FAST BREAK

■ Head coach Jeff Walz collected his 500th career win on Jan. 4 against Virginia Tech. He becomes the third fastest active head coach to reach 500 wins for his career. Kim Mulkey (17 seasons) and Geno Auriemma (18 seasons) are the only two active head coaches to reach 500 wins quicker than Walz. Among all Division I coaches, Walz is the fourth fastest coach to reach 500 wins.

■ The Cards have four Quad 1 wins this season, the most of any team in the ACC. The league has 15 Quad 1 wins this season with the Cards accounting for 27% of those wins. Louisville is 4-3 in Quad 1 games this season, the only ACC team with a .500 or better record against Quad 1 opponents. Louisville leads the ACC with a NET of 11 and a Wins Above Bubble (WAB) rank of 7.

■ Louisville has faced a gauntlet of a schedule this season with a number of ranked opponents on the slate. Louisville played the preseason No. 1 and No. 2 teams in their non-conference schedule, just one of two teams nationally to face both teams during non-conference play. The Cardinals have played five Top 20 teams so far this season and the 23rd-ranked Irish will be their sixth ranked opponent of the season.

■ Walz ranks ninth among active head coaches with a .771 career winning percentage (502-149). Among power conferences, Walz ranks sixth overall and has the highest winning percentage among ACC coaches.

■ Louisville has been getting great production from the bench this season as they lead the ACC and rank second nationally with 36.3 bench points per game. They have had 40 or more bench points eight times this season and the Louisville bench has outscored opponents on their own three times this season.

■ The Cardinals have been strong on the defensive front this season, holding opponents to 58.7 points per game. They have limited opponents to 60 points or less 10 times this season and held them to 50 points or less six times this year. The Cardinals have held their opponent below their season scoring average in each of the last 17 games dating back to Nov. 12.

ABOUT THE FIGHTING IRISH

Notre Dame enters Thursday's matchup with a 12-4 overall record and are 4-2 in ACC play. The Irish are ranked 23rd in most recent AP poll and xx in the most recent coaches poll. Notre Dame's ACC wins this season have come against #22/#18 North Carolina (73-50), Boston College (94-60), Pitt (94-59) and Florida State (93-60) while the defeats have come against Duke (68-82) and Georgia Tech (90-95, OT). Notre Dame leads the ACC and ranks sixth in steals per game (15.3), lead the ACC and rank eighth nationally in free throw percentage (79.2%) and lead the ACC and rank 14th nationally in turnover margin (+8.7). Hannah Hidalgo leads the NCAA with 5.9 steals per game and ranks second nationally with 25.1 points per game. She leads the ACC with 34.3 minutes played per game and the Irish have three players that rank in the Top 10 in the ACC in minutes played per game (Vanessa de Jesus, 6th, 33.5; Cassandre Prosper, 8th, 33.2).

■ **Series History** - This will be the 37th meeting between the two schools as they have been conference foes going back to the BIG EAST days. The Cardinals trail the all-time series 14-22. Louisville is 8-6 over the last 14 matchups dating back to the 2018-19 season. The Cardinals are 5-9 all-time in games played up in South Bend.

■ **Last Meeting (Mar. 2, 2025)** - The No. 25/RV Louisville women's basketball team (20-9, 13-5 ACC) dropped its final game of the regular season, 72-59, to No. 3 Notre Dame (24-5, 16-2 ACC) Sunday afternoon at Purcell Pavilion. The Cardinals had a one point lead following the first quarter but were unable to keep up with the Irish the rest of the afternoon. Jayda Curry led the Cards in scoring with 19 points and tied a career high with five three-pointers. Curry has scored 15 or more points in each of her last six games.

THE NEW MR. 500

Head coach Jeff Walz picked up his 500th career win in the Cardinals 85-60 win over Virginia Tech on Jan. 4.

■ Walz is the third fastest active head coach to reach 500 wins for his career. Kim Mulkey (17 seasons) and Geno Auriemma (18 seasons) are the only two active head coaches to reach 500 career wins faster than Walz (19 seasons).

■ Among all Division I coaches, Walz is tied for fourth all-time for the fastest to reach 500 wins for their career, trailing just Mulkey, Auriemma and Leon Barmore.

