Frogs rank highly in blocks per game (21st in the country with 5.6) and turnovers forced per game (16th with 17.1). They are led by Brock harding who ranks 8th in the country in steals per game (3.3) and 20th in assists per game (6.1). Harding (10.0), Jayden Pierre (11.7) and David Punch (12.7) all average double figures.

NEEDED IT

"Believe." A word that was said after every huddle in the preseason and start of the 2025-26 campaign. Belief that Notre Dame could get over its hump of finishing on the wrong side of close games. Coach Shrewsberry stated during the preseason that if this program wanted to turn a corner, it had to be mentally tougher in close games down the stretch. "Fight. Compete."

Last season, the Irish were involved in 10 games that were decided by one possession. They were 5-5 in those instances and 0-3 in games decided by one point. Fast forward to this season and ND suffered a heartbreaking 63-64 loss at Ohio State in game four. The Irish had two chances to extend the lead late, and another chance at the buzzer for the win; but couldn't convert.

Against Kansas, the Irish fought to cut an II-point deficit to four, and against No. 3 Houston, they cut a 22-point deficit to four as well. Versus both however, they couldn't push past that final hump.

Those learning lessons bubbled to a boiling point against Missouri. The Fighting Irish battled back down 12, traded 11-0 runs in the second half, endured seven ties and eight lead changes, and with the game tied in the final minute they pushed through with a game-winning three to take down Mizzou 76-71.

"Our guys have a lot of belief," Coach Shrewsberry said. "In order to keep that belief, something good has to happen for them. They earned the right for something good to happen to them. Our guys earned it by doing things the right way. We needed to win a close game. We needed to go through these tough moments and come out on the right side."

The game had it all and had that compete level Coach was asking for. It also had 16 assists on 25 made field goals - team basketball. More on that next.

MARKUS BURTON, POINT GUARD

Markus Burton had his best, if not most complete game of his career in the Missouri win. The junior point guard recorded his first career double-double with 18 points and a career high 10 assists.

Burton assisted or scored on eight of the team's final nine made baskets.

"He creates so much havoc when he drives," Shrewsberry said. "Just making the right play every time. Ten assists, 2 turnovers is big-time for him. ... I thought he was really aggressive, driving to score. But I thought when people came over to help, he made the right play each time."

CERTA-FIED

Cole Certa flashed it in the season opener when he dropped 22 points on a career best 6-9 night from three-point range. He flashed it last season in the win over Stanford when he drained a corner three with 18 seconds left for the 56-54 win. The sophomore guard delivered in a major way in the win over Missouri, recording the game-winning three

with 17 seconds left.

In fact, Certa converted three triples in the final 4:35 of the game, ultimately finishing with 14 points.

FEED THE HOT HANDS

Two Irish are currently churning along offensively and riding long scoring streaks heading into TCU. For Burton, he hasn't scored below 13 points this season and has registered five games of 20+. His 19.9 ppg currently ranks sixth in the ACC.

Burton is one of the best in the country from the midrange. The Mishawaka native is shooting 53.1 percent in the paint, which is 10.8 percent above the Division I average. Over the last five games, Burton has converted an impressive 64.7 percent from two.

Then there's freshman guard Jalen Haralson, who gives this Notre Dame offense a new look and feel. He's another ball handler who can attack the paint, or post up or get to the front of the rim. Plus, he takes pressure off Burton and gets him off the ball. He also provides length on the defensive end.

Haralson has produced seven consecutive games in double figures, averaging 14.4 points in that span on 53.6 percent shooting. Haralson gets to the rim at will, where he converts a whopping 75.7 percent - that's 13.1 percent above the D1 average.

PLAYERS ERA ROUNDUP

Notre Dame left the desert with a 1-2 record at the Players Era. The Fighting Irish defeated Rutgers but fell to Kansas and No. 2 Houston by 10 points each. A commonality of both losses was poor three-point shooting, which was a strength heading into this MTE. Versus Kansas, Notre Dame was 4-24, and against Houston, the Irish were 6-28.

