IRISH OPEN ACC PLAY IN CALI

Notre Dame will begin ACC play with its first California road swing since Cal and Stanford joined the ACC last year. It's prime scheduling for the Irish, knocking out the Cali road trip right off the bat during the holiday break and getting a week off before their third conference game.

The Fighting Irish know the importance of grabbing two wins this week after suffering a setback loss to close the non-con portion of their season. Notre Dame will start with Stanford on Dec. 30, then Cal on Jan. 2.

Last season, the Irish ended the regular season with both these teams and emerged victorious in both in dramatic fashion. First, a 56-54 last second win against the Cardinal in which Cole Certa hit the game-winner. Then a 112-110 4OT thriller against Cal in which Markus Burton dropped 41 points.

Coach Shrewsberry is 1-1 in ACC openers, while the program all-time is 5-7.

If you are an Irish fan in the Palo Alto or Berkeley area, now is the time. This trip will mark the first time ND has visited Cal and just the second time at Stanford, with the previous trip being Jan. 12, 1993. In that game, Monty Williams dropped 23 points in the 67-61 win.

NEXT MAN UP

The Fighting Irish will be without their floor general, Markus Burton, for the foreseeable future. On Wednesday, Dec. 10, he had

surgery performed on his left ankle, an injury he incurred at TCU.

Burton was averaging a team best 18.5 points per game and was coming off one of his most complete games of his career after dropping his first career double-double with 18 points and 10 assists vs. Missouri. He had six points and five assists in 10 minutes at TCU.

Burton had a phenomenal start of the season, becoming just 1-of-3 Notre Dame players over the past 30 years to total 180+ points, 30+ assists and 15+ steals over the first 10 games, joining Jerian Grant (2013-14, 2014-15) & Chris Thomas (2002-03).

WHO'S HOT?

With Markus Burton on the mend, the ball has been put in the hands of freshman Jalen Haralson and he has delivered. **The Indiana native has dropped 20 or more points in three of the last four games. He's 26-57 from the field in that span, averaging 17.8 ppg - a team best.**

One of those big time performances was the TCU overtime victory and it was Jalen himself who hit the buzzer beater in regulation. Down two with three seconds remaining, Haralson hit a step-back fadeaway jumper to tie it at 76-all. Haralson finished the night with 20 points & a career high 9 assists.

Other ND greats over the last three decades to match Jalen's stat line of 20 points, 5 rebounds, 9 assists and 1 block: Jerian Grant

in 2015 / Chris Thomas 3x (twice in 2002 and once in 2005).

"The thing that I told Jalen, right before we went out after halftime, I said, 'You've got to be the best player on the floor with no doubt of who that is,'" Coach Shrewsberry said. "I thought he did that in the second half."

ACC PLAY RESET

Notre Dame begins ACC play with a 9-4 record so let's talk about how we got here.

The Irish incurred three losses earlier on in the season but two were to ranked powers Kansas and Houston in Vegas, and the third was a what if scenario in Columbus - a one-point loss at Ohio State. Those battles tested the Irish, as they learned from them and got better. After Vegas, they rattled off four straight wins which included an SEC Challenge victory over Mizzou and a Quad 1 win at TCU. At that point in time, the Irish jumped from 86 in the NET to 69. They received votes in the A.P. poll for the first time in the Coach Shrews Era. They appeared at No. 25 in Andy Katz's Power37 and No. 41 in Jon Rothstein's 45.

As Coach Shrewsberry stated, it was a culmination of all their games played, specifically the three losses this year. In fact, not only did they close, but they battled back. The Irish were down 12 to Missouri (7 at the half) and 11 to TCU (9 at the half). The last time Notre Dame came back to win after being down 9+ at halftime was a 13-point deficit to Virginia Tech in the ACC

Tourney on March 7, 2018.