■ **Making the Extra Pass** - Louisville tallied 20 assists on its 36 made baskets in the win over Pitt. It was the third-straight game and the eighth time this season the Cardinals have had 20 or more assists in a game. Louisville is averaging 17.8 assists per game in ACC play this season.

■ **Active in the Passing Lanes** - Louisville tallied a season-best 18 steals in its most recent win over Pitt. It was the most steals for the Cardinals in an ACC game since January 6, 2022, when they had 19 against Pitt.

■ **Biggest ACC Win in Four Years** - The Cardinals 40-point win over Pitt on Jan. 11 was their largest margin of victory in an ACC game since January 6, 2022, when they defeated Pitt by 42.

CARDS POST-THANKSGIVING STREAK

The Cardinals have been running on all cylinders on both sides of the ball since the Thanksgiving holiday.

- Over the last 13 games, the Cardinals have averaged 86.4 points per game, hold a +30.8 scoring margin and have shot 46.7% from the field and 35.0% from three.
- Louisville's lowest point total over this streak has been 76 points as they have scored 80 or more points nine times and 90 or more points five times.
- The Cards have averaged 18.8 assists per game and have a 1.4 assist/turnover ratio over the last 13 games.
- Defensively, Louisville's opponents are averaging just 55.6 points per game.
- The Cards have held their opponents to 60 points or less eight times and 50 points or less five times over this stretch.
- Louisville has dominated the glass as they have averaged 47.6 rebounds per game and have a +14.7 rebounding margin over the last 13 games.
- The Cards have had contributions from multiple players over this stretch. They have had six different players lead them in scoring, six different players lead the team in rebounding and six different players lead the team in assists.

CARDS CRUSH NO. 17/18 TENNESSEE, 89-65

Louisville had a dominant 89-65 win over No. 17/18 Tennessee on Dec. 20 in the Women's Champions Classic at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, NY.

- After the score was tied halfway through the third quarter, Louisville outscored the Volunteers 41-17 over the final 15 minutes to clinch the win.
- The 24-point margin is the largest win by an ACC team against a ranked opponent this season.
- It was Louisville's largest win over a Top 20 team since March of 2023, when the Cardinals defeated No. 10 Notre Dame, 64-38.
- The 24-point loss was the largest loss for the Volunteers since Feb. 27, 2025, when they lost by 24 to Kentucky.
- Louisville hauled in 59 rebounds in the win, the most rebounds given up by Tennessee in a game since Feb. 20, 2022, when they allowed 59 rebounds in a loss to No. 1 South Carolina.

INCREDIBLE IMARI

Sophomore guard Imari Berry has been lighting it up in her second year with the Cardinals.

- On the season, she is averaging 10.5 points, 5.1 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game while shooting 46.1% from the field.
- Since the ETSU game on Nov. 29, Berry has averaged a team-best 11.7 points with 5.9 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 1.6 steals per game while shooting 50.5% from the field, 50.0% from three and 92.6% from the line.
- She has scored in double figures nine times over the past 12 games while hauling in five rebounds or more in eight of the last 12 games.
- Scored 12 points on 4-for-5 shooting, 2-for-2 from three with seven rebounds in the win over Pitt.
- Tallied 14 of her 16 points in the second half, including 11-straight points in the fourth quarter, in the road win over Miami. She set a season-high with 4-for-6 shooting from three.
- Had 13 points on 5-for-8 shooting and 3-for-4 from three in the win over Virginia Tech.
- Scored 11 points and led the team with nine rebounds in the win over SMU.
- Had one of the best games of her career with 15 points and a career-best 13 rebounds for her first career double-double while tying a career best with four steals in the win over No. 17/18 Tennessee.
- Scored 11 of her 13 points in the second half and overtime of Louisville's 76-66 overtime win over No. 12/11 North Carolina.

