12	The Irish collected 12 two-out RBIs in their series win at Duke.
12	The squad features 12 true freshmen. Six of those 12 were ranked among the top two recruits in the Class of 2025 at their respective positions in their states.
9	Caden Crowell was ranked as No. 9 on the D1Baseball Freshman Impact List for 2026.
7	Seven transfer student-athletes joined the Irish for the 2026 season, including five graduate student-athletes.
6.0	Jack Radel threw 6.0 perfect innings with nine strikeouts on just 68 pitches against UCF.
6	The Irish have six players listed in the D1baseball.com Preseason rankings by position. Bino Watters (No. 19 first baseman), Jack Radel (No. 29 starting pitcher), Mark Quatrani (No. 49 catcher), Drew Berkland (No. 63 outfielder), Oisín Lee (No. 74 relief pitcher) and Davis Johnson (No. 132 outfielder).
5	The Irish erased a five-run deficit (3-8) to defeat Indiana 9-8 in 11 innings at the Live Like Lou Jax Baseball Classic.







- Juniors Jack Radel and Davis Johnson played integral roles in the success of the team a season ago. Radel was the Friday night starter for the Irish in his sophomore season and earned All-ACC honors in 2025. Johnson competed in 41 games a year ago and belted seven home runs with six doubles.

- The 2026 Irish sophomore class marks Coach Stiffler's first true recruiting class on campus after he took over the program in 2023. Parker Brzustewicz, Noah Coy, Jayce Lee and Bino Watters set a strong foundation for the squad and will be looked upon to be the core to continue the growth of the program in 2026.

- Fellow sophomores Oisin Lee, Chase Van Ameyde and Kellan Klosterman were stalwarts in the bullpen for the Irish in their freshman seasons. They each made at least 13 appearances in their rookie seasons in South Bend.

- Five position players who return in 2026 competed in at least 20 games a season ago. Six returning pitchers made at least 10 appearances.

EXPERIENCED NEWCOMERS

The Irish brought in seven transfers over the summer.

- Andrew Graham (Yakima Valley College/ Metropolitan State University of Denver), Evan Clark (USC/Illinois), Drew Berkland (Minnesota), Ty Uber (Stanford) and Eli Thurmond (State College of Florida/Tampa) all join the Irish as graduate transfers for 2026.

- Senior Noah Rooney (Minnesota) and junior Mark Quatrani (Cornell) also joined the Notre Dame squad.

TALENTED FRESHMEN

The 2026 baseball squad features 12 true freshmen for the Irish.

- Caden Crowell was ranked as the top left-handed pitcher in the state of Indiana and the 15th LHP nationally in the 2025 class by Perfect Game.

- Brandon Logan, a two-sport athlete for the Irish as a member of the Notre Dame football team, was ranked as the best outfielder in the state of Indiana and the 28th outfielder in the country.

- Dylan Passo was the top-ranked first baseman in the state of New Jersey

and the 18th ranked first baseman in the country in the Class of 2025.

- Aiden Zerr was the top-ranked RHP and the second-ranked overall recruit in the state of South Dakota in the latest recruiting class.


- Gian Gamelli was the top-ranked LHP and the eighth-ranked overall recruit in the state of Massachusetts.

- Mason Barth joined the Irish as the second-ranked shortstop in Indiana and the 12th ranked recruit in the state.

RADEL - ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Jack Radel was named as the ACC Pitcher of the Week on February 23. He threw 6.0 perfect innings at the Live Like Lou Jax Baseball Classic against UCF. He tied the tournament record with nine strikeouts and needed just 68 pitches to retire the 18 batters he faced in the contest. It was the second ACC Pitcher of the Week honor of his career.



ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM HONOREES

Jack Radel (starting pitcher), Mark Quatrani (catcher) and Drew Berkland (outfield) were all named to the 2026 Live Like Lou Jax Baseball Classic All-Tournament Team for their performances during the weekend.

IRISH DUO NAMED TO WATCH LISTS

Noah Coy and Chase Van Ameyde were named to a pair of award watch lists in early March by the College Baseball Foundation.

