THE OPENING TIP

• Pitt begins the home stretch Saturday as the Panthers host Notre Dame in a pivotal ACC game. The contest is scheduled for a 2 p.m. tipoff on the ACC Network.

• Kevin Brown and Randolph Childress will be on the call for Saturday's game on ACC Network.

• The game will also be broadcast on the Panthers Radio Network (flagship 93.7 The Fan) with Bill Hillgrove (play-by-play) and Curtis Aiken (analysis) providing the commentary.

• The winner of Saturday's game will take a pivotal step towards securing one of the league's 15 berths to the ACC Tournament. Five teams enter the weekend with four league wins or

fewer and two of those teams will advance to ACC Tournament play. At 3-10, Notre Dame is currently in the driver's seat for the 15 seed, but a Pitt win spring the Panthers into position.

• Both teams had a midweek bye but Notre Dame picked up an 89-74 win over Georgia Tech that snapped a five-game losing streak. Pitt is currently on a five-game skid with four of those contests coming against top 25 teams.

• Notre Dame leads the all-time series between the two programs, 41-32, and has won each of the last two meetings between the two programs, including a contest that ended Pitt's season in the ACC Tournament a year ago.

THE ALL-TIME SERIES

• Pitt and Notre Dame have played 73 times previously and the Fighting Irish hold a 41-32 lead in the all-time series, including an 8-2 lead in the last 10 games.

• Notre Dame is 8-5 in ACC regular season games against Pitt and was 14-11 when the two teams played in the Big East. Notre Dame has also posted two ACC Tournament wins, most recently last year's 55-54 victory.

• During Pitt's undefeated 1927-28 national championship season, the Panthers' Charley Hyatt scored at the buzzer for a 24-22 victory over Notre Dame that helped secure the Helms Foundation National Championship and a 21-0 record. Notre Dame would go on to win a national title two years later.

• The highest scoring game in the all-time series came inside the Petersen Events Center on January 4, 2006 -- a 100-97 Pitt double overtime victory. Aaron Gray led Pitt with 25 points and 11 rebounds to offset Chris Quinn's 37-point, 9-assist performance.

• In 2009, DeJuan Blair had one of the great individual performances in Petersen Events Center history with 23 points and 22 rebounds, which remains the single-game rebounding record at the PEC, as Pitt won 93-80.

LAST TIME OUT

• Senior forward Cameron Corhen scored a team-high 23 points to tie his season high, but Pitt fell to No. 11/13 North Carolina, 79-65, Saturday afternoon at the Dean Smith Center.

• Corhen shot 10-of-17 from the field, including 3-of-4 from three-point range, while adding six rebounds and six assists in 36 minutes. The Allen, Texas, native scored 17 of his points in the first half, including 11 of Pitt's first 13 as the Panthers' frontcourt carried the early offensive load.

• The Tar Heels made their first eight shots of the game and jumped out to an 18-8 lead midway through the first half. Corhen kept Pitt within striking distance with his three first-half three-pointers, but North Carolina shot 53 percent in the opening 20 minutes

and took a 46-32 lead into halftime.

• North Carolina extended its advantage early in the second half, building a game-high 22-point lead at 70-48 with 7:56 remaining. Pitt responded with a 14-6 run, cutting the deficit to 76-62 on a Barry Dunning Jr. three-pointer with three minutes to play, but the Panthers could not get closer than 14 the rest of the way.

• Roman Siulepa added 14 points on 6-of-10 shooting for Pitt, while Dunning finished with 10 points and a team-high eight rebounds. Nojus Indrusaitis chipped in seven points and three rebounds.

• Pitt shot 47 percent from the floor and made 7-of-19 (36.8 percent) three-pointers. The Panthers committed 12 turnovers and were outscored 16-4 in fast break points.

• Jarin Stevenson and Seth Trimble led North Carolina with 19 points apiece. Trimble went 9-of-11 from the free throw line, while Stevenson made 3-of-4 from beyond the arc. Zayden High added 15 points and seven rebounds, and Luka Bogavac finished with 15 points and four assists.