It was done by playing team basketball - making the extra pass and hitting clutch shots. Notre Dame produced 16 assists on 25 made field goals against Mizzou. Then recorded 27 assists on 33 made field goals at TCU. The latter marked the most assists in a game since at Syracuse on Jan. 4, 2020.

The Irish were then looking to make it five in a row when Purdue Fort Wayne came to town but it was a cold shooting day for the home team. The three-point loss dropped ND 21 spots in the NET to 81. They check in now at 66 in KenPom.

A CAREER NIGHT FOR SHREWSBERRY AND MOHAMMED

In that four-game win streak was an 82-58 win over Evansville, which featured career high performances from both Braeden Shrewsberry and Sir Mohammed.

Shrewsberry scored a career-high 26 points on 9-12 shooting from the floor (75%) and finished with a career-high 8 three pointers, shooting 80% from three on 8-10 shooting.

Then there was Mohammed who dropped a career-high 21 points on 8-12 shooting from the floor. Mohammed also chipped in two rebounds and three assists for the Irish.

SHREWSBERRY DIALED IN

That last note now leads us to Who's Hot 2.0, which is Braeden Shrewsberry. He's also filling the scoring hole that is Burton and has produced five straight games in double figures. He's averaging 15.8 ppg in that span on 51.0% shooting.

He's been dialed in from beyond the arc where he's 21-41 (.512) over the last five games. That was the fifth best three point field goal percentage in the month of December for anyone with at least 20 made threes.

More on Braeden over his last five games:
- His 71.6 effective FG% and 72.5 true shooting % both rank in the 99th percentile according to CBB Analytics.

Overall, Braeden is 48.8 percent from three, which ranks second in the ACC & 14th in the nation. He's converting 3.3 made threes

per game, which ranks second in the league. Lastly, his 42 total threes ranks 17th nationally.

REBOUNTING TRANSLATES

Coach on Towt: "He's energy personified. There have been a ton of transfers that transferred up and there scoring output doesn't necessarily follow. Rebounding translates at every level. It's heart and it's effort. That's what he does. Carson is just max effort, man. He just plays really hard. His effort on the glass on both ends, his physicality. He's a big brother to these dudes. He's feeding their belief because of the energy and the confidence that he gives them."

Last year's NCAA rebounding leader Carson Towt has been a high-level impact transfer from Northern Arizona. To start, he tied his career-high 19 rebounds in the season opener, which also set a new record for an Irish debut. He then became the first Irish player in the conference era (1995-present) to start the season with six straight games with double-digit rebounds.

Towt's current rebounding rankings:

- 10.2 rpg ranks 16th nationally, 2nd in the ACC
- 3.5 offensive rpg - 2nd in the ACC
- 6.6 defensive rpg - 5th in the ACC
- 132 total boards - 7th nationally, 2nd in the ACC
- 1,210 career rebounds - leads all active players

MORE THAN JUST REBOUNTING

Carson Towt is 19-26 (.731) from the floor over the past four games. He's averaging a double-double in that span at 10.0 points & 10.0 rebounds. He's also recorded the second most assists over the last four games with 11.

During that stretch, the graduate recorded a season high 19 points against Idaho, in what was his third double-double of the season (15 boards). He also scored 13 points in big road win at TCU, in which he was a perfect 6-6 from the floor, to go with his 9 boards & 4 assists.

CERTA-FIED

Cole Certa has flashed NBA Jam on fire like moments at different points of this season.

The sophomore sharpshooter flashed it in the season opener when he dropped 22 points on a career best 6-9 night from three-point range. He showed it vs. Mizzou when he converted three triples in the final 4:35 of the game, including the game-winning three with 17 seconds left.

But nothing tops his second half at TCU where he drained four triples in a row, ultimately converting five in the half and six in the game to finish with 20 points. It marked the second game this season in which Certa came off the bench and drained 5+ threes.

Over the last five games, Certa has averaged the third most points at 12.2 ppg. He's 15-33 from three in that span (.455).