HEAD COACH JEFF WALZ



Head coach **Jeff Walz**, in his 19th season as a head coach, has compiled a 502-149 record as the Cardinals' leader. Walz and the Cardinals boast quite an astounding resumé that includes 12 trips to the NCAA Sweet 16, eight trips to the Elite Eight, four trips to the final four and two trips to the national title game. Overall, he has compiled a 41-16 record in NCAA Tournament games and ranks 10th all-time and fifth among active coaches with a 71.9 NCAA Tournament winning percentage. All of this for a program that had just four NCAA Tournament wins and had never reached a Sweet 16 prior to Walz being named head coach.

Walz is the all-time winningest coach in program history and averages 27.1 victories per season. He directed Louisville to a program-record 36 victories in 2017-18 en route to being named ACC Coach of the Year, 34 victories in 2008-09, 33 wins in 2013-14, 32 wins in 2018-19 and 29 wins in 2021-22.

Walz has been with the Cardinals for 19 seasons and is tied for 14th for the longest active streak at the same school. Among the power conferences, Walz is fifth behind Geno Auriemma (41 years, UConn), Bill Fennelly (31 years, Iowa State), Brenda Frese (24 years, Maryland) and Jim Flanery (24 years, Creighton).

The Cardinals have reached 20 wins 15 consecutive times and they have won at least 20 games in 17 of Walz's 18 full seasons. The longest run previously was three, achieved twice, and UofL had just 10 20-win seasons in its 32 previous years.

Walz led Louisville to four consecutive Atlantic Coast Conference regular season titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021, and over that four-year span, the Cardinals went a combined 122-15, which marked the fewest losses and best winning percentage over a four-year period in program history.

From 2016-2021, he coached the ACC Player of the Year in five of six seasons as Myisha Hines-Allen won the award in 2016, Asia Durr in 2018 and 2019, and Dana Evans in 2020 and 2021. He also coached Angel McCoughtry to Big East Player of the Year honors in 2007.

After being hired as the Cardinals' head coach on March 27, 2007, the Bluegrass State native used little time to make a splash. His first year featured the program's first NCAA Sweet 16 and it culminated with Louisville earning the No. 12 ranking in the final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. For his efforts, Walz was named the WBCA Maggie Dixon Rookie Coach of the Year.

Prior to taking the reins at Louisville, Walz spent five seasons at Maryland, including his final season as the associate head coach in 2006-07. The season prior, he helped lead the Terrapins to a school-record 34 wins and the program's first national title.

Walz has four children: daughter Kaeley, son Jacob, and daughters Lola and Lucy. He married the former Lauren Lueders in September of 2012, and the couple resides in Louisville.

ELIF'S SUMMER ABROAD

Forward Elif Istanbuluoglu spent most of her summer overseas as she competed with multiple levels of the Türkiye National Teams.

- In her first summer tournament, Elif made the Türkiye Senior National Team for the 2025 FIBA EuroBasket in Greece. Coach Walz and graduate assistant Selim Aldag were on the Türkiye staff and the team finished seventh overall.

- Later in the summer, Elif played with the U20 team at the 2025 FIBA U20 EuroBasket in Portugal and had a breakout tournament.

- She led the squad with 17.9 points and 11.1 rebounds per game while shooting 44.0 percent from the floor.

- Elif was one of 10 'Players who lit up FIBA U20 Women's EuroBasket 2025' by FIBA following the tournament.

- Had career highs in back-to-back games with 12 points against EIU and 15 against ETSU.

- Tied a career high with 15 points and led the team with nine rebounds against No. 3 South Carolina.

- Set a career high with 16 points and 39 minutes played in the overtime road win over No. 12/11 North Carolina.

- Tallied a career-best 14 rebounds in the win over #17/#18 Tennessee.

- Had her best game in a Louisville uniform in the road win over Miami. She had a career-best 23 points on 9-for-14 shooting and also set a career high with five assists to go with seven rebounds.

- The 23 points were tied for the most by a Louisville player this season.

ZIEGLER THE WALKING DOUBLE-DOUBLE

The Cardinals added one of the most prolific rebounders and scoring post players from the transfer portal in forward Laura Ziegler from Saint Joseph's.

- Ziegler leads the team in rebounding with 7.4 rebounds per game. She has led the team in rebounds in nine games this season.

- She averages 2.8 assists per game and has multiple assists in 15 of the 19 games this season. Ziegler has a team-best 2.0 assist/turnover ratio on the season.