SO CLOSE...

• Pitt's start to ACC play mirrored what the Panthers did a year ago when the team lost eight regular season ACC games in "close" fashion.

• In 2024-25, Pitt led, was tied or was within one possession in the final six minutes of regulation in eight of its 12 ACC losses. This year, four of the team's seven losses in league action have been "close" defeats.

• On top of that, Pitt lost six ACC games a year ago in which it led, was tied or was within one possession in the final minute of regulation. The Panthers' ACC Tournament loss to Notre Dame was a seventh such contest.

• Pitt became the 41st program in NCAA Division I history to play 3,000 basketball games when it defeated Wake Forest, 80-76 in overtime.

- Pitt became the eighth ACC team to reach 3,000 games all-time, behind North Carolina, Duke, Notre Dame, Syracuse, Virginia, Cal and NC State.
- Pitt has an all-time record of 1,730-1,275 for a winning percentage of .576.

DOUBLE DOUBLE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

• Bear with us as we explain ... if two players have a double-double, those would be double double-doubles, correct? If so, then we'd call it double double double-doubles if those same two players had double-doubles in the next game as well, right?

• Cameron Corhen and Roman Siulepa paired up for the rare Quad D (here at the Institute for Naming Things, we think that's catchier than double double double-doubles) against Boston College and NC State with both players recording at least 10 points and 10 rebounds in back-to-back games.

• Corhen earned his fifth double-double of the season at Boston College, posting 13 points and 12 rebounds. Siulepa had his first double-digit rebounding game of his career the same night, grabbing a career-high eight on the offensive glass, for 13 points and 11 rebounds.

• The duo did it again against NC State. Siulepa followed up his first career double-double by grabbing eight more offensive rebounds and finishing with 15 points and 13 rebounds. Corhen had seven offensive rebounds and ended with 10 points and 10 rebounds for the 10th double-double of his career.

...BUT IT DIDN'T END FOR SIULEPA

• Roman Siulepa followed up those two performances with a third consecutive double-double as he went for 15 points and 15 rebounds in an 80-76 overtime win over Wake Forest.

• He became the first Pitt freshman to record a 15/15 game since DeJuan Blair had 15 points and 20 rebounds on Dec. 20, 2007.

• Siulepa also became the first Pitt player to record three consecutive double-doubles since current Washington Wizards player Justin Champagnie had four straight from Feb. 17 through March 2 of the 2020-21

season.

• The streak was broken at Clemson, but just barely. Siulepa ended with 12 points and nine rebounds, grabbing five more offensive boards in the defeat.

ROMAN'S EMPIRE

• Freshman Roman Siulepa plays with a bruising style that complements his Australian rugby background. Throughout his freshman campaign, Siulepa has made consistent and impressive improvement.

• He has found a consistent groove over the past 15 games. He has scored in double-figures 12 times after doing so just three times in the first 11 games. He is averaging 13.1 points and 6.7 rebounds during that stretch, shooting 49.7 percent from the field.

• Maybe the most impressive thing about Siulepa's game has been his offensive rebounding. He has at least three offensive rebounds in eight of the last 11 games and leads the ACC in offensive rebounding (4.5 per game) in conference action only. He has nine more offensive rebounds in league play than any other player in the ACC.

• Siulepa ranks fifth in the country in offensive rebounds in league play at 4.31 per contest.

• In Pitt's final non-conference game of the year, Siulepa broke out with a 28-point performance in a blowout win of Penn State. He was 10-of-16 shooting, including 5-of-6 from deep. He entered the game just 3-of-20 from three-point range on the season.

• His performance against Penn State places him among the top 10 freshman single game performances at Pitt in a number of statistical categories including: points (28 - t8th), field goals made (10 - t7th), three-pointers made (5 - t5th), and three-point percentage (.833 - t3rd).

• The top basketball prospect out of Australia and someone who has appeared on the radars of NBA teams since the age of 16, Siulepa was also one of the best youth rugby players in the country. Commentators praised him as one of the best high-school rugby players ever through the GPS system.

