SETTING THE SCENE

Opening its final road trip of the 2025-26 campaign, Stanford men's basketball travels to Notre Dame on Wednesday, March 4 at 6 p.m. PT (9 p.m. ET). The action will air on ESPNU.

THE STARTING FIVE

- Stanford is out to a 18-11 start and 7-9 mark in the ACC, including four quadrant one NET victories against then-No. 14/15 North Carolina, No. 16/13 Louisville, Saint Louis and at Virginia Tech.
- Ebuka Okorie ranks fifth in the country in scoring at 22.7 points per game and second among freshmen, behind only BYU's AJ Dybantsa, and he leads the ACC in scoring, just above Duke's Cameron Boozer. Named to the top-10 lists for national freshman of the year by ESPN, Bleacher Report, Field of 68 and Hoops HQ, Okorie was added to the Naismith Trophy Late-Season Team on Feb. 19.
- Stanford won the Acrisure Invitational in Palm Desert with wins over Minnesota and Saint Louis, with Benny Gealer's buzzer beater on Nov. 28 sending the Cardinal home victorious.
- Only 37 teams nationwide have at least four quadrant one wins, with Stanford one of nine ACC teams to reach the threshold. Both of the Cardinal's remaining games are in the top two quadrants.
- Maxime Raynaud graduated from Stanford in 2025 after posting one of the top seasons in program history, and the All-American was drafted by the Sacramento Kings in June. Stanford's NBA alumni are shining above expectations, with Raynaud scoring 10.4 points per game, Ziaire Williams 9.1, Brook Lopez 7.3, Spencer Jones 5.8, and Dwight Powell 3.1. The double-double king at Stanford, with 25 in a single-season last year, Raynaud leads all NBA rookies with 12 double-doubles this season.

SENIOR DAY SUCCESS

As Stanford celebrated its senior class, Benny Gealer scored a career-high 30 points as Stanford throttled SMU, 95-75, on Feb. 28. Gealer's 30 points came with a career-high seven 3-pointers as well as four rebounds and a career-high six steals. He is the first player at any school, nationally, to score 30 points with 7 3-pointers and six steals against a major conference opponent in at least 20 years. Ebuka Okorie, who entered the night as the ACC's leading scorer, finished with 22 points, six assists and two steals.

OKORIE: ONE OF ONE

Ebuka Okorie has dazzled for the Cardinal this season with averages of 22.7 points, 3.7 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 1.6 steals per game. Okorie ranks fifth nationally in scoring and second among freshmen, trailing only BYU's AJ Dybantsa nationally, and he leads the ACC, just ahead of Duke's Cameron Boozer. Okorie became the first Stanford freshman with four-straight 20-point games since Brook Lopez from Feb. 15-24, 2007, and the first Stanford player with back-to-back 30-point games since Landry Fields from Jan. 23-28, 2010. He would be the first freshman to meet his averages in points, rebounds, assists and steals since Oklahoma's Trae Young and Howard's RJ Cole in 2017-18.

Okorie has topped the Stanford freshman scoring record three times this season. First, he broke the standard with 32 points against Colorado (Dec. 20) and then topped his own mark with 36 points against North Carolina (Jan. 14). Scoring 40 points against Georgia Tech (Feb. 7), Okorie became the first Stanford player with a 40-point game since Casey Jacobsen scored 41 on Feb. 7, 2002 vs. Oregon, and Okorie's performance is the ninth in program history with at least 40 points. He was just the fifth (now six) freshman in ACC history to score 40 points in a game, joining Cooper Flagg, Tyler Hansbrough, Harrison Barnes and Olivier Hanlan, and since, Mikel Brown Jr. The last ACC freshmen guards to average at least 20 points per game were Kenny Anderson (Georgia Tech, 1989-90) and Mark Price (Georgia Tech, 1982-83).

Okorie's six 30-point games are tied for second most by any freshman in ACC history, just one away from matching Marvin Bagley III (Duke) in 2017-18. Okorie also co-leads the country in games with 25 or more points, along with Dybantsa.

His 18 made free throws against Colorado are the second most in a single game by any player in program history, trailing only the 19 by Reid Travis on Dec. 3, 2016 vs. Kansas. The 18 makes and 21 attempts at the line are the sixth- and fifth-most by any player in the country this season, and he ranks eighth in the country with 6.5 free throws per game.