Against the top-three ranked Cougars, the Irish showed tremendous fight after falling into a 22-point hole, clawing back to just a four-point deficit. A standout in this game was junior guard Logan Imes, who supplied great minutes and boasted the biggest +/-at +10.

Markus Burton led Notre Dame in scoring for all three games in Vegas. The junior averaged 21.3 ppg on 53.3 percent shooting. He recorded 16 rebounds, 11 assists and six steals.

Freshman guard Jalen Haralson kept his double-digit scoring streak alive and against top notch competition no less. He averaged 14.0 ppg in Vegas on 44.1 percent shooting.

REBOUNDING TRANSLATES

Coach on Towt: "He's energy personified. There have been a ton of transfers that transferred up and there scoring output doesn't necessarily follow. Rebounding translates at every level. It's heart and it's effort. That's what he does. Carson is just max effort, man. He just plays really hard. His effort on the glass on both ends, his physicality. He's a big brother to these dudes. He's feeding their belief because of the energy and the confidence that he gives them."

Last year's NCAA rebounding leader Carson Towt has been a high-level impact transfer from Northern Arizona. To start, he tied his career-high 19 rebounds in the season opener, which also set a new record for an Irish debut. He produced two double-doubles in the first five games. He then became the first Irish player in the conference era (1995-present) to start the season with six straight games with double-digit rebounds.

Towt's current rebounding rankings:

- 10.2 rpg ranks 17th nationally, 1st in the ACC
- 3.3 offensive rpg 36th nationally, 4th in the ACC
- 6.9 defensive rpg 22nd nationally, 3rd in the ACC
- 1,170 career rebounds leads all active players

NOTRE NOTABLES

- Notre Dame currently boasts a perfect 5-0 record at home, where they are averaging 86.2 points per game. They are shooting 50.5 percent inside Purcell. They are also averaging 11.0 made threes per game at home.
- The Irish are 16 wins away from 2,000 all-time. They would become the eighth program to achieve this feat.
- Certa is a perfect 16-16 from the FT line.
- Irish defense doing its part against P4 teams - held OSU to 64, Kansas to 71,

- No. 3 Houston to 66, Mizzou to 71.
- For the first time since the 2016-17 season, the Fighting Irish opened the season with three straight 20+ point victories.

IRISH DEPTH LEADS TO 3-0 START

Eleven different Irish scored in the season opener and in game two, six different Irish finished in double figures. The depth was on full display in week one. In game three, Coach Shrews found a lineup that clicked in the second half, dropping 47 points in that period to win by 20.

Game 1 - Burton popped off for 24 points as Cole Certa exploded onto the scene with 22 points behind six triples. Ryder Frost scored all 15 of his points in the second half.

Game 2 - Notre Dame recorded 19 assists on 36 made field goals. Carson Towt recorded his first double-double in an Irish uniform with 11 points and 10 rebounds. Sir Mohammed was the MVP with 10 points, six rebounds and a career high six assists. Brady Koehler netted his first game in double figures with 10 points.

Game 3 - Braeden Shrewsberry was 6-8 from three to total 18 total points. Jalen Haralson scored 13 of his 17 in the second half and finished the night a perfect 6-6 from the field. Burton led again with 21 points.

Coach Shrewsberry:

"We have II guys that are capable. Sometimes in practice you'll have separation, but there hasn't been much separation in practice. Every day a different player plays great and we have so many guys. So we don't have that 'ok you're doing this and this is your spot.' We have options now so we can keep mixing. If it's not your night, that's fine, we can go with someone else and that's ok. We are going to keep trying to press the right buttons."