- Scored 13 points on 6-for-8 shooting with seven rebounds in the win over Pitt.

- Tied a season-best with 18 points and led the team with nine rebounds in the win over Virginia Tech.

- Scored 10 points to go with eight rebounds and a team-best six assists in the win over No. 17/18 Tennessee.

- Was named ACC Co-Player of the Week following the wins over Ball State and No. 12/11 North Carolina.

- She had 15 points with five rebounds and two assists in the win over Ball State.

- Eclipsed the 1,500-point mark for her career with 16 in the win over ETSU.

- Collected her third double-double of the season with 18 points and 11 rebounds against No. 20/18 Kentucky.

- She scored in double figures for the fourth-straight game with team-high 13 points against Morehead State.

- Ziegler recorded her second double-double of the season with team-highs 17 points and 10 rebounds in the road win over Clemson.

- She reached double-digit rebounds with a team-best 11 and five assists to go with nine points against NKU.

- In her debut for the Cardinals, Ziegler led the team with 16 points and a career-best 18 rebounds for a double-double against No. 1 UConn.

- The 18 rebounds were the most by an opposing player in a single game against UConn since 2003.

- Ziegler earned Preseason All-ACC honors prior to the season. She was also named to the Naismith Trophy Women's Player of the Year Watch List, Wooden Award Preseason Watch List, USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale Award Watch List and Lisa Leslie Award Watch List.

- In September, Ziegler played with the Denmark National Team in the 3x3 Europe Cup that was hosted in Copenhagen.

- Ziegler spent three seasons at Saint Joseph's prior to transferring to Louisville ahead of her senior season.

- She is coming off a junior season where she led the Atlantic-10 in rebounding with 10.4 per game and was second in the conference in scoring with 17.5 per game.

Sophomore Anaya Hardy is having a breakout season in her second year with the Cardinals.

- She leads the team with a .719 field goal percentage and is second on the team with 5.9 rebounds per game.
- Since the Morehead State game on Nov. 19, Hardy has played 10 minutes or more in 10 of the last 15 games. She has played 20 minutes or more in six of those games.
- She earned her first career start against No. 3 South Carolina and has started in each game since.
- Over the last 15 games, Hardy has averaged 7.0 points per game and 6.5 rebounds per game while shooting 45-for-63 (71.4%) from the field.
- She had a career best and team-high 16 points on 7-for-9 shooting with nine rebounds and career-best three steals in the win over Pitt.
- Hardy has tallied three double-doubles and is tied with Ziegler for the most double-doubles on the season.
- She had 12 points and 13 rebounds against Morehead State, 11 points and 12 rebounds against EIU and 12 points and 10 rebounds against Ball State.
- Hardy has had 10 or more rebounds in four games this year.

RISING ROBERTS

Guard Tajanna Roberts put on a show during her first collegiate season for the Cardinals and is back for her sophomore campaign.

- Leads the team in scoring with 12.3 points per game and has a team-best 13 games in double figures and three 20-point scoring games.
- Two of her three 20-point outings have come against teams that are currently ranked in the Top 10 (No. 3 South Carolina, No. 6 Kentucky)
- Roberts also has a team-best 3.1 assists per game this season. She has had multiple assists in six of the last seven games and in 15 of the 19 games this season.
- Had a career-best seven assists in the win over Miami. The seven assists are tied for the most by a Louisville player in a game this season.
- Led the team in scoring with 15 points and tied a career high with a team-best five assists in the win over SMU.
- Had team-best 18 points, tied a career high with five assists and tied a season best with five rebounds in win over No. 17/18 Tennessee.
- Scored 11 points to go with a team-best four assists and tied a career high with four steals in road win over No. 12/11 North Carolina.
- Tallied a team-best 20 points and was 4-for-8 from three against No. 3 South Carolina.
- Scored in double figures in five-straight games between NKU (11/9) and Eastern Illinois (11/28).
- Scored 22 points against No. 20/18 Kentucky.
- Roberts tied a career high with 23 points on 10-for-16 shooting in the win over NKU.
- Prior to the 2025-26 season, Roberts earned Preseason All-ACC honors from the coaches and Blue Ribbon Panel. She was also named to the Naismith Trophy Women's Player of the Year Watch List, USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale Award Watch List and the HoopHall Ann Meyers Drysdale Award Watch List.
- Roberts started all 33 games as a freshman, averaged 12.8 points per game (second on the team) and led the team with 57 steals on the season.
- She earned ACC All-Freshman team and Second Team All-ACC honors after the regular season. She was one of just two freshmen to earn All-ACC honors.
- Roberts was named ACC Rookie of the Week five times during the season, setting the program record for most freshmen of the week honors in a single season.
- She tallied 25 games with 10 points or more, the most of any ACC freshmen during the season.