• Siulepa's basketball resume has led to claims that he is the best prospect out of Australia since Ben Simmons. He has drawn comparisons to past notable NBA prospects such as Zion Williamson.

BOARD MEETING

• Behind the ferocious rebounding of Roman Siulepa, Pitt has become one of the best offensive rebounding teams in the country. The Panthers rank second in the ACC in offensive rebounding at 12.0 offensive rebounds per game in league play.

• That doesn't tell the entire story, though, as Pitt has posted at least 15 offensive rebounds in five of the past eight games and is averaging 13.6 per game during that stretch.

• Pitt had a remarkable 26 offensive rebounds against NC State, winning the rebounding battle 52-31. That was the most lopsided Pitt rebounding total since the Panthers held a 46-24 advantage in the season opener against Youngstown State.

• The last time Pitt had at least 26 offensive rebounds in a game came when the team also had 26 against Wake Forest on Feb. 16, 2016.

CONSISTENT CAM CORHEN

• As the only player in Pitt's regular rotation taller than 6-feet-6, Cameron Corhen has had to shoulder a large load inside in 2025-26. He's been Pitt's most consistent player throughout the year, leading the team with 18 double-figure scoring games and 18 games with six or more rebounds.

• After averaging 11.0 points and 5.2 rebounds per game a year ago, Corhen has taken the next step in his game. This year, he has bumped his averages to 12.4 points and 7.2 rebounds per game, while leading the team in field goal percentage at 52.5 percent.

• Along with the statistical averages above, Corhen has made increases this year in minutes (33.6-28.4 a year ago), three-pointers made (12-1 from a year ago), free-throw-percentage (.628 compared to .593 a year ago), assists (48-29) and steals (23-22).

• Corhen also has six double-doubles on the season with five of those coming against high major opponents.

• In the season opener against Youngstown State, Corhen finishing with 23 points and 12 rebounds, while shooting 8-of-11 from the field. He followed that up with 14 points

and 10 rebounds, while blocking two shots and adding two assists and two steals against West Virginia.

- Corhen's third double-double came in a 17-point, 11-rebound performance against UCF. He then posted his fourth double-double of the season with 18 points and 10 rebounds in the win over Ohio State.

- Against Boston College, Corhen posted another double-double with 13 points and 12 rebounds. He followed that up with 10 points and 10 rebounds last Saturday against NC State for back-to-back double-doubles.

- Against Syracuse, Corhen played all 40 minutes for the first time in his career and he ranks tenth in the league in minutes played in ACC games only at almost 34 minutes per contest.

- Opponent three-point shooting has been a critical factor in determining Pitt's games. The Panthers are holding opponents to just 29.6 percent from three in their nine wins but opponents are shooting 38.3 percent in the team's 16 losses.

ACC-LIMATION PERIOD

- Nojas Indrusaitis got off to a slow start in ACC play, going 0-for-12 from the field, missing all five of his three-point attempts and two free-throws over the first three games. He went scoreless in those contests.

- Indrusaitis broke out of the slump in Pitt's win at Georgia Tech, tying a career-high with 16 points. In the ten games since that early slump, he is 17-of-42 (40.5 percent) from three-point range and has made at least two three-pointers in seven of the ten contests.

- At 35.3 percent on the season, Indrusaitis is third on the team in three-point percentage. He is 36-of-102 and has hit multiple three-pointers in a game 12 times.

BRANDIN'S BENCH COOKING

- Brandin Cummings has been in-and-out of the starting lineup this year, starting nine times and coming off the bench on 10 occasions. Pitt's leading scorer is averaging 13.6 points off the bench and 11.2 points in a starting role.

- Cummings came off the bench to score a career-high 34 points against Hofstra on Dec. 7, including 30 in the second half, as he tried to rally Pitt back from a 17-point deficit. He went 8-for-12 from the field over the final 20 minutes, burying five three-pointers, and made all nine of his free-throw attempts.