ACC SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

Finding success on the court and in the classroom, Benny Gealer was named the Skip Prosser Award recipient as the ACC Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

Gealer is Stanford men's basketball's sixth consecutive Scholar-Athlete of the Year, as Stanford won the final four Pac-12 awards in the category and Maxime Raynaud won the award in 2025 from the ACC. In addition to Raynaud, Gealer joins Oscar da Silva (2021), Sam Beskind (2022), James Keefe (2023) and Brandon Angel (2024), extending the program's streak, and he becomes the 10th recipient of the honor from either conference, along with Dorian Pickens (2018), Chasson Randle (2015), Dwight Powell (2014) and Landry Fields (2010). The men's basketball program becomes the first of Stanford's 36 teams to win six consecutive scholar-athlete of the year honors, dating back to the award's inception in the Pac-10 in 2007-08.

THE NET RESULT

Stanford enters the matchup with the Irish at No. 65 in the NET rankings (March 2). The matchup is currently a quadrant two contest, as Notre Dame slots in at No. 89. 17 of Stanford's 31 regular season games are currently slated to be in quadrant one or two, including 10 in Q1. Stanford has four quadrant one victories so far, against Saint Louis, Louisville, North Carolina and Virginia Tech, and it is one of nine ACC teams and 37 teams nationally that have reached the threshold.

RECORD BOOK WATCH

Rewriting the Cardinal's freshman record book, Ebuka Okorie already has broken the program's scoring records in a game (40) and in a season (614), passing Todd Lichti, Casey Jacobsen and Tyrell Terry in February for the top position. His scoring average is on pace to top Lichti (17.2) for the top spot by 5.5 per game. Okorie has already broken the Stanford freshman record for free throws made (175) and free throw attempts (208) in a season. He has moved into first in field goals made (193) and fifth in 3-pointers made (53). Not just a scorer, Okorie ranks seventh in assists (94) and fifth in steals (42).

In Stanford's overall season history, Okorie has moved into 13th in total points, passing Adam Keefe (1989-90) against SMU (Feb. 28). He is just seven points from jumping all the way to 11th, where we would pass Casey Jacobsen (2001-02) and Keith Jones (1983-84). His current scoring average of 22.7 points per game would rank second all-time, trailing only Adam Keefe (25.3, 1991-92) and just ahead of Landry Fields (22.0, 2009-20) and Casey Jacobsen (21.9, 2001-02). He is also ranks sixth in a single-season in made free throws, four away from entering the top five.

BIG SHOT BENNY

One of the top 3-point shooters in the ACC, Benny Gealer is posting a career-best 42.4 percent mark from beyond the arc, including 17 games with at least three triples. Gealer has made multiple threes in nine straight games - his longest stretch of the season - going 36-for 83 over the span (43.4%) while averaging 14.8 points and 4.0 3-pointers per game over the sample. Gealer scored a career-high 30 points, with a career-best six steals, against SMU with seven 3-pointers.

Gealer leads in the ACC in 3-point percentage, and slots in 21st nationally, ranks fourth in the ACC in 3-pointers per game (2.7). An efficient player, Gealer ranks 23rd in the country in offensive rating, per KenPom. He currently ranks 12th in a single-season at Stanford with 78 triples and 16th in a career with 153, and his career 88.5 percent mark at the free throw line would rank second in program history. He is six threes away from the top-five in a single season and can jump to 14th on the career list with his next four triples.

THE ACC'S LEADING SIXTH MAN

Graduate student guard Jeremy Dent-Smith is hitting his stride in ACC play, scoring 16 or more points in four of the past 12 games, including two straight with a season-high 20 against Duke and California. Dent-Smith, a two-time Division II All-American, is 27 for his last 60 (45%) from 3-point range over the last 12 games, and his six 3-pointers against North Carolina are tied for the sixth-most in any league game this season. He ranks 17th in league games in 3-point percentage (39.2%), and he has increased his overall average in conference play to 8.9 points per game. A leading contender for ACC Sixth Man of the Year, Dent-Smith ranks third in the ACC in scoring off the bench in conference play (9.3 ppg), trailing only Clemson's Nick Davidson (9.6) and Virginia's Chase Mallory (9.3) per game.

NOTRE DAME, PART II

Opening the conference slate in a low-possession defensive battle, Stanford men's basketball fell to visiting Notre Dame, 47-40, at Maples Pavilion on Dec. 30. Stanford's defense held Notre Dame to just 32.1 percent from the floor and 18.8 percent from beyond the arc, and it held the Fighting Irish to just 47 points on the evening, marking its lowest since giving up 46 to Oregon State on Jan. 19, 2023. The Cardinal offense, however, stalled in the second consecutive low-scoring battle between the two programs, with Stanford still in search of its first win in the series history. Chisom Okpara led the Cardinal with 13 points, while Oskar Giltay tallied double digit rebounds with 11 boards to go with three steals.