The collegiate landscape is starting to pick up on what Notre Dame fans already knew - Markus Burton is a special player. The junior guard picked up two major preseason accolades

KNOW THE NAME - MARKUS BURTON

If you don't know the name Markus Burton, you should. The 6-0 junior guard, who is playing in front of his home town, recorded a sensational sophomore season and is poised to have an even bigger junior campaign.

Burton averaged 21.3 ppg last year, which ranks third nationally amongst returners.

The last Irish player to average 20+ points in a season was Luke Harangody (21.8 ppg) in the 2009-10 season.

Burton continued to write his name in different areas of the record book, alongside the all-time Irish greats. Here's one for example - Burton joined David Rivers as the only Irish players to average 20+ points and 3+ assists in a season. He averaged a team best 3.0 apg last season.

He averaged 23.5 ppg in conference play which led all ACC players.

CORE NUCLEUS INTACT

For Notre Dame and Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry, retention and player development has been key. For the second consecutive year, the Fighting Irish return the highest scoring by percentage of any ACC school.

- 2. Virginia Tech 44.9%

Leading those returners is one of the best backcourt duos in the ACC - junior guards Markus Burton and Braeden Shrewsberry. Approaching their third year together on the court, the duo combined for a league best 35.3 ppg.

HIGHEST RATED ND RECRUIT CLASS IN MODERN HISTORY TAKES THE FLOOR

When Micah Shrewsberry became the Glenn & Stacey Murphy Notre Dame Men's Basketball Head Coach he told fans to jump on now because the train was taking off. Said recruiting train built massive momentum that materialized in Notre Dame's highest-rated recruiting class in the modern era.

The class was ranked fourth in the nation by 247Sports, fifth by ESPN, fifth by Rivals and sixth by ON3. It's also the top-rated class in the state of Indiana; second overall in the ACC.

The class is comprised of Tommy Ahneman, Ryder Frost, Brady Koehler and Jalen Haralson - the latter (at the time of his signing) was the highest rated recruit for Notre Dame in the modern era.

Haralson became the 20th McDonald's All-American in program history and the first of the Shrews Era.

Frost was on Paul Biancardi's 2025 top shotmakers list. In 2024, he led the UA summer circuit in three-point percentage, converting 45.2 percent.

Koehler was a 2025 AP Indiana Boys Basketball All-State First Team selection. He attended Coach Shrews' high school and averaged 16.3 points, 6.6 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.0 steals.

Ahneman was the top-ranked prospect in the state of Minnesota and led Cretin-Derham to a Class 4A Station runner-up finish as a senior. He averaged 16.3 points and 10.6 rebounds. Unfortunately, Ahneman is out indefinitely rehabbing his knee.

MORE ON BURTON

Burton was one just three high-major players to post both a usage rate above 30 percent and an assist rate above 20 percent - joining 2025 lottery picks Cooper Flagg and Jeremiah Fears. Additionally, he generated 34.1 points per 40 minutes, ranking in the 98th percentile nationally, according to CBB Analytics.

According to Bart Torvik's database, since the 2007-08 season, only 10-high major players listed at 6-feet tall or shorter have reached those benchmarks in a single season. Of that group, Burton is one of just four to hit those marks in multiple seasons – joining South Carolina's Devan Downey (2009-10), Louisville's Russ Smith (2012-13) and Marquette's Markus Howard (2019-20).

PAT GARRITY RETURNS TO ALMA MATER IN NEW ROLE

A Notre Dame basketball alumnus has returned home in a new role aimed at revolutionizing the operational aspect of Fighting Irish basketball. Back in May, Pat Garrity was named the Men's & Women's Basketball General Manager, along with serving as the primary sports administrator for the men's program.

Garrity will be tasked with developing long-term roster management strategies for both programs. He'll work to establish a clear vision in recruiting and the transfer portal, while working hand-in-hand with the NIL office on a financial asset allocation strategy.

As the sport administrator for the men's program, other key components of Garrity's role include, but aren't limited to, the development of annual strategic goals, team personnel management, budget analysis, revenue generation and fundraising, alumni relations and facility management.