- Coy was named to the 2026 watch list for the Brooks Wallace Award, which honors the nation's top shortstop. It is

named for former Texas Tech shortstop Brooks Wallace, who played for the Red Raiders from 1977 to 1980. He passed away from leukemia at the age of 27.

- Van Ameyde is on the 2026 watch list for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year. The award is named after former Washington State University standout John Olerud, who was a first baseman and left-handed pitcher during the late 1980s. He was inducted into the National College Baseball Hall of Fame in 2007.

TOP-RANKED TALENT

The Irish have six players listed in the D1baseball.com Preseason rankings by position.

- Sophomore Bino Watters was the 17th ranked first baseman.
- Junior Jack Radel was 29th on the starting pitchers list.
- Junior Mark Quatrani was 49th on the catchers list.
- Graduate student Drew Berkland was 63rd on the outfielders report.
- Sophomore Oisin Lee came in at 74th on the relief pitchers list.
- Junior Davis Johnson was listed at 132nd in the outfielder rankings.

Additionally, Notre Dame had representation on the D1Baseball Impact Freshman List as Caden Crowell came in at No. 9 on the ranking.

AROUND THE HORN CATCHERS

- Junior Mark Quatrani joins the Irish after a successful two seasons at Cornell. A two-time First Team All-Ivy selection, Quatrani will be a frontrunner for the Irish behind the plate in 2026. He posted 80 hits with 51 runs, 12 doubles, a triple and 17 home runs in two seasons with the Big Red. Quatrani slashed .338/.612/.461 over his first two seasons of collegiate baseball. Defensively, he has cut down 18 of 76 (23.7 percent) of runners trying to steal.

- Freshman Shane Miranda was the No. 7 ranked catcher in the state of California in the 2025 recruiting class. He was a California All-Region First Team Preseason selection by Perfect Game in 2025

- Junior Davis Johnson saw time behind the plate in both his freshman and sophomore seasons. While he is also likely to get reps in the outfield in 2026, Johnson will be looked upon for his experience behind the dish.



INFIELDERS

- Sophomore Noah Coy is set to make the move to shortstop to anchor the middle infield for the Irish in 2026. Coy had a huge summer season with the Kalamazoo Growlers, boasting a .363 batting average on his way to earning the 2025 Rawlings Hitting Award. He was named as a breakout player to watch for the Irish by D1Baseball.
- Sophomore Parker Brzustewicz is also set to switch to the left side of the infield after serving as a stalwart at first base in 2025. His .415 on-base percentage is the second-highest among returning Irish players as he led the team with 56 hits last spring.
- Freshman Jamie Zee will likely get the nod to start at second base to begin the season for the Irish. The fourth-ranked shortstop in the state of New Jersey in the Class of 2025, he set his high school's hit record.
- Freshman Dylan Passo along with Brzustewicz, Bino Watters and Chase Van Ameyde will all be looked upon as a unit to serve as first basemen in 2026 for the Irish.

OUTFIELDERS

- Graduate transfer Drew Berkland will serve as the anchor for the Irish in the outfield in 2026. A four-year player at the University of Minnesota, he collected 92 career hits over three seasons with 18 home runs, 70 RBI and 62 runs scored. Berkland played in all 52 of Minnesota's games in 2025 and had a .293 batting average with 10 doubles, 14 home runs and a team-best 53 RBI.
- Sophomores Jayce Lee and Bino Watters along with junior Davis Johnson will provide veteran experience in the outfield.
- One of the breakout players to watch by D1Baseball, Lee is in line to start in right field for the Irish. Lee tallied 22 hits over 36 appearances with 20 runs scored, a double, two triples and four home runs. Over the summer, he slashed .330/.421/.468 with 13 doubles and 13 stolen bases in the Northwoods League with the Kalamazoo Growlers.
- Watters made 19 appearances in the outfield in 2025 and split time between left and right field for the Irish. A Freshman All-America Second Team selection by D1Baseball and a 2025 ACC All-Freshman Team honoree a season

ago, Watters made 44 total appearances in his rookie season. He hit .317 on the year with a .549 slugging percentage after amassing 52 hits, nine doubles, a triple and nine homers with 39 RBI.