NOTRE NOTABLES

- The Irish are 13 wins away from 2,000 all-time. They would become the eighth program to achieve this feat.
- Logan Imes earned a career high 12 points vs. Purdue Fort Wayne (12/21). He shot 5-10 from the floor, including 2 triples. He also grabbed a career best 4 steals.
- Certa is a perfect 22-22 from the FT line. This marks the third most free throws made for those Division I players who have not missed this season.
- Njie grabbed a season best 10 rebounds in win over Evansville.
- According to Haslam Metrics, Notre Dame allows the 'Average Opponent' to convert only 3.2% of all second-chance opportunities (ranked 12th in the NCAA), and with a rating of 10.30, they're 13th in potential points allowed off of the offensive glass as well.
- Kenpom Rating: Offense 114.5 (81st) & Defense 102.1 (66th).

MARK ZACKERY IV ADDED TO MEN'S BASKETBALL ROSTER

Glenn & Stacey Murphy Notre Dame head coach Micah Shrewsberry announced the roster addition of Mark Zackery IV on

Zackery IV is fresh off his freshman football season at Notre Dame, but is no stranger to the game of basketball. The former Indiana Class 4A state champion and Indiana All-Star will provide immediate depth to the point guard position.

"I think that Mark will be a great addition to our program," Shrewsberry stated.

"I have seen him play many times throughout his high school career. Whether competing with Team Teague, Indiana Elite, or Ben Davis High School, he always does things that help lead to winning. He will be an asset for us with his ball handling, playmaking, and defensive abilities. More importantly, he is a great young man that will add more value to our locker room and culture."

PLAYERS ERA ROUNDUP

Notre Dame left the desert with a 1-2 record at the Players Era. The Fighting Irish defeated Rutgers but fell to Kansas and No. 2 Houston by 10 points each. A commonality of both losses was poor three-point shooting, which was a strength heading into this MTE. Versus Kansas, Notre Dame was 4-24, and against Houston, the Irish were 6-28.

Against the top-three ranked Cougars, the Irish showed tremendous fight after falling into a 22-point hole, clawing back to just a four-point deficit. A standout in this game was junior guard Logan Imes, who supplied great minutes and boasted the biggest +/- at +10.

Markus Burton led Notre Dame in scoring for all three games in Vegas. The junior averaged 21.3 ppg on 53.3 percent shooting. He recorded 16 rebounds, 11 assists and six steals.

Freshman guard Jalen Haralson averaged 14.0 ppg in Vegas on 44.1 percent shooting.

IRISH DEPTH LEADS TO 3-0 START

Eleven different Irish scored in the season opener and in game two, six different Irish finished in double figures. The depth was on full display in week one. In game three, Coach Shrews found a lineup that clicked in

the second half, dropping 47 points in that period to win by 20.

Game 1 - Burton popped off for 24 points as Cole Certa exploded onto the scene with 22 points behind six triples. Ryder Frost scored all 15 of his points in the second half.

Game 2 - Notre Dame recorded 19 assists on 36 made field goals. Carson Towt recorded his first double-double in an Irish uniform with 11 points and 10 rebounds. Sir Mohammed was the MVP with 10 points, six rebounds and a career high six assists. Brady Koehler netted his first game in double figures with 10 points.

Game 3 - Braeden Shrewsberry was 6-8 from three to total 18 total points. Jalen Haralson scored 13 of his 17 in the second half and finished the night a perfect 6-6 from the field. Burton led again with 21 points.

Coach Shrewsberry:

"We have 11 guys that are capable. Sometimes in practice you'll have separation, but there hasn't been much separation in practice. Every day a different player plays great and we have so many guys. So we don't have that 'ok you're doing this and this is your spot.' We have options now so we can keep mixing. If it's not your night, that's fine, we can go with someone else and that's ok. We are going to keep trying to press the right buttons."

