EVANSVILLE ON DECK

On Saturady, the Evansville Aces (4-6) come to South Bend for the sixth time in program history as Notre Dame leads the overall series 6-4. The Irish are perfect 5-0 at home against the Aces.

The last two match ups have been played in Purcell Pavilion, but the last time the two programs have faced each other was in 2012, where the Irish won 58-49. Before that, the last matchup was 20 years prior in 1992 where the Irish won 76-70 at home.

WEDNESDAY'S WIN

The (RV) Notre Dame men's basketball team (8-3) has won three-straight games as they defeated the Idaho Vandals (6-4) in an 80-65 battle inside of Purcell Pavilion on Wednesday night.

The Fighting Irish shot a blistering 61.3 percent in the second half, where they outscored Idaho 47-32. Cole Certa, Jalen Haralson and Braeden Shrewsberry all recorded double-digit points in the second half alone.

Haralson led the offensive charge with second 20-point performance in a row, followed by Towt with 19, Certa with 15, and Shrewsberry with 14.

Eleven games into the season and the Irish sit at 8-3 and look to make it four wins in a row when they host Evansville on Saturday, Dec. 13 at 2 p.m. ET on ACCN.

The Fighting Irish will play three consecutive games inside Purcell Pavilion before

departing for the Christmas break and gearing up for ACC play.

HEADBAND TOWT

Carson Towt continues to be rebounding force for the Irish and he did it again on Wednesday night in the win over Idaho - and he did in fashion. Sporting the headband for the first time this season, Towt recorded his third double-double of the season.

He finished with an impressive seasonhigh 19 points on 9-12 shooting while also grabbing 15 rebounds. Towt is now 15-18 from the floor over the past two games.

MARK ZACKERY IV ADDED TO MEN'S BASKETBALL ROSTER

Glenn & Stacey Murphy Notre Dame head coach Micah Shrewsberry announced the roster addition of Mark Zackery IV on Thursday afternoon.

Zackery IV is fresh off his freshman football season at Notre Dame, but is no stranger to the game of basketball. The former Indiana Class 4A state champion and Indiana All-Star will provide immediate depth to the point guard position.

"I think that Mark will be a great addition to our program," Shrewsberry stated.

"I have seen him play many times throughout his high school career. Whether competing with Team Teague, Indiana Elite, or Ben Davis High School, he always does things that help lead to winning. He will be an asset for us with his ball handling, playmaking, and defensive abilities. More importantly, he is a great young man that will add more value to our locker room and culture."

WHAT A WEEK

A home win and SEC Challenge victory over Mizzou ... then a Quad 1 win at TCU in a hostile environment, in overtime no less ... with two stellar back-to-back wins, the Irish jumped from 86 in the NET to 69 and that's not all.

They received votes in the A.P. poll for the first time in the Coach Shrews Era. They appeared at No. 25 in Andy Katz's Power37 and No. 41 in Jon Rothstein's 45.

In both games, they defied a stigma about finishing out close games. A Certa three from deep to come up clutch or a Haralson fadeaway to send it to OT. They stayed together and competed; they believed. As Coach Shrewsberry stated, it was a culmination of all their games played, specifically the three losses this year. In fact, not only did they close, but they battled back. The Irish were down 12 to Missouri (7 at the half) and 11 to TCU (9 at the half). The last time Notre Dame came back to win after being down 9+ at halftime was a 13-point deficit to Virginia Tech in the ACC Tourney on March 7, 2018.

"Our guys have a lot of belief," Coach Shrewsberry said. "In order to keep that belief, something good has to happen for them. They earned the right for something good to happen to them. Our guys earned it by doing things the right way. We needed to

win a close game. We needed to go through these tough moments and come out on the right side."

It was done by playing team basketball - making the extra pass and hitting clutch shots.

Notre Dame produced 16 assists on 25 made field goals against Mizzou. Then recorded 27 assists on 33 made field goals at TCU. The latter marked the most assists in a game since at Syracuse on Jan. 4, 2020.

That's 43 assists on 58 made field goals over the two games. The Irish collectively shot 50.9 percent from the floor and converted 23 three-pointers.

