SETTING THE SCENE

Stanford finished non-conference action at 11-2 and opens ACC action at home against Notre Dame on Tuesday, Dec. 30 at 6 p.m. The game will be broadcast on ESPN2.

THE STARTING FIVE

- Stanford is out to a 11-2 start, including wins over Colorado, Minnesota and Saint Louis at neutral sites, marking its best start since 2019-20. Stanford is outscoring its foes by 9.5 points per game this year.
- Stanford won the Acrisure Invitational in Palm Desert with wins over the Gophers and Billikens, with Benny Gealer's buzzer beater on Nov. 28 sending the Cardinal home victorious.
- Ebuka Okorie is tied for third in the country in scoring at 22.8 points per game and third among freshmen. He joins only Duke's Cameron Boozer and BYU's AJ Dybantsa as freshmen nationally north of 22 points per night. Chisom Okpara is averaging 15.4 points per night, which ranks 17th in the ACC.
- The Cardinal posted a successful first season under the leadership of Kyle Smith, winning the program's most games since 2014-15 (21) and matching a program record for wins on its home court (17). 2025-26 marks the program's second year in the ACC, after Stanford finished seventh in its maiden season. The Cardinal was postseason bound for the first time since 2018, appearing in the NIT.
- Maxime Raynaud graduated from Stanford in 2025 after posting one of the top seasons in program history, and the All-American was drafted by the Sacramento Kings in June. Raynaud, Spencer Jones and Ziaire Williams have each scored 20 or more in the NBA since Dec. 1, including career highs for Jones (28) and Raynaud (25). He is posting 14.3 points and 9.6 rebounds as a starter with Sacramento (eight games).

30, AGAIN

Ebuka Okorie led the Cardinal with 30 points, finishing 9-for-18 from the floor with four 3-pointers and eight free throws in am 88-80 victory over CSUN. Okorie, who broke Stanford's freshman scoring record with 32 points on Dec. 20 vs. Colorado, is the first Cardinal student-athlete with back-to-back 30-point outings since Landry Fields on Jan. 23 and 28 in 2010. Chisom Okpara tallied his fourth 20-point outing of the campaign, while Benny Gealer finished with 13 points and Ryan Agarwal ended with 10.

OUTSTANDING OKORIE

As the calendar gets ready to flip to 2026, Ebuka Okorie has dazzled for the Cardinal with averages of 22.8 points, 3.5 rebounds, 2.9 assists and 1.7 steals per game. Okorie is tied for third nationally in scoring, and third among freshmen, joining Duke's Cameron Boozer and BYU's AJ Dybantsa as the only three freshmen nationally above 20 points per game, and second in the ACC, trailing only Boozer. Okorie became the first Stanford freshman with four-straight 20-point games since Brook Lopez from Feb. 15-24, 2007. He would be the first freshman to meet his averages in points, rebounds, assists and steals, along with Boozer, since Oklahoma's Trae Young and Howard's RJ Cole in 2017-18.

The 26 points in Okorie's debut marked the most for a Cardinal true freshman in program history against a Division I opponent - only Mark Pitchford had more, coming against Division II Cal Poly in 1977. He was the first freshman point guard to start the season opener since Tyrell Terry in 2019 and just the third freshman overall to start the opener since 2019, joining Ziaire Williams (2020) and Harrison Ingram (2021).

Okorie broke Stanford's freshman scoring record with 32 points against Colorado (Dec. 20), topping the mark previously held by Kanaan Carlyle, vs. Washington State on Jan. 18, 2024. His 18 made free throws in the game are the second most in a single game by any player in program history, trailing only the 19 by Reid Travis on Dec. 3, 2016 vs. Kansas. The 18 makes at the line are the second-most by any player in the country this season, while his 21 attempts are tied for first. Okorie ranks second in the country with 7.5 free throws per game, trailing only Auburn's Keyshawn Hall (7.6). Okorie is already tied for 15th with Tim Young in Stanford's freshman history with 83 made free throws this season.

ACRISURE INVITATIONAL CHAMPIONS

With wins over Minnesota and Saint Louis, Stanford captured its first multi-team event championship since the 2007 Basketball Travelers Classic, winning the Acrisure Invitational. The Cardinal opened with a win over Minnesota on Thanksgiving Day, 72-68, to reach the championship game. Ebuka Okorie led the way with 25 points, while Benny Gealer had 14 and Chisom Okpara 11. Chisom Okpara led four Cardinal players in double figure with 19 points against the Billikens, while Okorie had 17, Jeremy Dent-Smith 12 and AJ Rohosy 11. Trailing by two in the closing seconds, Okorie missed a free throw intentionally, which was rebounded by Rohosy, who found Gealer for the game-winner with 0.8 to play.