PRESEASON ACCOLADES FOR BURTON

The collegiate landscape is starting to pick up on what Notre Dame fans already knew - Markus Burton is a special player. The junior guard picked up two major preseason accolades

- First Team Preseason All-ACC - last Irish player to garner Preseason First Team honors was senior forward John Mooney in 2019.
- Bob Cousy Award Watch List - recognizing the top-20 point guards in the country.
- Naismith Trophy Watch List
- Wooden Award Watch List

CORE NUCLEUS INTACT

For Notre Dame and Head Coach Micah Shrewsberry, retention and player development has been key. For the second

consecutive year, the Fighting Irish return the highest scoring by percentage of any ACC school.

1. Notre Dame - 55.1%

Leading those returners is one of the best backcourt duos in the ACC - junior guards Markus Burton and Braeden Shrewsberry. Approaching their third year together on the court, the duo combined for a league best 35.3 ppg.

HIGHEST RATED ND RECRUIT CLASS IN MODERN HISTORY TAKES THE FLOOR

When Micah Shrewsberry became the Glenn & Stacey Murphy Notre Dame Men's Basketball Head Coach he told fans to jump on now because the train was taking off. Said recruiting train built massive momentum that materialized in Notre Dame's highest-rated recruiting class in the modern era.

The class was ranked fourth in the nation by 247Sports, fifth by ESPN, fifth by Rivals and sixth by ON3. It's also the top-rated class in the state of Indiana; second overall in the ACC.

The class is comprised of Tommy Ahneman, Ryder Frost, Brady Koehler and Jalen Haralson - the latter (at the time of his signing) was the highest rated recruit for Notre Dame in the modern era.

Haralson became the 20th McDonald's All-American in program history and the first of the Shrews Era.

Frost was on Paul Biancardi's 2025 top shot-makers list. In 2024, he led the UA summer circuit in three-point percentage, converting 45.2 percent.

Koehler was a 2025 AP Indiana Boys Basketball All-State First Team selection. He attended Coach Shrews' high school and averaged 16.3 points, 6.6 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.0 steals.

Ahneman was the top-ranked prospect in the state of Minnesota and led Cretin-Derham to a Class 4A Station runner-up finish as a senior. He averaged 16.3 points

and 10.6 rebounds. Unfortunately, Ahneman is out indefinitely rehabbing his knee.

PAT GARRITY RETURNS TO ALMA MATER IN NEW ROLE

A Notre Dame basketball alumnus has returned home in a new role aimed at revolutionizing the operational aspect of Fighting Irish basketball. Back in May, Pat Garrity was named the Men's & Women's Basketball General Manager, along with serving as the primary sports administrator for the men's program.

Garrity will be tasked with developing long-term roster management strategies for both programs. He'll work to establish a clear vision in recruiting and the transfer portal, while working hand-in-hand with the NIL office on a financial asset allocation strategy.

As the sport administrator for the men's program, other key components of Garrity's role include, but aren't limited to, the development of annual strategic goals, team personnel management, budget analysis, revenue generation and fundraising, alumni relations and facility management.

Garrity graduated magna cum laude from Notre Dame in 1998 with a B.S. in Science Pre Professional Studies. On the court, he was just as successful – a three-time All-Big East selection, the 1997 Big East Player of the Year, a 1998 Second Team All-American and a two-time First Team Academic All-American. Garrity finished with 2,085 career points, which still ranks fifth all-time.

He was selected 19th overall in the first round of the 1998 NBA draft by the Milwaukee Bucks and traded immediately to the Phoenix Suns. In the summer of 1999 he was traded to the Orlando Magic, competing for nine seasons before retiring in 2008. During this time, he also served as secretary/treasurer for the National Basketball Players Association for seven seasons.

In August of 2014 Garrity landed the role of Director of Strategic Planning for the Detroit Pistons. In the summer of 2016, Garrity was promoted to Assistant General Manager and held that position for four seasons before leaving the post in 2020.