NAISMITH TROPHY RECOGNITION

Ebuka Okorie has been named to the 2026 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Men's College Player of the Year Late-Season Team, as announced by the Atlanta Tipoff Club on Feb. 19. Okorie is one of 30 players on the late-season team as well as one of three players from the ACC (Cameron Boozer, Duke; Caleb Wilson, North Carolina) and one of 10 freshmen. Stanford has a player on the late-season team for the second season in a row, as Maxime Raynaud was honored a year ago.

CLASS OF 2026 SIGNS

Stanford has signed a top-15 class nationally in the class of 2026, with all four prospects rated as four-star players: Aziz Olajuwon (G/F, 6-7, Houston, Texas), Isaiah Rogers (G, 6-3, Corona, Calif.), Elias Obenyah (G, 6-5, Ukiah, Calif.) and Julius Price (G, 6-2, Santa Maria, Calif.). As of March 2, the class ranks 23rd nationally from ESPN, previously 13th after national signing day, and 14th from and 247 Sports. Olajuwon, the son of former NBA star Hakeem Olajuwon, was ranked as high as No. 40 nationally from ESPN at the time of his signing and currently sits at No. 61. All four players rank in the top-100 by at least one recruiting service, with 247 Sports having three players in the top-100: Olajuwon (64), Price (88) and Obenyah (99), and On3/Rivals having two: Olajuwon (69), Rogers (79).

ROOKIE OF THE WEEK FOR THE THIRD TIME

After another highly productive week, led by wins over Pittsburgh and SMU, Stanford guard Ebuka Okorie has been named the ACC Rookie of the Week for Feb. 23-March 1. The award is the third of the year for Okorie, which ranks second in the conference this season. In the two wins, Okorie averaged an ACC-leading 28.0 points, 6.0 assists and 2.5 steals per game. He tallied 34 points against Pitt, including 28 in the second half, and 22 vs. SMU. He scored or assisted on 37 of the final 43 points against the Panthers.

ON THEIR TAR HEELS

Stanford downed North Carolina, 95-90, behind 36 points from Ebuka Okorie, but it also got 20 points apiece from Ryan Agarwal, a career-high, and Jeremy Dent-Smith, a season-high. Agarwal made five 3-pointers and Dent-Smith had six, helping Stanford to a 16-for-28 mark in the game, tied for the second most made 3-pointers in program history. Stanford had three players with at least 20 points for the first time since Jan. 24, 2015 vs. Arizona State, when Anthony Brown, Chasson Randle and Stefan Nastic all eclipsed the 20-point threshold. The Cardinal has topped North Carolina in consecutive seasons.

ACRISURE INVITATIONAL CHAMPIONS

With wins over Minnesota and Saint Louis, Stanford captured its first multi-team event championship since the 2007 Basketball Travelers Classic, winning the Acrisure Invitational. The Cardinal opened with a win over Minnesota on Thanksgiving Day, 72-68, to reach the championship game. Ebuka Okorie led the way with 25 points, while Benny Gealer had 14 and Chisom Okpara 11. Chisom Okpara led four Cardinal players in double figure with 19 points against the Billikens, while Okorie had 17, Jeremy Dent-Smith 12 and AJ Rohosy 11. Trailing by two in the closing seconds, Okorie missed a free throw intentionally, which was rebounded by Rohosy, who found Gealer for the game-winner with 0.8 to play. Gealer was honored as the tournament's Most Valuable Player.

CARD > CARDS

Opening the calendar year with a statement on the national level, Stanford earned an 80-76 victory over No. 16/13 Louisville on Jan. 2. Ebuka Okorie led the Cardinal with 28 points, while Chisom Okpara stuffed the box score with 17 points and a season-high eight rebounds, while Ryan Agarwal scored 12 points, including a perfect 4-for-4 mark from three. The Cardinal limited Louisville to just 6-for-27 shooting beyond the arc – season-low marks in both categories at the time.

PRO CARD

2025 NBA Draft selection Maxime Raynaud is one of five Stanford players in the NBA, and he joins Spencer Jones (Denver Nuggets) and Brook Lopez (LA Clippers) as players currently starting. Raynaud was drafted in the second round of the 2025 NBA Draft by the Sacramento Kings, and he gave the Cardinal an NBA Draft selection for the fourth time in seven years.