- Cummings was 11-of-17 shooting and 5-of-5 from the free-throw line for 29 points

against Syracuse, again off the bench. He followed that up with 23 points in a non-starting role at Georgia Tech, making three three-pointers. He had a team-high 11 points against Louisville.

- In his career, Cummings has three of the top five bench scoring performances in Pitt history.

- The 34 points against Hofstra were the most in Pitt history by a player coming off the bench and were the second-most by a Pitt player (starter or non-starter) in Petersen Events Center history. It is the most points by a non-starter in the ACC since Virginia's Sean Singletary had 41 against Miami on March 1, 2008.

- Cummings' 30 second-half points were the second-most in a half in program history as well.

- As a freshman in 2024-25, Cummings had a season-best 30 points in a win over Eastern Kentucky on Dec. 11, 2024. As with the other performances, he came off the bench in that contest.

- Cummings has two of the top three scoring performances by a non-starter in the ACC this year. Combined with teammate Barry Dunning, Jr., Pitt players account for four of the seven highest scoring bench performances in the ACC this year.

MAJOR MINOR

- Fifth-year point guard Damarco "Polo" Minor has taken the long road to get to Pitt, but is leading the Panthers in 2025-26.

- Minor began his collegiate career in junior college at South Suburban College for the 2021-22 season and then spent two years at SIU Edwardsville, culminating in First Team All-OVC honors. He transferred to Oregon State for the 2024-25 season.

- With 1,308 career points and 361 career assists to his name prior to the start of the season, Minor brings experience to the Panthers. He played in his 100th career game at the NCAA Division I level when he got the starting nod against Youngstown State in the season opener.

- In the win over Eastern Michigan, Minor had 12 points, seven rebounds, six assists and four steals, while playing almost 38 minutes. He became just the third player in the NCAA this year to post a 12/7/6/4 game.

- Minor is averaging 9.1 points and 3.8 rebounds, while leading the team in assists (3.4 per game) and steals (1.4 per game). Minor is also shooting 91.1 percent (41-of-45) at the free-throw line and is second on the team in three-point shooting at 35.9 percent (47-of-131).

- Among Pitt players who have attempted at least 50 free-throws in a season (Minor needs five more attempts to reach that total), no player has shot better than Minor's 91.1 percent since Sean Miller shot 91.4 percent (74-of-81) in 1988-89.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Pitt has compiled a 324-104 (.757) record, including a 189-20 (.904) ledger in non-conference play, at the Petersen Events Center.

- Pitt is 28-31 (.475) versus teams ranked in the top 25 of the AP Poll at the Petersen Events Center, with a 14-11 (.560) mark against top-10 teams and a 9-5 (.643) ledger versus teams ranked in the top-5.

- Pitt played six games at home in the month of November, the most since also playing six home games in November of 2021. The Panthers have never played seven games at home in the month of November.

PANDEMONIUM AT PITT

- Damarco Minor's buzzer beating three-pointer against Ohio State set off "Pandemonium at Pitt" in the 67-66 victory.

- It was the 40th game-winning shot in the final seconds in Pitt program history and the first since Zack Austin buried an overtime game-winning three pointer in a 91-90 win over the same Ohio State program on Nov. 29, 2024. Minor's shot came 364 days after Austin's.

- While there were still 0.4 seconds remaining after Austin's shot a year ago, Minor's three-ball was the first walk-off winner that took Pitt from defeat to victory since Ashton Gibbs sunk a similarly long three-pointer to beat Providence 73-71 on March 4, 2010.

- The Gibbs' winner was eerily similar as Pitt had 3.5 seconds to go the length of the court. Much like Minor, Gibbs caught the inbounds pass and dribbled his way up the court before pulling up and walking it off.

- Prior to his time at Pitt, O'Toole spent two seasons as associate head coach at Cal and three years as an assistant at Stanford. He also helped Syracuse reach the 2013 Final Four and spent two years at Duke, where

he coached a young Jeff Capel and helped bring in the nation's No. 1 recruiting class featuring Elton Brand and Shane Battier.