- Johnson will likely split time between the outfield and catching. He mostly split time between catching and serving as the DH in 2025 with one appearance in the outfield in his sophomore season. Johnson put up a .281 batting average and a .492 slugging percentage a year ago with 38 runs, six doubles, seven home runs and 28 RBI.
- Freshman Brandon Logan will be in the mix in the outfield for the Irish as well after joining the baseball team as one of the highest-ranked outfield recruits in the country.

STARTING PITCHERS

- Junior RHP Jack Radel, freshman LHP Caden Crowell and graduate student RHP Ty Uber are set to get the nod for the starting rotation during opening weekend.
- Radel was named as a Preseason All-America Third Team selection for the 2026 season by the NCBWA. He was an All-ACC performer in his sophomore season and earned ACC Pitcher of the Week honors after posting a career-best 12 strikeouts over 7.0 innings of work in a win over California. He registered 70.1 innings pitched with 13 starts and 60 strikeouts in 2025 for the Irish.
- Radel earned ACC Pitcher of the Week honors on February 23 after throwing six perfect innings against UCF and striking out nine on just 68 pitches.
- Crowell was named as the 2025 Indiana Baseball Player of the Year by Prep Baseball Indiana. The lefty true freshman gave up just two earned runs over 55 innings while racking up 97 strikeouts and only 11 walks in his senior season in high school. He posted a perfect 6-0 record, a 0.53 WHIP, did not allow an extra-base-hit or any stolen bases the entire spring and held opponents to a .098 batting average. He was key to helping Valparaiso High School to their first-ever IHSA State Championship in 2025. His father, Jim, played 13 years of professional baseball, having stints with the Cincinnati Reds, Philadelphia Phillies, Florida Marlins and Toronto Blue Jays organizations.
- Uber was a two-time Pac-12 Champion during his time at Stanford.

He joins the Irish with 15 starts and 55 total appearances under his belt in three seasons with the Cardinal. He tallied three saves and struck out 29 batters in 35.0 innings of work during the 2025 season. He was named as a Notre Dame Breakout Player to Watch by D1Baseball.

- RHP Kellan Klosterman and RHP DJ Helwig each earned starts in 2025. Klosterman was tabbed as the midweek starter for the Irish on five occasions and made eight appearances in relief in his freshman season in South Bend. He recorded 22 strikeouts over 25.1 innings of work with a 1-1 record in his rookie campaign. Helwig earned the start for game two against Virginia Tech and tacked on nine appearances in relief in his sophomore season. Helwig posted 23 strikeouts in 20.2 innings while going 2-1 on the bump in 2025.

RELIEF PITCHERS

- RHP Oisin Lee, RHP Chase Van Ameyde, RHP DJ Helwig, RHP Xavier Hirsch and RHP Radek Birkholz all made relief appearances in 2025.
- Oisin Lee was listed among the top relief pitchers in the nation ahead of the 2026 season. He was ranked in the D1Baseball position list and was on the NBCWA Stopper of the Year Preseason Watch List. A Notre Dame Breakout Player to Watch according to D1Baseball, Lee is in line to be the closer for the Irish in 2026. He held opponents to a .194 batting average over the summer with North Shore in the NECBL.
- Chase Van Ameyde picked up a save and 31 strikeouts in just 23.2 innings a season ago for the Irish. Van Ameyde was also named as a Notre Dame Breakout Player to Watch by D1Baseball, he could be a two-way player for the Irish in 2026 with appearances both out of the bullpen and at first base.
- Transfer LHP Noah Rooney made 22 appearances and struck out 36 batters while posting a 4-1 record in 2025 at Minnesota. Over three seasons with the Golden Gophers, Rooney amassed 108.2 innings of work over 56 appearances with 80 strikeouts.
- Transfer RHP Eli Thurmond won a pair of NCAA Division II National Championships at the University of Tampa. He made 19 total appearances in 2025 with his sole start coming in the national championship game win. He allowed just one run on four hits with a

pair of strikeouts over 4.1 innings of work as Tampa repeated as NCAA Division II Champions in 2025.


DUKE (Mar. 6-8)

- **Mar. 6** - The Irish put a run on the scoreboard in the top of the third and erupted for five runs on three homers in the fifth en route to a 10-4 win in game one of the series at Duke. Jamie Zee belted his first collegiate home run in the victory. Jack Radel continued his stellar start to the season with 7.0 innings pitched (92 pitches), nine strikeouts and one run allowed.