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL
SECOND SEASON AT STANFORD

Kyle Smith was announced as the Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball on March 25, 2024, and he begins his second season at Stanford in 2025-26.

In its first season in the ACC, and the first under Smith, the Cardinal finished the 2024-25 season at 21-14 overall, marking its most total victories since 2014-15 while matching a program record with 17 wins at Maples Pavilion. Stanford went 9-1 at home in the ACC, while Smith is just the second coach in program history to win 20 or more games in his first season. Additionally, the seven-win improvement year-to-year matches a program record for a first-year head coach. Smith saw numerous players have career-best seasons, led by All-American and ACC first team honoree and Scholar-Athlete of the Year, Maxime Raynaud.

Smith landed at The Farm following a successful five-year stint at Washington State, where he went 94-71 overall, including a 25-10 mark and second-place finish in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. Smith holds a 290-209 career record across 15-plus seasons as a head coach, including six seasons at Columbia and three at San Francisco. Additionally, he spent 18 years as an assistant coach with stretches at Saint Mary's (2001-10), Air Force (2000-01) and San Diego (1992-2000).

The 2024 John R. Wooden Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Smith led the Cougars to a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the round of 32 with a victory over Drake in the opening round, while the postseason event was the seventh for Smith as a head coach and third with Washington State. The Cougars also reached the NIT semifinals in 2022 and earned a bid for a second consecutive season in 2023.

Smith was the first coach in Washington State history to post a .500 or better record in each of his first four seasons, doing so after taking over a program that was under .500 in each of the previous seven campaigns.

A talented coach known for expertise in analytics and player development, Smith's tutelage has included three NBA Draft selections in CJ Elleby (2020), Mouhamed Gueye (2023) and Jaylen Wells (2024), as well as Pac-12 Freshman of the Year Myles Rice (2024), while three Cougars earned All-Pac-12 recognition in 2024. Smith also coached San Francisco's Jamaree Bouyeya, who made his NBA debut in 2023, and mentored a series of professional athletes as an assistant coach, including NBA players Matthew Dellavedova and Patty Mills at Saint Mary's.

Smith has also seen success on the recruiting trail, landing two top-60 classes, the highest for Washington State in over a decade. He signed a top-100 prospect to Pullman in the class of 2022, the first for the program since Klay Thompson in 2008.

Prior to Smith's tenure at Washington State, he led San Francisco to a 63-40 record, including 20 wins or more in each season and two postseason appearances. His three straight 20-win seasons marked just the fourth time in school history that a USF coach accomplished the feat and the first time in nearly 40 years. Smith produced seven All-WCC picks, paced by two-time All-WCC first team selection Frankie Ferrari.

Preceding his time in the Bay Area, he served as the head coach at Columbia where he put together a 101-82 overall mark, including a CIT Championship in his final season. Smith mentored 10 All-Ivy League selections over his six seasons at Columbia, led by Maodo Lo, a two-time first team honoree and the second-leading scorer in school history.

Smith played an integral role in building the Gaels' program into a perennial championship contender in the West Coast Conference under head coach Randy Bennett. In his nine seasons in Moraga, the Gaels made three NCAA Tournament (2005, '08, '10) appearances and earned one NIT bid (2009). Saint Mary's averaged 23 wins over Smith's last six seasons on the staff, including an 81-20 record over his final three seasons. The 2009-10 team finished with a 28-6 record, advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Championship and was ranked 19th nationally in the final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll.

During his one season at Air Force, Smith served as the Falcons' offensive and recruiting coordinator and took a lead role with player development and scouting. He was instrumental in the recruitment of 2003-04 Mountain West Conference Player of the Year Nick Welch along with all-conference players Antoine Hood and A.J. Kuhle.

Before joining the Falcons, Smith served eight seasons as an assistant coach at San Diego from 1992-2000 under Hank Egan and Brad Holland. During his time at San Diego, Smith helped lead the Toreros to their second-highest win total in school history (20 in 1999-2000) and as associate head coach, orchestrated a defense that allowed the lowest opponent scoring average (62.6) in the West Coast Conference (62.6 in 1999-2000).

Born in El Paso, Texas, Smith graduated in 1992 from Hamilton College with a degree in English literature. He also played basketball and helped lead the Continentals to a 26-1 record and the No. 1 ranking in the nation for NCAA Division III as a junior. He shot a school-record 51.3 percent from three-point range and helped Hamilton to an Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) championship.

Smith earned a master's degree in educational leadership from the University of San Diego, where he began his coaching career.

Kyle and his wife, Katie, have three sons, Rocco, Bo, and Luke.