Garrity graduated magna cum laude from Notre Dame in 1998 with a B.S. in Science Pre Professional Studies. On the court, he was just as successful – a three-time All-Big East selection, the 1997 Big East Player of the Year, a 1998 Second Team All-American and a two-time First Team Academic All-American. Garrity finished with 2,085 career points, which still ranks fifth all-time.



He was selected 19th overall in the first round of the 1998 NBA draft by the Milwaukee Bucks and traded immediately to the Phoenix Suns. In the summer of 1999 he was traded to the Orlando Magic, competing for nine seasons before retiring in 2008. During this time, he also served as secretary/treasurer for the National Basketball Players Association for seven seasons.

In August of 2014 Garrity landed the role of Director of Strategic Planning for the Detroit Pistons. In the summer of 2016, Garrity was promoted to Assistant General Manager and held that position for four seasons before leaving the post in 2020.

SHREWS SUMMER RECAP

For the second straight summer, Coach Shrewsberry lent his expertise to USA Basketball. A year prior he won gold with the U18 Team in South America. This summer, he won gold with the U19 squad playing over in Switzerland.

Then in September, Coach Shrews was named to the NABC Board of Directors. Shrewsberry was one of nine head coaches selected by the organization joining Baylor head coach Scott Drew, North Georgia head coach Dan Evans, Yale head coach James Jones, Pomona-Pitzer head coach Charles

Katsiaficas, Liberty head coach Ritchie McKay, Kentucky head coach Mark Pope, Duke head coach Jon Scheyer and Illinois head coach Brad Underwood.

ANALYSIS:

Notre Dame has a fairly solid squad that likely falls within the top quartile of all teams in college basketball this year. They are ranked #79 (out of 365) in the most recent Haslametrics ratings and have a record of 6-3. They are also ranked by this site as the #13 team (out of 18) in the ACC (average ranking 66.9).

Notre Dame will mainly try to find success through their defense. They are ranked 82nd in defensive efficiency and allow fewer than 104 points every 100 possessions vs. AO. Notre Dame does a fantastic job to prevent opposing teams from capitalizing on chances from offensive rebounds. The squad allows AO to convert only 4.0% of all second-chance opportunities (ranked 16th in the NCAA). Notre Dame also boasts one of the better overall defensive field goal percentages in the country. The team ranks #34 nationally in field goal percentage allowed, as AO only makes good on about 40.6% of their total attempts from the floor.

Notre Dame plays at about the same level on offense as they do on defense. The team ranks 90th nationally in offensive efficiency, scoring about 113 points every 100 trips upcourt vs. AO. Notre Dame has a keen ability to drain field goals between the three-point line and the low post. The squad is ranked 36th nationally in mid-range field goal percentage, making about 42.8% of their attempts from those locations vs. AO.

3rd Season at Notre Dame 5th as a Head Coach at the DI Level

On March 24, 2023, an Indiana native came home to kickstart a new era of Notre Dame men's basketball. Vice President and James E. Rohr Notre Dame Director of Athletics Jack Swarbrick announced Micah Shrewsberry as the 18th head coach in Fighting Irish men's basketball history.

Shrewsberry brought a wealth of experience and success to the helm of the Notre Dame program. All-in-all he's coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals - in addition to coaching all-NBA honorees Jayson Tatum and Jaylen Brown.

Coach Shrewsberry is now hard at work prepping for year three at the helm of the program ahead of the 2025-26 season.

Year Two with the Irish (2024-25)

A year of 'what could have been' as several key injuries kept the team from achieving its fullest potential. Over the course of the season, guards Markus Burton, Braeden Shrewsberry, Matt Allocco and Sir Mohammed all missed significant time. With that said, the Irish finished 15-18 overall and 8-12 in ACC play, once again obtaining the No. 12 seed in the ACC Tournament.