Gealer was honored as the tournament's Most Valuable Player. Ebuka Okorie ranked second in the field with 21.0 points per game, second with 4.0 assists per game and first in assist-to-turnover ratio at 8-to-1. Chisom Okpara was sixth with 15.0 points per game, while AJ Rohosy was first with 7.0 rebounds per game and Benny Gealer first with 2.0 steals per game. Rohosy and Okpara were two of three players to lead the bracket in offensive rebounds with 3.0 per night.

STATISTICS 101

In addition to Ebuka Okorie leading the ACC in scoring, he also ranks seventh in steals (1.7), 10th in free throw percentage (.814), and sixth in minutes played (33.1). Okorie is one of two players nationally to meet his averages in points, rebounds, assists and steals per game. Chisom Okpara ranks 17th in the ACC in scoring (15.4), and Stanford joins North Carolina, Miami, Cal, SMU and Louisville in having two of the top-17 scorers in the ACC. Benny Gealer ranks eighth in the ACC with 2.5 made 3-pointers per game, doing so at a 46.5 percent clip, which is third-best in the ACC. Gealer also ranks fifth in the ACC with 1.8 steals per game and 12th nationally in free throw percentage, per KenPom. AJ Rohosy slots in 20th in the ACC with 6.0 rebounds while ranking in the top-155 nationally in offensive and defensive rebound percentage, while Oskar Giltay ranks 17th in the ACC with 1.1 blocks per game and 21st with 2.2 offensive rebounds per game.

The Cardinal ranks third in the ACC as a team in turnovers forced per game at 15.2 and sixth in turnover margin at plus-3.5, while ranking eighth in the country in offensive steal percentage (6.7%), per KenPom. Stanford also ranks first in the ACC in defensive rebounds percentage (76.4%, seventh nationally) and 22nd nationally in limiting opponent assists (43.8%). Additionally, it received its first votes in the AP poll (Nov. 10 and Nov. 17) since week two of 2020-21.

DROP YOUR BUFFS

Led by a dominant performance from freshman Ebuka Okorie, Stanford rolled to a 77-68 victory over Colorado in the Hall of Fame Series Phoenix at Mortgage Matchup Center. Okorie broke the Stanford freshman scoring record with a career-best 32 points, going 6-for-13 from the floor with a pair of threes and an 18-for-21 mark at the free throw line. Benny Gealer scored 13 points, including a trio of 3-pointers, while Chisom Okpara added 11 with five rebounds to help Stanford stay unbeaten away from home (4-0).

THE NET RESULT

Stanford enters the matchup with the Fighting Irish at No. 83 in the NET rankings (Dec. 28). The matchup is currently a quadrant three contest, as Notre Dame slots in at No. 80. 16 of Stanford's 31 regular season games are currently slated to be in quadrant one or two, including 10 in Q1. Stanford has one quadrant one victory so far, against Saint Louis in the Acrisure Invitational championship game.

IRISH VISIT THE FARM

Stanford and Notre Dame will play basketball's version of the historic rivalry for the fifth time, with Stanford looking for its first win in the series. The Irish's only previous visit to Maples came on Jan. 12, 1993 - a six-point Irish win. Notre Dame won the first ACC meeting, 56-54, in South Bend after the game-winning three with 18 seconds to play.

CLASS OF 2026 SIGNS

Stanford has signed a top-15 class nationally in the class of 2026, with all four prospects rated as four-star players: Aziz Olajuwon (G/F, 6-7, Houston, Texas), Isaiah Rogers (G, 6-3, Corona, Calif.), Elias Obenyah (G, 6-5, Ukiah, Calif.) and Julius Price (G, 6-2, Santa Maria, Calif.). The class ranks 13th nationally from ESPN and 14th from and 247 Sports.

Olajuwon, the son of former NBA star Hakeem Olajuwon, is ranked as high as No. 40 nationally from ESPN, while 247 Sports ranks Price at No. 87. Rodgers and Obenyah are consensus top-150 signings.

SHOOTERS SHOOT

Stanford has made nine or more 3-pointers in five of the last seven games, including 14 against Portland (Dec. 1) and 13 against Saint Louis (Nov. 28). The Cardinal's 14 against the Pilots gave it at least 13 threes in back-to-back games for the first time since at least 2004, and they were the most since making a program record 19 threes on Feb. 10, 2024 vs. USC. Stanford hit 11 in the first half against Portland, just one shy of the 12 from the USC game in 2024. Benny Gealer leads the way at 46.5 percent from beyond the arc, ranking third in the ACC and eighth in made 3-pointers per game.