NEXT MAN UP

The Fighting Irish will be without their floor general, Markus Burton, for the forseeable future. On Wednesday, Dec. 10, he had surgery performed on his left ankle, an injury he incurred at TCU.

Burton was averaging a team best 18.5 points per game and was coming off one of his most complete games of his career after dropping his first career double-double with 18 points and 10 assists vs. Missouri. He had six points and five assists in 10 minutes at TCU.

Burton had a phenomenal start of the season, becoming just 1-of-3 Notre Dame plaeyrs over the past 30 years to total 180+points, 30+ assists and 15+ steals over the first 10 games, joining Jerian Grant (2013-14, 2014-15) & Chris Thomas (2002-03).

HARALSON IN THE CLUTCH

Adding on to the Next Man Up mantra was guard Jalen Haralson at TCU. Down two with three seconds remaining, Haralson hit a step-back fadeaway jumper as the freshman tied it up 76-all to take it into overtime.

Haralson finished the night shooting 8-12 from the floor to record a career best 20 points, push a career high 9 assists. Other ND greats over the last three decades to match Jalen's stat line of 20 points, 5 rebounds, 9 assists and 1 block: Jerian Grant in 2015 / Chris Thomas x3 (twice in 2002 and once in 2005).

"The thing that I told Jalen, right before we

went out after halftime, I said, 'You've got to be the best player on the floor with no doubt of who that is," Coach Shrewsberry said. "I thought he did that in the second half."

CERTA-FIED

Speaking of great weeks, ladies and gentlemen, Cole Certa. The sophomore sharpshooter flashed it in the season opener when he dropped 22 points on a career best 6-9 night from three-point range. He flashed it last season in the win over Stanford when he drained a corner three with 18 seconds left for the 56-54 win.

Then the Illinois native delivered in a major way in the win over Missouri, recording the game-winning three with 17 seconds left. In fact, Certa converted three triples in the final 4:35 of the game, ultimately finishing with 14 points.

Next, Certa went NBA Jam fire mode in the second half at TCU, where he drained four triples in a row. He ultimately converted five in the half and six in the game to finish with 20 points. It marked the second game this season in which Certa came off the bench and drained 5+ threes.

Most recently, Certa shot an impressive 75% from deep, knocking down 3-of-4 from behind the arc in the win over Idaho.

PROTECT PURCELL

The Fighting Irish have done just that and have protected Purcell with a 6-0 start. The Irish are averaging 10 more points per game at home, where they are shooting a hot 50.9 percent from the field. They are also averaging 10.7 made threes per game at home.

Individually speaking, four Irish are averaging double figures inside Purcell: Markus Burton (20.2), Jalen Haralson (14.0), Braeden Shrewsberry (11.8), Cole Certa (11.5).

The Irish are looking for a 7-0 start at home

for the first time since the 2022-23 season. If they closed out the non-con perfect at home, that would mark the first time since 2021-22.

WHO'S HOT

Jalen Haralson, who gives this Notre Dame offense a new look and feel. He's another ball handler who can attack the paint, or post up or get to the front of the rim. He also provides length on the defensive end.

He's been Mr. Dependable - nine straight games in double figures (includes Kansas, Houston, Missouri, TCU) - averaging 15.7 points in that span on 54.6% shooting.

More specifically, last week in the wins over Mizzou and TCU, Haralson averaged 16.5 points on 68.4% shooting, plus 4.5 rpg & 5.5 apg.

He's getting to the rim at will, where he converts a whopping 75.0 percent - that's 12.4 percent above the D1 average.

However, the hottest shooter from last week award goes to Cole Certa. The sophomore averaged a team best 17.0 points on a blazing 10-19 (.526) from three.

He's currently 40.6 percent from three on the season. His sweet spot has been the corner three, where he's 10-22 (.455). In addition, he's averaging 2.4 made threes per game.

Lastly, Carson Towt is coming off a big performance in the win over Idaho, posting his third double-double of a season-high 19 points and 15 rebounds.

In the win over TCU in the game prior, the graduate poured in 13 points on a perfect 6-6 from the floor. Towt also recorded nine boards & four assists.