Coach Shrewsberry's core nucleus of players made tremendous strides in year two. Markus Burton solidified himself as an elite guard in the league, earning Second Team honors. Burton led the league in scoring, averaging 23.5 ppg over ACC play. He averaged 21.3 ppg overall which ranked fifth nationally. He joined Irish legend David Rivers as the only two players in program history to average 20+ points and 3+ assists in a season. He also became the seventh fastest player in program history to reach 1,000 career points.

As Braeden Shrewsberry upped his average to 14.0 ppg, Notre Dame boasted the best scoring guard duo in the ACC, topping Duke's Cooper Flags and Kon Knueppel. Due to the core nucleus, Notre Dame's KenPom offensive efficiency jumped 139 spots from the year prior to 95. The offense, which averaged 64.0 ppg in 2023-24, leaped up to 72.6 ppg in 2024-25.

Despite the roller-coaster season, there were several memorable moments along the way, including Coach Shrews delivering the program's first ever win in Charlottesville against Virginia. How about the Irish recording a 14-point comeback at Boston College, the largest comeback in Coach

Shrewberry's tenure? How about freshman guard Cole Certa burying a corner three in the final seconds for a 56-54 win over Stanford? How about the four-overtime thriller in the 112-110 win over Cal that saw Burton go off for 43 points? After that victory, Coach Shrews improved to 4-2 in overtime games in his two years in South Bend.

Now, Notre Dame maintained a bulk of its core ahead of the 2025-26 season and will inject a very talented freshman class of Tommy Ahneman, Ryder Frost, Jalen Haralson and Brady Koehler. Back in November of 2024, Coach Shrewsberry and his staff signed these four young men and inked the program's highest ever rated recruiting class in the modern era - a consensus top-10.

Last but not least, the summer of 2024 witnessed Shrewsberry winning a gold medal at the FIBA U18 Americup as an assistant coach with the U.S. U18 team. He'll rejoin the same coaching staff to mentor the US U19 squad at the 2025 FIBA U19 World Cup in June of 2025.

Year One with the Irish (2023-24)

Coach Shrewsberry achieved two of his priorities in the 2023-24 season: establish the right culture at Notre Dame and have the team playing its best basketball at the end of the season. It was a program that returned 1.6% of its scoring and was projected to finish dead last in the ACC. The young Irish team came together and doubled its ACC win total from the year prior, finishing 7-13 in league play. Coach Shrewsberry even received several votes for ACC Coach of the Year. Notre Dame finished with a 13-20 overall record and won one game (First Round vs. Georgia Tech) in the ACC Tournament.

The first key moment of the season included an emphatic 76-54 win over Virginia. What Shrews' crew accomplished had never been done by an Irish team against the Cavaliers ... ever ... it was the largest margin of victory against UVA in the all-time series. In addition, the 76 points were the most scored by an Irish squad against the Cavaliers in regulation in program history. Furthermore, right after the Virginia contest, the Irish almost pulled off the upset to two teams who made the Elite Eight in NC State and Duke.

Next, the Irish bonded together by winning five of six during the final portion of the regular season, which included the final four at home (Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech, Wake Forest, Clemson). From Feb. 1 to March 1, Notre Dame was the biggest mover in kenpom AdjEM across the Power-Five conferences. Another fun stat: when the first NET rankings came on Dec. 4, the Irish were 238. On March 10, the Irish were up to 126.

An early Coach Shrewsberry stamp on the program was the defensive intensity. Notre Dame scoring defense of 67.2 finished with a national ranking of 49th in the country, plus 3rd in the ACC. According to KenPom, Notre Dame's defensive efficiency ranked 39th nationally. In ACC play, Notre Dame ranked 2nd in scoring defense (66.4) and 2nd in field goal percentage defense (417). Of the 20 ACC games – all but three (Virginia Tech on March 9, UNC on March 5 & Syracuse on Feb. 24) were held under their season average, with Miami, Duke and Louisville each held to season-low point totals.