Stanford had nine or more threes for the first time in four straight games (Nov. 28-Dec. 13) since Feb. 27-March 13, 2013. Stanford is shooting 39.8 percent from beyond the arc over the last seven games with four players shooting above 39 percent: Benny Gealer (17-for-36, 47.2%), Ryan Agarwal (12-for-28, 42.9%), Chisom Okpara (10-for-25, 40%) and Jeremy Dent-Smith (16-for-41, 39%). Over the same stretch, Stanford held its opponents to just 32.7 percent from beyond the arc on just 5.0 made triples per game.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

Stanford finished the 2024-25 regular season with the ACC's second-best home record, and it went 17-3 overall, including a 9-1 mark in the ACC. Duke went 10-0 in the ACC at home, while the Cardinal were one of three one-loss teams at home in conference play, along with Clemson and Louisville. Stanford outscored all opponents at home by 11.0 points per night in ACC play. The Cardinal matched its program record, along with the 2011-12 team, with 17 home wins, and it is 7-2 to open the season in 2025-26, outscoring opponents by 11.7 points at Maples.

LEVELING UP

Stanford's AJ Rohosy (Claremont-Mudd-Scripps, Division III) and Jeremy Dent-Smith (Cal State Dominguez Hills, Division II), have been revelations this season as graduate transfers. Rohosy - an All-American and Academic All-American last season at CMS - is averaging 9.4 points per game on 56.7 percent shooting with six games in double figures, while Dent-Smith - a two-time All-American at CSUDH - is averaging 7.2 points per game with five double-digit scoring performances.

BAY AREA BATTLE

Stanford remained unbeaten away from home with a road win at San Jose State, 86-82. Stanford has won seven consecutive Bay Area clashes, including a 5-0 run against rival California, and seven straight battles with the Spartans dating back to 1992. Chisom Okpara and AJ Rohosy scored 20 points apiece, while Rohosy joined Jeremy Dent-Smith (16) in setting or tying season-highs. Stanford was strong offensively, shooting 60.9 percent from the floor and 50 percent from beyond the three-point arc. The last time Stanford was over 60 percent in a game was Feb. 11, 2023 vs. Arizona, while the Cardinal has made at least nine threes in four consecutive games for the first time since Feb. 27-March 13, 2013. Additionally, Stanford limited San Jose State to just eight defensive rebounds, marking its lowest total for an opponent since Nov. 9, 2007 vs. Harvard (6).

NERDBALL IN ACTION

Kyle Smith doesn't just love analytics - the analytics love him back. Smith was ranked No. 7 on KenPom's list of the top 25 active coaches based on what they add to what is already captured by the model predictors. He was one of four coaches to rank in the top-15 on both sides of the ball.

KING RAYNAUD

Maxime Raynaud was the nation's premier center last season, averaging 20.1 points and 10.6 rebounds per game, ranking 14th and ninth nationally, while also ranking second in the country in double-doubles (25). His 21st double-double, coming against Boston College on Feb. 26, set a new Stanford single-season record, passing Adam Keefe (1991-92), while Raynaud was the only player in the country to average at least 20 points and 10 rebounds. He ranked first in the ACC in rebounding and second in scoring while setting a new Stanford single-season record with 371 rebounds, and he finished fourth all-time with 707 points in a season. Raynaud graduated as the third Stanford player to record at least 1,600 points and 900 rebounds in program history, joining Adam Keefe and Kim Belton. Raynaud was drafted in the second round of the 2025 NBA Draft by the Sacramento Kings, and he gave the Cardinal an NBA Draft selection for the fourth time in seven years, making Stanford one of four teams in the ACC to accomplish the feat, joining Duke, North Carolina and Florida State.

PRO CARD

Raynaud is one of five Stanford players in the NBA, and he joins Spencer Jones (Denver Nuggets) and Brook Lopez (LA Clippers) as players currently starting. Jones is averaging 8.4 points per game across 16 starts, while Lopez is at 7.1 points per game back on the west coast. Ziaire Williams is averaging 8.7 points per game with the Brooklyn Nets while Dwight Powell is at 2.7 points with the Dallas Mavericks. Raynaud leads the alumni with 10.3 points per game this season, and 14.8 points as a starter.