REBOUNDING TRANSLATES

Coach on Towt: "He's energy personified. There have been a ton of transfers that transferred up and there scoring output doesn't necessarily follow. Rebounding translates at every level. It's heart and it's effort. That's what he does. Carson is just max effort, man. He just plays really hard. His effort on the glass on both ends, his physicality. He's a big brother to these dudes. He's feeding their belief because of

the energy and the confidence that he gives them."

Last year's NCAA rebounding leader Carson Towt has been a high-level impact transfer from Northern Arizona. To start, he tied his career-high 19 rebounds in the season opener, which also set a new record for an Irish debut. He produced two double-doubles in the first five games. He then became the first Irish player in the conference era (1995-present) to start the season with six straight games with double-digit rebounds.

Towt's current rebounding rankings:

- 10.5 rpg ranks 13th nationally, 2nd in the ACC
- 3.45 offensive rpg 2nd in the ACC
- 7.1 defensive rpg 13th nationally, 2nd in the ACC
- 1,194 career rebounds leads all active players

NOTRE NOTABLES

- The Irish are 14 wins away from 2,000 all-time. They would become the eighth program to achieve this feat.
- Certa is a perfect 20-20 from the FT line. In terms of D1 players who remain perfect from the stripe, Certa has converted the fifth most.

PLAYERS ERA ROUNDUP

Notre Dame left the desert with a 1-2 record

at the Players Era. The Fighting Irish defeated Rutgers but fell to Kansas and No. 2 Houston by 10 points each. A commonality of both losses was poor three-point shooting, which was a strength heading into this MTE. Versus Kansas, Notre Dame was 4-24, and against Houston, the Irish were 6-28.

Against the top-three ranked Cougars, the Irish showed tremendous fight after falling into a 22-point hole, clawing back to just a four-point deficit. A standout in this game was junior guard Logan Imes, who supplied great minutes and boasted the biggest +/-at +10.

Markus Burton led Notre Dame in scoring for all three games in Vegas. The junior averaged 21.3 ppg on 53.3 percent shooting. He recorded 16 rebounds, 11 assists and six steals.

Freshman guard Jalen Haralson averaged 14.0 ppg in Vegas on 44.1 percent shooting.

IRISH DEPTH LEADS TO 3-0 START

Eleven different Irish scored in the season opener and in game two, six different Irish finished in double figures. The depth was on full display in week one. In game three, Coach Shrews found a lineup that clicked in the second half, dropping 47 points in that period to win by 20.

Game 1 - Burton popped off for 24 points as Cole Certa exploded onto the scene with 22 points behind six triples. Ryder Frost scored all 15 of his points in the second half.

Game 2 - Notre Dame recorded 19 assists on 36 made field goals. Carson Towt recorded his first double-double in an Irish uniform with 11 points and 10 rebounds. Sir Mohammed was the MVP with 10 points, six rebounds and a career high six assists. Brady Koehler netted his first game in double figures with 10 points.

Game 3 - Braeden Shrewsberry was 6-8 from three to total 18 total points. Jalen Haralson scored 13 of his 17 in the second half and finished the night a perfect 6-6 from the field. Burton led again with 21 points.

Coach Shrewsberry:

"We have II guys that are capable. Some-

times in practice you'll have separation, but there hasn't been much separation in practice. Every day a different player plays great and we have so many guys. So we don't have that 'ok you're doing this and this is your spot.' We have options now so we can keep mixing. If it's not your night, that's fine, we can go with someone else and that's ok. We are going to keep trying to press the right buttons."

PRESEASON ACCOLADES FOR BURTON

The collegiate landscape is starting to pick up on what Notre Dame fans already knew - Markus Burton is a special player. The junior guard picked up two major preseason accolades

- First Team Preseason All-ACC last Irish player to garner Preseason First Team honors was senior forward John Mooney in 2019.
- Bob Cousy Award Watch List recognizing the top-20 point guards in the country.

CORE NUCLEUS INTACT

For Notre Dame and Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry, retention and player development has been key. For the second consecutive year, the Fighting Irish return the highest scoring by percentage of any ACC school.

Leading those returners is one of the best backcourt duos in the ACC - junior guards Markus Burton and Braeden Shrewsberry. Approaching their third year together on the court, the duo combined for a league best 35.3 ppg.