ANALYSIS:
While this site doesn't quite consider them to be in the national title hunt, Notre Dame has the potential to be a formidable opponent for many in Division I. Ranked 77th overall (out of 365) in our most recent ratings, they presently have a record of 9-4. Of the 18 schools in the ACC (average ranking 73.0), they're currently ranked as our #11 team in the conference.

Notre Dame succeeds primarily through their offense. They are ranked 84th in offensive efficiency and score in excess of 115 points every 100 possessions vs. AO. Notre Dame does fairly solid work converting shots between the three-point stripe and the low post. The squad is ranked 70th nationally in mid-range field goal percentage, making about 42.2% of their attempts from those locations vs. AO. The team will take a fair amount of shots from those in-between locations, too. Approximately 26.0% of their attempts vs. AO are of the mid-range variety, which puts the team in the top-100 in that category nationally. Notre Dame has also been generally quite good when shooting the three-pointer. They're ranked 71st nationally in three-point field goal percentage and make about 37.2% of their attempts from there vs. AO.

Notre Dame plays at roughly the same level defensively as they do offensively. The team ranks 97th nationally in defensive efficiency, allowing about 104 points every 100 trips upcourt vs. AO. Notre Dame does a fantastic job to prevent opposing teams from capitalizing on chances from offensive rebounds. The squad allows AO to convert only 3.2% of all second-chance opportunities (ranked 12th in the NCAA), and with a rating of 10.30, they're 13th in potential points allowed off of the offensive glass as well. Notre Dame also boasts one of the better overall defensive field goal percentages in the country. The team ranks #49 nationally in field goal percentage allowed, as AO only makes good on about 41.3% of their total attempts from the floor. If Notre Dame does exhibit a weakness on the defensive end of the floor, it'd likely be the team's unwillingness to take risks in order to score fast points off of the opposition's turnovers. The squad only has a rating of 9.03 in potential points scored off of steals vs. AO, which ranks 35th-worst in the college game.

3rd Season at Notre Dame 5th as a Head Coach at the DI Level

On March 24, 2023, an Indiana native came home to kickstart a new era of Notre Dame men's basketball. Vice President and James E. Rohr Notre Dame Director of Athletics Jack Swarbrick announced Micah Shrewsberry as the 18th head coach in Fighting Irish men's basketball history.

Shrewsberry brought a wealth of experience and success to the helm of the Notre Dame program. All-in-all he's coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals - in addition to coaching all-NBA honorees Jayson Tatum and Jaylen Brown.

Coach Shrewsberry is now hard at work prepping for year three at the helm of the program ahead of the 2025-26 season.

Year Two with the Irish (2024-25)

A year of 'what could have been' as several key injuries kept the team from achieving its fullest potential. Over the course of the season, guards Markus Burton, Braeden Shrewsberry, Matt Allocco and Sir Mohammed all missed significant time. With that said, the Irish finished 15-18 overall and 8-12 in ACC play, once again obtaining the No. 12 seed in the ACC Tournament.

Coach Shrewsberry's core nucleus of players made tremendous strides in year two. Markus Burton solidified himself as an elite guard in the league, earning Second Team honors. Burton led the league in scoring, averaging 23.5 ppg over ACC play. He averaged 21.3 ppg overall which ranked fifth nationally. He joined Irish legend David Rivers as the only two players in program history to average 20+ points and 3+ assists in a season. He also became the seventh fastest player in program history to reach 1,000 career points.

As Braeden Shrewsberry upped his average to 14.0 ppg, Notre Dame boasted the best scoring guard duo in the ACC, topping Duke's Cooper Flagg and Kon Knueppel. Due to the core nucleus, Notre Dame's KenPom offensive efficiency jumped 139 spots from the year prior to 95. The offense, which averaged 64.0 ppg in 2023-24, leaped up to 72.6 ppg in 2024-25.