KYLE SMITH

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL SECOND SEASON AT STANFORD



Kyle Smith was announced as the Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball on March 25, 2024, and he begins his second season at Stanford in 2025-26.

In its first season in the ACC, and the first under Smith, the Cardinal finished the 2024-25 season at 21-14 overall, marking its most total victories since 2014-15 while matching a program record with 17 wins at Maples Pavilion. Stanford went 9-1 at home in the ACC, while Smith is just the second coach in program history to win 20 or more games in his first season. Additionally, the seven-win improvement year-to-year matches a program record for a first-year head coach. Smith saw numerous players have career-best seasons, led by All-American and ACC first team honoree and Scholar-Athlete of the Year, Maxime Raynaud.

Smith landed at The Farm following a successful five-year stint at Washington State, where he went 94-71 overall, including a 25-10 mark and second-place finish in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. Smith holds a 290-209 career record across 15-plus seasons as a head coach, including six seasons at Columbia and three at San Francisco. Additionally, he spent 18 years as an assistant coach with stretches at Saint Mary's (2001-10), Air Force (2000-01) and San Diego (1992-2000).

The 2024 John R. Wooden Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Smith led the Cougars to a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the round of 32 with a victory over Drake in the opening round, while the postseason event was the seventh for Smith as a head coach and third with Washington State. The Cougars also reached the NIT semifinals in 2022 and earned a bid for a second consecutive season in 2023.

Smith was the first coach in Washington State history to post a .500 or better record in each of his first four seasons, doing so after taking over a program that was under .500 in each of the previous seven campaigns.

A talented coach known for expertise in analytics and player development, Smith's tutelage has included three NBA Draft selections in CJ Elleby (2020), Mouhamed Gueye (2023) and Jaylen Wells (2024), as well as Pac-12 Freshman of the Year Myles Rice (2024), while three Cougars earned All-Pac-12 recognition in 2024. Smith also coached San Francisco's Jamaree Bouyea, who made his NBA debut in 2023, and mentored a series of professional athletes as an assistant coach, including NBA players Matthew Dellavedova and Patty Mills at Saint Mary's.

Smith has also seen success on the recruiting trail, landing two top-60 classes, the highest for Washington State in over a decade. He signed a top-100 prospect to Pullman in the class of 2022, the first for the program since Klay Thompson in 2008.

Prior to Smith's tenure at Washington State, he led San Francisco to a 63-40 record, including 20 wins or more in each season and two postseason appearances. His three straight 20-win seasons marked just the fourth time in school history that a USF coach accomplished the feat and the first time in nearly 40 years. Smith produced seven All-WCC picks, paced by two-time All-WCC first team selection Frankie Ferrari.

Preceding his time in the Bay Area, he served as the head coach at Columbia where he put together a 101-82 overall mark, including a CIT Championship in his final season. Smith mentored 10 All-Ivy League selections over his six seasons at Columbia, led by Maodo Lo, a two-time first team honoree and the second-leading scorer in school history.

Smith played an integral role in building the Gaels' program into a perennial championship contender in the West Coast Conference under head coach Randy Bennett. In his nine seasons in Moraga, the Gaels made three NCAA Tournament (2005, '08, '10) appearances and earned one NIT bid (2009). Saint Mary's averaged 23 wins over Smith's last six seasons on the staff, including an 81-20 record over his final three seasons. The 2009-10 team finished with a 28-6 record, advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Championship and was ranked 19th nationally in the final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll.

During his one season at Air Force, Smith served as the Falcons' offensive and recruiting coordinator and took a lead role with player development and scouting. He was instrumental in the recruitment of 2003-04 Mountain West Conference Player of the Year Nick Welch along with all-conference players Antoine Hood and A.J. Kuhle.

Before joining the Falcons, Smith served eight seasons as an assistant coach at San Diego from 1992-2000 under Hank Egan and Brad Holland. During his time at San Diego, Smith helped lead the Toreros to their second-highest win total in school history (20 in 1999-2000) and as associate head coach, orchestrated a defense that allowed the lowest opponent scoring average (62.6) in the West Coast Conference (62.6 in 1999-2000).

Born in El Paso, Texas, Smith graduated in 1992 from Hamilton College with a degree in English literature. He also played basketball and helped lead the Continentals to a 26-1 record and the No. 1 ranking in the nation for NCAA Division III as a junior. He shot a school-record 51.3 percent from three-point range and helped Hamilton to an Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) championship.

Smith earned a master's degree in educational leadership from the University of San Diego, where he began his coaching career.

Kyle and his wife, Katie, have three sons, Rocco, Bo, and Luke.