HIGHEST RATED ND RECRUIT CLASS IN MODERN HISTORY TAKES THE FLOOR

When Micah Shrewsberry became the Glenn & Stacey Murphy Notre Dame Men's Basketball Head Coach he told fans to jump on now because the train was taking off. Said recruiting train built massive momentum that materialized in Notre Dame's highest-rated recruiting class in the modern era.



The class was ranked fourth in the nation by 247Sports, fifth by ESPN, fifth by Rivals and sixth by ON3. It's also the top-rated class in the state of Indiana; second overall in the ACC.

The class is comprised of Tommy Ahneman, Ryder Frost, Brady Koehler and Jalen Haralson - the latter (at the time of his signing) was the highest rated recruit for Notre Dame in the modern era.

Haralson became the 20th McDonald's All-American in program history and the first of the Shrews Fra Frost was on Paul Biancardi's 2025 top shotmakers list. In 2024, he led the UA summer circuit in three-point percentage, converting 45.2 percent.

Koehler was a 2025 AP Indiana Boys Basketball All-State First Team selection. He attended Coach Shrews' high school and averaged 16.3 points, 6.6 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.0 steals.

Ahneman was the top-ranked prospect in the state of Minnesota and led Cretin-Derham to a Class 4A Station runner-up finish as a senior. He averaged 16.3 points and 10.6 rebounds. Unfortunately, Ahneman is out indefinitely rehabbing his knee.

PAT GARRITY RETURNS TO ALMA MATER IN NEW ROLE

A Notre Dame basketball alumnus has returned home in a new role aimed at revolutionizing the operational aspect of Fighting Irish basketball. Back in May, Pat Garrity was named the Men's & Women's Basketball General Manager, along with serving as the primary sports administrator for the men's program.

Garrity will be tasked with developing

ANALYSIS

This website places Notre Dame in the top 25% of all NCAA college basketball teams this year. Ranked 67th overall (out of 365) in our most recent ratings, they presently have a record of 8-3. Of the 18 schools in the ACC (average ranking 68.2), they're currently ranked as our #11 team in the conference.

Notre Dame succeeds primarily through their offense. They are ranked 76th in offensive efficiency and score in excess of 115 points every 100 possessions vs. AO. Notre Dame has a keen ability to drain field goals between the three-point line and the low post. The squad is ranked 36th nationally in mid-range field goal percentage, making about 43.7% of their attempts from those locations vs. AO. The team will take a fair amount of shots from those in-between locations, too. Approximately 25.6% of their attempts vs. AO are of the mid-range variety, which puts the team in the top-100 in that category nationally. Notre Dame has also been fairly successful when shooting from the field. The squad is ranked 54th in the country in field goal percentage, making approximately 47.5% of their attempts vs. AO.

Notre Dame plays at roughly the same level defensively as they do offensively. The team ranks 87th nationally in defensive efficiency, allowing about 103 points every 100 trips upcourt vs. AO. Notre Dame does a fantastic job to prevent opposing teams from capitalizing on chances from offensive rebounds. The squad allows AO to convert only 3.3% of all second-chance opportunities (ranked eighth in the NCAA), and with a rating of 10.27, they're 13th in potential points allowed off of the offensive glass as well. Notre Dame also boasts one of the better overall defensive field goal percentages in the country. The team ranks #39 nationally in field goal percentage allowed, as AO only makes good on about 40.5% of their total attempts from the floor. If Notre Dame does exhibit a weakness on the defensive end of the floor, it'd likely be the team's unwillingness to take risks in order to score fast points off of the opposition's turnovers. The squad only has a rating of 9.07 in potential points scored off of steals vs. AO, which ranks 34th-worst in the college game.

Notre Dame is one of the more consistent teams in Division I (presently ranked 42nd in consistency), so forecasting the outcomes of their future contests tends to be easier than the norm.

3rd Season at Notre Dame 5th as a Head Coach at the DI Level

On March 24, 2023, an Indiana native came home to kickstart a new era of Notre Dame men's basketball. Vice President and James E. Rohr Notre Dame Director of Athletics Jack Swarbrick announced Micah Shrewsberry as the 18th head coach in Fighting Irish men's basketball history.

Shrewsberry brought a wealth of experience and success to the helm of the Notre Dame program. All-in-all he's coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals - in addition to coaching all-NBA honorees Jayson Tatum and Jaylen Brown.