Lastly – two freshman guards flourished under Coach Shrewsberry in Markus Burton and Braeden Shrewsberry. Burton became the program's first ACC Rookie of the Year. He also broke the program freshman scoring record after dropping 577 points. Burton averaged 17.5 points both on the season and in league play, leading the Irish. Shrewsberry was the lone other Irish to finish in double figures, averaging 10.2 points on the year and 11.3 points in ACC play. With that said, Burton and Shrewsberry became the 9th ACC freshmen duo in league history to rank No. 1 and No. 2 for their team in scoring, proving the future is bright in South Bend.

Prior to Notre Dame

Prior to Notre Dame, Shrewsberry produced a historic turnaround as the head coach at Penn State. After a 14-17 first season, Shrewsberry produced a 23-14 mark in 2022-23, just the 12th 20-win season in the 127-year history of Penn State basketball. Furthermore, he collected more Big Ten wins (17) in his first two seasons than any other Penn State head coach.

Shrewsberry certainly captured the nation's attention in late February and into March, going 9-3 over their last 12 games. Shrewsberry then made plenty of noise in the 2023 Big Ten Tournament in Chicago, defeating No. 7 Illinois, No. 2 Northwestern and No. 3 Indiana to reach the championship game as the No. 10 seed. It marked the program's second-ever Big Ten title game appearance. Penn State was just the third double-digit seed to reach the Big Ten Tournament championship game and the first since 2008.

The Nittany Lions then made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2011. In the first round, Shrewsberry and the Nittany Lions knocked off No. 7 seed and SECTournament runner-up Texas A&M, winning the program's first NCAA Tournament game since 2001.

In year one at Penn State, Shrewsberry engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense and guided the squad to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in Il years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games.

Recruiting-wise, Shrewsberry made an instant splash in Happy Valley. In his first year, Shrewsberry signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history, a consensus top-30 class. A year later, he signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, marking the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions had signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes.

Development-wise, Shrewsberry proved himself there as well, turning Jalen Pickett and Seth Lundy into 2nd Round NBA Draft picks. It marked the first time in program history that two Nittany Lions were selected.







Statistically speaking, the 2022-23 squad set the BIG and Penn State single-season team record for three-pointers made in a season with 385. The Nittany Lions compiled a total of five top-15 national statistical rankings. In addition, Shrewsberry tutored an Associated Press All-American in Jalen Pickett and a total of three All-Big Ten players during the 2022-23 season.

Prior to his time with Penn State, Shrewsberry experienced two separate stints at Purdue – one as assistant coach from 2011-13 and another as associate head coach from 2019-21. Highlights include the 2020-21 season, in which Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a 13-6 fourth-place finish in the Big Ten and an 18-10 overall mark, culminating in an NCAA Tournament at-large bid. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections. Shrewsberry played a major role in recruiting Ivey, who grew up in South Bend and is the son of Karen and Kevin Keyes Family Head Women's Basketball Coach Niele Ivey.

Another highlight from his time in West Lafayette includes the 2011-12 squad that produced a 22-13 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the BIC, netting accolades from conference and national entities.

In between his Purdue stints, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach under Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Brown and Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors.

The Brad Stevens connection was previously made at Butler University, where Shrewsberry spent one year as the director of operations then three as an assistant coach. With Shrewsberry on the sidelines, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles and made three NCAA Tournament appearances – which included back-to-back runs to the national championship game in 2010 and 2011.

Also at Butler, he aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, the 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year and a 2010 Final Four All-Tournament Team selection. Hayward was the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Continuing on Shrewsberry's basketball journey, he spent time as the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships.

Shrewsberry was also the first men's basketball head coach at Indiana University South Bend. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

An Indianapolis area native, Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree from Indiana State in 2003. As a player at Hanover, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain.

He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.