Despite the roller-coaster season, there were several memorable moments along the way, including Coach Shrewsberry delivering the program's first ever win in Charlottesville against Virginia. How about the Irish recording a 14-point comeback at Boston College, the largest comeback in Coach

Shrewsberry's tenure? How about freshman guard Cole Certa burying a corner three in the final seconds for a 56-54 win over Stanford? How about the four-overtime thriller in the 112-110 win over Cal that saw Burton go off for 43 points? After that victory, Coach Shrews improved to 4-2 in overtime games in his two years in South Bend.

Now, Notre Dame maintained a bulk of its core ahead of the 2025-26 season and will inject a very talented freshman class of Tommy Ahneman, Ryder Frost, Jalen Haralson and Brady Koehler. Back in November of 2024, Coach Shrewsberry and his staff signed these four young men and inked the program's highest ever rated recruiting class in the modern era - a consensus top-10.

Last but not least, the summer of 2024 witnessed Shrewsberry winning a gold medal at the FIBA U18 Americup as an assistant coach with the U.S. U18 team. He'll rejoin the same coaching staff to mentor the US U19 squad at the 2025 FIBA U19 World Cup in June of 2025.

Year One with the Irish (2023-24)

Coach Shrewsberry achieved two of his priorities in the 2023-24 season: establish the right culture at Notre Dame and have the team playing its best basketball at the end of the season. It was a program that returned 1.6% of its scoring and was projected to finish dead last in the ACC. The young Irish team came together and doubled its ACC win total from the year prior, finishing 7-13 in league play. Coach Shrewsberry even received several votes for ACC Coach of the Year. Notre Dame finished with a 13-20 overall record and won one game (First Round vs. Georgia Tech) in the ACC Tournament.

The first key moment of the season included an emphatic 76-54 win over Virginia. What Shrews' crew accomplished had never been done by an Irish team against the Cavaliers ... ever ... it was the largest margin of victory against UVA in the all-time series. In addition, the 76 points were the most scored by an Irish squad against the Cavaliers in regulation in program history. Furthermore, right after the Virginia contest, the Irish almost pulled off the upset to two teams who made the Elite Eight in NC State and Duke.

Next, the Irish bonded together by winning five of six during the final portion of the regular season, which included the final four at home (Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech, Wake Forest, Clemson). From Feb. 1 to March 1, Notre Dame was the biggest mover in kenpom AdjEM across the Power-Five conferences. Another fun stat when the first NET rankings came on Dec. 4, the Irish were 238. On March 10, the Irish were up to 126.

An early Coach Shrewsberry stamp on the program was the defensive intensity. Notre Dame scoring defense of 67.2 finished with a national ranking of 49th in the country, plus 3rd in the ACC. According to KenPom, Notre Dame's defensive efficiency ranked 39th nationally. In ACC play, Notre Dame ranked 2nd in scoring defense (66.4) and 2nd in field goal percentage defense (.417). Of the 20 ACC games - all but three (Virginia Tech on March 9, UNC on March 5 & Syracuse on Feb. 24) were held under their season average, with Miami, Duke and Louisville each held to season-low point totals.



Lastly - two freshman guards flourished under Coach Shrewsberry in Markus Burton and Braeden Shrewsberry. Burton became the program's first ACC Rookie of the Year. He also broke the program freshman scoring record after dropping 577 points. Burton averaged 17.5 points both on the season and in league play, leading the Irish. Shrewsberry was the lone other Irish to finish in double figures, averaging 10.2 points on the year and 11.3 points in ACC play. With that said, Burton and Shrewsberry became the 9th ACC freshmen duo in league history to rank No. 1 and No. 2 for their team in scoring, proving the future is bright in South Bend.

Prior to Notre Dame

Prior to Notre Dame, Shrewsberry produced a historic turnaround as the head coach at Penn State. After a 14-17 first season, Shrewsberry produced a 23-14 mark in 2022-23, just the 12th 20-win season in the 127-year history of Penn State basketball. Furthermore, he collected more Big Ten wins (17) in his first two seasons than any other Penn State head coach.