- **Mar. 7** - Notre Dame responded to an early run by the Blue Devils with a three-spot in the top of the second. A ninth-inning rally by Duke, however, saw the Blue Devils use three runs in the final frame to take a 6-5 decision. Noah Coy had a triple and drove in three of the

team's five runs.

- **Mar. 8** - Drew Berkland got it done on both sides of the field to help lift the Notre Dame baseball team to a 2-0 win over Duke to capture the opening ACC series of the year. The grad transfer outfielder had a diving catch with a runner on base in the scoreless fourth inning, hit a solo home run in the top of the sixth for the first run of the game, and made a leaping catch at the fence with two runners on and two outs in the bottom half of the sixth to keep Duke off the scoreboard. Ty Uber had a career-high eight strikeouts and allowed zero runs on two singles in a shared shutout on the mound. Noah Rooney earned a gutsy save with a strikeout looking after Duke put two runners in scoring position in the ninth.



EASTERN MICHIGAN (Mar. 6)

- The Irish responded to an early deficit with a seven-run third inning en route to an 11-1 (8 inn.) win in their home opener. Jayce Lee led the offense with two triples and scored three times. Xavier Hirsch earned the win in relief after going 2.2 innings with three strikeouts.

HOLIDAY INN CLASSIC (Feb. 27-Mar. 1)

- **ALABAMA A&M** - The Irish posted ten runs in the first three innings and never looked back in a 19-2 win in seven innings against Alabama A&M in the first-ever meeting between the two teams. Jack Radel earned the win on the bump after going 6.0 innings with 10 strikeouts.

- **UIC** - Brandon Logan used a game-ending grand slam to help lift the Notre Dame baseball team to a 14-3 (8 innings) win. Mark Quatrani added a homer. Caden Crowell picked up the win on the mound while Noah Rooney earned a save.

- **TENNESSEE TECH** - Bino Watters belted two home runs and drove in four, and Mark Quatrani added a grand slam with five RBIs in the win. Jayce Lee went 4-for-5 at the dish, and Ty Uber earned the win.

LIVE LIKE LOU JAX CLASSIC (Feb. 20-22)

- **UCF** - Jack Radel used 68 pitches to strikeout nine batters and retire all 18 batters he faced in a perfect 6.0 innings of work. UCF tied the game in the ninth before taking the game by a 4-2 score in 10 innings. Dylan Passo belted the first home run of his collegiate career.

- **LSU** - The No. 2 Tigers took a lead early in a 9-4 final. The Irish outscored LSU 4-3 over the final five innings of play as Jayce Lee notched a home run. Mark Quatrani and Noah Coy both went 2-for-4 at the plate and scored a run for the Irish.

- **INDIANA** - Trailing 8-3 midway through the seventh inning, the Irish plated five runs in the bottom half of the inning before walking off a 9-8 win in 11 innings. Mark Quatrani went 4-for-6 at the dish with two home runs on the day. Drew Berkland added a 4-for-6 effort of his own with three RBIs, which included the game-tying and game-winning runs.

FLORIDA ATLANTIC (Feb. 13-15)

- **Feb. 13** - The Irish struck first against the Owls when Jamie Zee drove in Noah Coy from second base with his first career hit and RBI in his first collegiate at-bat. FAU, however, put up seven unanswered runs in a 7-1 final on opening night.

- **Feb. 14** - Notre Dame put the first eight runs on the scoreboard and never looked back in a 14-1 win over FAU to set up a Sunday rubber match showdown. Bino Watters and Jayce Lee each had three hits with a solo homer apiece. Xavier Hirsch posted a career-high six strikeouts and picked up the relief win for the Irish.

- **Feb. 15** - After a scoreless four innings to start the game, the Irish put a pair of runs on the scoreboard in the fifth. Notre Dame tacked on a four-run eighth and a run in the ninth for a 7-1 win to capture the series. Bino Watters tallied his second three-hit game of the weekend, and Ty Uber earned the pitch-count win on the bump in his first start in an Irish uniform.