Coach Shrewsberry is now hard at work prepping for year three at the helm of the program ahead of the 2025-26 season.

Year Two with the Irish (2024-25)

A year of 'what could have been' as several key injuries kept the team from achieving its fullest potential. Over the course of the season, guards Markus Burton, Braeden Shrewsberry, Matt Allocco and Sir Mohammed all missed significant time. With that said, the Irish finished 15-18 overall and 8-12 in ACC play, once again obtaining the No. 12 seed in the ACC Tournament.

Coach Shrewsberry's core nucleus of players made tremendous strides in year two. Markus Burton solidified himself as an elite guard in the league, earning Second Team honors. Burton led the league in scoring, averaging 23.5 ppg over ACC play. He averaged 21.3 ppg overall which ranked fifth nationally. He joined Irish legend David Rivers as the only two players in program history to average 20+ points and 3+ assists in a season. He also became the seventh fastest player in program history to reach 1,000 career points.

As Braeden Shrewsberry upped his average to 14.0 ppg, Notre Dame boasted the best scoring guard duo in the ACC, topping Duke's Cooper Flags and Kon Knueppel. Due to the core nucleus, Notre Dame's KenPom offensive efficiency jumped 139 spots from the year prior to 95. The offense, which averaged 64.0 ppg in 2023-24, leaped up to 72.6 ppg in 2024-25.

Despite the roller-coaster season, there were several memorable moments along the way, including Coach Shrews delivering the program's first ever win in Charlottesville against Virginia. How about the Irish recording a 14-point comeback at Boston College, the largest comeback in Coach

Shrewberry's tenure? How about freshman guard Cole Certa burying a corner three in the final seconds for a 56-54 win over Stanford? How about the four-overtime thriller in the 112-110 win over Cal that saw Burton go off for 43 points? After that victory, Coach Shrews improved to 4-2 in overtime games in his two years in South Bend.

Now, Notre Dame maintained a bulk of its core ahead of the 2025-26 season and will inject a very talented freshman class of Tommy Ahneman, Ryder Frost, Jalen Haralson and Brady Koehler. Back in November of 2024, Coach Shrewsberry and his staff signed these four young men and inked the program's highest ever rated recruiting class in the modern era - a consensus top-10.

Last but not least, the summer of 2024 witnessed Shrewsberry winning a gold medal at the FIBA U18 Americup as an assistant coach with the U.S. U18 team. He'll rejoin the same coaching staff to mentor the US U19 squad at the 2025 FIBA U19 World Cup in June of 2025.

Year One with the Irish (2023-24)

Coach Shrewsberry achieved two of his priorities in the 2023-24 season: establish the right culture at Notre Dame and have the team playing its best basketball at the end of the season. It was a program that returned 1.6% of its scoring and was projected to finish dead last in the ACC. The young Irish team came together and doubled its ACC win total from the year prior, finishing 7-13 in league play. Coach Shrewsberry even received several votes for ACC Coach of the Year. Notre Dame finished with a 13-20 overall record and won one game (First Round vs. Georgia Tech) in the ACC Tournament.

The first key moment of the season included an emphatic 76-54 win over Virginia. What Shrews' crew accomplished had never been done by an Irish team against the Cavaliers ... ever ... it was the largest margin of victory against UVA in the all-time series. In addition, the 76 points were the most scored by an Irish squad against the Cavaliers in regulation in program history. Furthermore, right after the Virginia contest, the Irish almost pulled off the upset to two teams who made the Elite Eight in NC State and Duke.

Next, the Irish bonded together by winning five of six during the final portion of the regular season, which included the final four at home (Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech, Wake Forest, Clemson). From Feb. 1 to March 1, Notre Dame was the biggest mover in kenpom AdjEM across the Power-Five conferences. Another fun stat: when the first NET rankings came on Dec. 4, the Irish were 238. On March 10, the Irish were up to 126.