Shrewsberry certainly captured the nation's attention in late February and into March, going 9-3 over their last 12 games. Shrewsberry then made plenty of noise in the 2023 Big Ten Tournament in Chicago, defeating No. 7 Illinois, No. 2 Northwestern and No. 3 Indiana to reach the championship game as the No. 10 seed. It marked the program's second-ever Big Ten title game appearance. Penn State was just the third double-digit seed to reach the Big Ten Tournament championship game and the first since 2008.

The Nittany Lions then made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2011. In the first round, Shrewsberry and the Nittany Lions knocked off No. 7 seed and SEC Tournament runner-up Texas A&M, winning the program's first NCAA Tournament game since 2001.

In year one at Penn State, Shrewsberry engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense and guided the squad to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games.

Recruiting-wise, Shrewsberry made an instant splash in Happy Valley. In his first year, Shrewsberry signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history, a consensus top-30 class. A year later, he signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, marking the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions had signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes.

Development-wise, Shrewsberry proved himself there as well, turning Jalen Pickett and Seth Lundy into 2nd Round NBA Draft picks. It marked the first time in program history that two Nittany Lions were selected.

Statistically speaking, the 2022-23 squad set the BIG and Penn State single-season team record for three-pointers made in a season with 385. The Nittany Lions compiled a total of five top-15 national statistical rankings. In addition, Shrewsberry tutored an Associated Press All-American in Jalen Pickett and a total of three All-Big Ten players during the 2022-23 season.

Prior to his time with Penn State, Shrewsberry experienced two separate stints at Purdue – one as assistant coach from 2011-13 and another as associate head coach from 2019-21. Highlights include the 2020-21 season, in which Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a 13-6 fourth-place finish in the Big Ten and an 18-10 overall mark, culminating in an NCAA Tournament at-large bid. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections. Shrewsberry played a major role in recruiting Ivey, who grew up in South Bend and is the son of Karen and Kevin Keyes Family Head Women's Basketball Coach Niele Ivey.

Another highlight from his time in West Lafayette includes the 2011-12 squad that produced a 22-13 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the BIG, netting accolades from conference and national entities.

In between his Purdue stints, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach under Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Brown and Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors.

The Brad Stevens connection was previously made at Butler University, where Shrewsberry spent one year as the director of operations then three as an assistant coach. With Shrewsberry on the sidelines, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles and made three NCAA Tournament appearances – which included back-to-back runs to the national championship game in 2010 and 2011.

Also at Butler, he aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, the 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year and a 2010 Final Four All-Tournament Team selection. Hayward was the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Continuing on Shrewsberry's basketball journey, he spent time as the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships.

Shrewsberry was also the first men's basketball head coach at Indiana University South Bend. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

An Indianapolis area native, Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree from Indiana State in 2003. As a player at Hanover, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain.

He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.

- Averaged a team best 21.3 ppg in Vegas on 24-45 (.533) shooting. Nearly perfect 13-14 from the stripe.

- Burton's 24 points against Kansas tied for the most by an opponent against the Jayhawks this season.

- Shot 53.1% in the paint - 11% above the DI average.

- Around the rim he was 29-41 (.707). Overall from two he was 55.7%.

- Over his last 5 games, Burton's Assist Percentage was 42.0% which ranked in the 99th percentile.

- Was 44-48 (917) from the FT line. A career best percentage. Ranked 3rd in the ACC.

- An efficient game: 10-13 FG for 25 points in win over Bellarmine.

- Team best 4 steals vs Detroit Mercy to go with his 13 pts.

- Burton's 19.3 career average ranks 13th amongst active players.

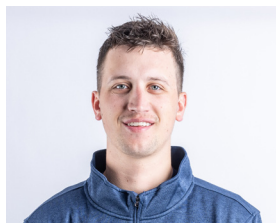