SKYLAR'S BEEN SWIPING

The Cards added a defensive menace from the transfer portal in guard/forward Skylar Jones from Arizona.

 - Tied a career high with 15 points and team-best four assists against No. 3 South Carolina.
 - Scored 13 points on 5-for-8 shooting against Bellarmine.
 - Back-to-back games in double figures after scoring 11 points against Morehead State.
 - She was one of three players in double figures with 10 points and added five rebounds in the road win over Clemson.
 - Scott scored in double figures with 13 points on 6-for-8 shooting to go with four rebounds and two steals in the win over NKU.
 - She led the Cards with three assists and added nine points and four rebounds against No. 1 UConn.
 - Scott had 92 career games played over her three years at Oklahoma
 - In her junior year at OU, she started each of the last 16 games and helped the Sooners reach the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament.
 - Scott scored in double figures five times, all against Power Four opponents last season.
 - She dished out five or more assists in six games last year, including career-high eight at No. 7 LSU.

STRENUOUS SCHEDULE

- Louisville has one of the toughest schedules in the country, especially over the first two months of the season.
- Louisville faced both the No. 1 and No. 2 team in the AP preseason poll, just one of two teams nationally to play both teams during the non-conference portion of the schedule.
 - The Cardinals have played five Top 20 teams so far this season.
 - Louisville has four Quad 1 wins this season, which leads the ACC. Louisville has 27% of the leagues Quad 1 victories this season as the ACC has 15 across all teams.

- The Cards are 4-3 in Quad 1 games, the only ACC team to have a .500 record or better against Quad 1 teams.
- All three of Louisville's losses this season have come to teams that are currently ranked in the Top 10 (No. 1 UConn, No. 2 South Carolina, No. 7 Kentucky).
- Louisville leads the ACC with a NET of 11 and a Wins Above Bubble rank of 7.

IN RARE AIR

Jeff Walz is one of the winningest coaches in all of college basketball in the regular season and NCAA Tournament.

- In Women's Basketball, he is one of just four active head coaches (Geno Auriemma, Dawn Staley, Kim Mulkey) and one of 11 all-time to make four or more Final Fours.
- Of those 11, Walz is one of nine to have all of his appearances come at the same school.
- Including Men's Basketball, Walz is one of only seven active coaches to make four or more Final Fours.
- Walz ranks ninth in the NCAA with a .771 career winning percentage (502-149).
- Among power conferences, Walz ranks sixth overall and has the highest career winning percentage in the ACC.

A DECADE (PLUS) OF ACC SUCCESS

Since Louisville joined the ACC back in the 2014-15 season, they have been one of the most successful teams in the conference during the regular season and in the NCAA Tournament.

- Since the 2014-15 season, Louisville leads the league with 157 ACC wins and a .818 winning percentage in conference games. They are the only school in the league to have a winning percentage of .800 or better in ACC games during that timeframe.
- With the win over Stanford on Feb. 9 last season, the Cardinals continued their streak of 10 or more ACC wins in each season since they joined the league. They are the only program in the conference to have 10 or more ACC wins in each of the last 11 seasons.
- Louisville has won 12 or more ACC games in each of their 11 seasons in the league with the win over No. 11 Duke on Feb. 20 last season.
- Louisville has finished in the Top 5 of the league standings every season they have been in the league. They are the only school to finish in the Top 5 in the ACC standings in each of the last 11 seasons.
- The Cardinals have also reached the quarterfinals or farther in each of the last 11 ACC Tournaments, the only school to reach the quarterfinals or farther in each of the last 11 conference tournaments.
- Louisville has had five players named ACC Player of the Year, the most by any school during the last 11 years.
- Over the last five NCAA tournaments (2021-25), Louisville leads the ACC with 11 total wins in the NCAA Tournament.
- In two of those five years (2021, 2022), the Cardinals were the farthest ACC team to advance in the bracket.
- Since the 2014-15 season, Louisville is second in the conference in NCAA Tournament wins (23).