An early Coach Shrewsberry stamp on the program was the defensive intensity. Notre Dame scoring defense of 67.2 finished with a national ranking of 49th in the country, plus 3rd in the ACC. According to KenPom, Notre Dame's defensive efficiency ranked 39th nationally. In ACC play, Notre Dame ranked 2nd in scoring defense (66.4) and 2nd in field goal percentage defense (417). Of the 20 ACC games – all but three (Virginia Tech on March 9, UNC on March 5 & Syracuse on Feb. 24) were held under their season average, with Miami, Duke and Louisville each held to season-low point totals.

Lastly – two freshman guards flourished under Coach Shrewsberry in Markus Burton and Braeden Shrewsberry. Burton became the program's first ACC Rookie of the Year. He also broke the program freshman scoring record after dropping 577 points. Burton averaged 17.5 points both on the season and in league play, leading the Irish. Shrewsberry was the lone other Irish to finish in double figures, averaging 10.2 points on the year and 11.3 points in ACC play. With that said, Burton and Shrewsberry became the 9th ACC freshmen duo in league history to rank No. 1 and No. 2 for their team in scoring, proving the future is bright in South Bend.

Prior to Notre Dame

Prior to Notre Dame, Shrewsberry produced a historic turnaround as the head coach at Penn State. After a 14-17 first season, Shrewsberry produced a 23-14 mark in 2022-23, just the 12th 20-win season in the 127-year history of Penn State basketball. Furthermore, he collected more Big Ten wins (17) in his first two seasons than any other Penn State head coach.

Shrewsberry certainly captured the nation's attention in late February and into March, going 9-3 over their last 12 games. Shrewsberry then made plenty of noise in the 2023 Big Ten Tournament in Chicago, defeating No. 7 Illinois, No. 2 Northwestern and No. 3 Indiana to reach the championship game as the No. 10 seed. It marked the program's second-ever Big Ten title game appearance. Penn State was just the third double-digit seed to reach the Big Ten Tournament championship game and the first since 2008.

The Nittany Lions then made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2011. In the first round, Shrewsberry and the Nittany Lions knocked off No. 7 seed and SECTournament runner-up Texas A&M, winning the program's first NCAA Tournament game since 2001.

In year one at Penn State, Shrewsberry engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense and guided the squad to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in Il years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games.

Recruiting-wise, Shrewsberry made an instant splash in Happy Valley. In his first year, Shrewsberry signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history, a consensus top-30 class. A year later, he signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, marking the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions had signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes.

Development-wise, Shrewsberry proved himself there as well, turning Jalen Pickett and Seth Lundy into 2nd Round NBA Draft picks. It marked the first time in program history that two Nittany Lions were selected.







Statistically speaking, the 2022-23 squad set the BIG and Penn State single-season team record for three-pointers made in a season with 385. The Nittany Lions compiled a total of five top-15 national statistical rankings. In addition, Shrewsberry tutored an Associated Press All-American in Jalen Pickett and a total of three All-Big Ten players during the 2022-23 season.

Prior to his time with Penn State, Shrewsberry experienced two separate stints at Purdue – one as assistant coach from 2011-13 and another as associate head coach from 2019-21. Highlights include the 2020-21 season, in which Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a 13-6 fourth-place finish in the Big Ten and an 18-10 overall mark, culminating in an NCAA Tournament at-large bid. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections. Shrewsberry played a major role in recruiting Ivey, who grew up in South Bend and is the son of Karen and Kevin Keyes Family Head Women's Basketball Coach Niele Ivey.

Another highlight from his time in West Lafayette includes the 2011-12 squad that produced a 22-13 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the BIG, netting accolades from conference and national entities.

In between his Purdue stints, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach under Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Brown and Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors.

The Brad Stevens connection was previously made at Butler University, where Shrewsberry spent one year as the director of operations then three as an assistant coach. With Shrewsberry on the sidelines, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles and made three NCAA Tournament appearances – which included back-to-back runs to the national championship game in 2010 and 2011.

Also at Butler, he aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, the 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year and a 2010 Final Four All-Tournament Team selection. Hayward was the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Continuing on Shrewsberry's basketball journey, he spent time as the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships.

Shrewsberry was also the first men's basketball head coach at Indiana University South Bend. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

An Indianapolis area native, Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree from Indiana State in 2003. As a player at Hanover, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain.

He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.

- An efficient game: 10-13 FG for 25 points in win over Bellarmine.