ONE OF THE BEST IN THE COUNTRY

Louisville has been one of the best teams in the country since the start of the 2017-18 season. The Cardinals have totaled 239 wins and an .810 winning percentage. The wins rank fifth and the winning percentage is sixth in the NCAA during that span.

ROAD WARRIORS

Since the start of the 2017-18 season, the Cardinals are 82-21 in true road games. Louisville is fifth in the NCAA in road wins and sixth in road winning percentage (.796) during that span. The Cardinals were 10-4 on the road in 2024-25 with the 10 wins ranked second best in the ACC.

70-PLUS POINTS

The Cardinals are 133-12 in their last 145 games when they have scored 70 points or more, dating back to the 2018-19 season. UofL is 362-35 when surpassing the 70-point plateau under Walz.

ALLOWING 59 POINTS OR LESS

The Cardinals have had great success when allowing 59 points or less in a game over the past few seasons. Louisville has won 60-straight games when allowing 59 points or less in a game after the 86-46 win over Pitt on Jan. 11. The 60-straight wins dates back to the 2020-21 season. Over the past 12 seasons, the Cardinals are 167-4 when allowing 59 points or less in a game.

The Cardinals were 7-0 in games when they shot 50 percent or better from the floor last season and are 4-0 this season after shooting 51.4% in the win over Bellarmine on Nov. 30. Overall, they boast a 163-3 record when shooting 50 percent or better from the field under Walz.

ANOTHER 20-WIN SEASON

UofL defeated Clemson on Feb. 27 last season to reach 20 wins for the 15th-straight season and extended the program record. The 15-straight seasons with 20 or more wins is the fourth-longest active streak in the country and the longest active streak in the ACC. The longest run previously was three, achieved twice. The Cards have won at least 20 games in 17 of Walz's 18 seasons. Prior to Walz's arrival, Louisville had just 10 20-win seasons in its history.

WALZ IN THE BIG DANCE

Walz boasts a 41-16 record in NCAA Tournament games. He is 10th all-time in winning percentage and fifth among active coaches who have coached in at least 25 tournament games or more. He has directed UofL to a pair of national runner-up finishes (2009, 2013), four Final Fours (2009, 2013, 2018, 2022), eight Elite Eights (2009, 2013, 2014, 2018, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023), 12 trips to the Sweet 16 and 16 NCAA Tournaments. Walz is one of four active head coaches to make four or more Final Fours.

PRESEASON AP AND USA TODAY RANKINGS

The Cardinals were ranked #20 in the 2025-26 Associated Press preseason poll and #19 in the USA Today Preseason Poll. They were one of five ACC teams in both polls.

■ **Preseason Top 20** - It marks the 16th-consecutive season that Louisville has been ranked in the Top 20 of the AP preseason poll and the 17th time in Walz's 19-year tenure. The 16-year streak in the preseason Top 20 is the longest active streak of any ACC team. The second-longest active streak among ACC teams is just five years.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

Since the KFC Yum! Center opened its doors for the 2010-11 season, the Cardinals have had one of the best home court advantages in the country. Louisville is 224-39 all-time at the KFC Yum! Center over the past 16 seasons. The Cardinals program record for consecutive home wins is 21 games, a streak that spanned over three seasons. Over the past nine seasons, Louisville is 119-15 at home.

BEST FANS IN THE COUNTRY

During the 2024-25 season, Louisville averaged 8,417 fans at the KFC Yum! Center, which was first in the ACC and eighth in the country. The 8,417 fans per game ranked eighth in ACC men's basketball for the 2024-25 season. For 15 straight-seasons, they have led the ACC and ranked in the top 10 in the country in attendance. They had a season-best 11,603 fans against Notre Dame last season.






